

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Extraordinary circumstances and extreme need having been shown, respondent Dustin Lewis's motion requesting an extension of time to file the answering brief is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Lewis shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file and serve an answering brief. Any additional extensions will be granted only on showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. *Id.* Failure to timely file the answering brief may result in the imposition of sanctions, including resolution of this appeal without an answering brief from Lewis. NRAP 31(d).

Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of the filing of Lewis's answering brief to file a reply brief, if deemed necessary.
