At the time Defendant entered the plea of guilty, this Court informed the Defendant of the privilege against compulsory self-incrimination, the right to a speedy trial, the right to a trial by jury, the right to compulsory process to compel witnesses to testify on behalf of the Defendant and the right to confront the accusers. That after being so advised, the Defendant stated that these rights were understood and still desired this Court to accept the plea of guilty.

The Court having accepted the Defendant's plea of guilty, set the date of the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2022, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. as the date and time for imposing judgment and sentence.

The Court pronounced the Defendant GUILTY of FOUR COUNTS of LEWDNESS WITH A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF FOURTEEN, Category A Felonies, and rendered judgment against him in the amount of \$25.00 administrative assessment fee, \$3.00 DNA assessment fee, \$150.00 DNA \$750.00 for the psychosexual evaluation on COUNT II; \$25.00 administrative assessment fee and \$3.00 DNA assessment fee on COUNT III; and \$25.00 administrative assessment fee and \$3.00 DNA assessment fee on COUNT IV. The Court ordered that the Defendant serve life with the possibility of parole after a minimum term of ten (10) years is served on each count. The Court further ordered that the Defendant pay a fine of \$10,000.00 on each count, for a total of \$40,000.00, and granted the Defendant three hundred fifty-nine (359) days credit for time served.
