

ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO TRANSMIT ORIGINAL EXHIBIT

Appellant has filed a motion to transmit an original exhibit. The motion is granted. NRAP 30(d). The clerk of the district court shall have 14 days from the date of this order to transmit to the clerk of this court original State's exhibit 136, identified on the district court exhibit list as "CD." To the extent appellant moves to place the exhibit under seal, the motion is denied without prejudice as appellant does not demonstrate that sealing the exhibit is warranted. *See Howard v. State*, 128 Nev. 736, 291 P.3d 137 (2012) (discussing the sealing of documents on appeal in a criminal matter).

It is so ORDERED.
