*ORDER REMOVING FROM SETTLEMENT PROGRAM  
AND REINSTATING BRIEFING*

On November 15, 2022, this court entered an order granting respondent's counsel's motion to withdraw. That order directed respondent to either retain new counsel and cause counsel to enter a notice of appearance with this court within 30 days or inform this court that she will not be retaining new counsel. To date, respondent has not caused new counsel to enter an appearance with this court. Accordingly, we conclude that respondent will be proceeding without counsel.

Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a transcript request form. If no transcript is to be requested, appellant shall file and serve a certificate to that effect within the same time period. See NRAP 9(a). Further, appellant shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. In preparing and assembling the appendix, counsel shall strictly comply with the provisions of NRAP 30. Respondent shall have 30 days from service of appellant's opening brief to file and serve an answering brief. See NRAP 46A(a) (permitting parties not represented by counsel to file briefs). Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with NRAP 31(a)(1).
