ORDER CONDITIONALLY IMPOSING SANCTIONS


On May 20, 2022, this court entered an order directing appellant to file and serve the transcript request form within 7 days. The transcript request form was thereby due on May 27, 2022. This court cautioned counsel for appellant that failure to comply timely with the order could result in the imposition of sanctions. See NRAP 9(a)(7). To date, appellant has failed to file the document or otherwise communicate with this court. Additionally, the opening brief and appendix are now overdue.


Appellant's counsel Craig A. Mueller's failure to file the transcript request form and opening brief and appendix warrants the *conditional* imposition of sanctions. Mr. Mueller shall pay the sum of \$250 to the Supreme Court Law Library and provide this court with proof of such payment within 14 days from the date of this order. The conditional sanction will be automatically vacated if Mr. Mueller files and serves the transcript request form and the opening brief and appendix within the same time frame.


If the required documents are not timely filed, the sanction will no longer be conditional and must be paid. Failure to comply with this order or any other filing deadlines may result in Mr. Mueller's removal as counsel

of record in this appeal. *See* NRAP 9(a)(6). Further, because it appears that Mr. Mueller's conduct in this appeal may constitute violations of RPC 1.3 (diligence), 3.2(a) (expediting litigation), and 8.4 (misconduct), failure to comply with this order or any other filing deadlines will also result in Mr. Mueller's referral to the State Bar of Nevada for investigation pursuant to SCR 104-105.

It is so ORDERED.
