

*ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS*

Court recorder Jessica Kirkpatrick's motion for an extension of time to file the trial transcripts in this matter is granted to the following extent. NRAP 9(c)(4). The certificate of completion was filed on December 6, 2022.

Appellant's motion for an extension of time to file the opening brief is granted to the following extent. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Appellant shall have until February 21, 2023, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Given the length of this initial extension request, no further extensions shall be permitted absent extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the opening brief and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions.
