
## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

## ORDER

On September 13, 2022, this court entered an order granting appellant's motion to expedite this appeal and the briefing schedule. That order gave appellant until September 16, 2022, to file and serve a transcript request form or certificate of no transcript request, docketing statement, and opening brief and appendix. On September 15, 2022, appellant separately filed the appendix, and attempted to file the certificate of no transcript request, docketing statement, and opening brief together in one electronic file. On that same date, this court issued a notice of rejection, informing appellant that each of these documents needed to be submitted separately for filing. Later that same date, appellant filed the certificate of no transcript request and again attempted to file the docketing statement. On September 16, 2022, a notice was issued informing appellant the docketing statement was rejected as nonconforming. See NRAP 14(c) (requiring in civil appeals that copies of all requested documents be attached to the completed docketing statement); NRAP 25(a)(5) (requiring that all documents submitted for filing in this court by a represented party contain the original signature of at least one attorney of record). To date, appellant has failed to file the docketing statement and opening brief.

Accordingly, appellant shall have until September 21, 2022, to file and serve a compliant docketing statement and the opening brief. Failure to timely comply with this order will result in the dismissal of appellant's appeal. See NRAP 14(c); NRAP 31(d). Respondents shall have until September 26, 2022, to file and serve the answering briefs. No reply brief shall be filed. Upon completion of briefing, the disposition of this appeal will be expedited to the extent this court's docket will permit.

It is so ORDERED.
