ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' RENEWED MOTION TO DISMISS

Before the Court is a renewed *Motion to Dismiss* (hereinafter, "*Motion*"), brought by Defendants by way of supplemental brief on November 29, 2021. Plaintiff filed a *Supplemental Briefing in Opposition to Defendants' Motion to Dismiss* on January 13, 2022, to which Defendants filed a *Reply Brief* on February 14, 2022. This matter was submitted to the Court on March 10, 2022. After a stipulated continuance, the Court entertained Oral Argument on August 2, 2022.

Having reviewed the pleadings, and relevant authorities, the Court **GRANTS** Defendants' *Motion* and finds as follows:

I. PROCEDURAL POSTURE

Among other relief requested, Plaintiff filed suit against Defendants "to recover... damages as a result of the opioid public-health crisis" on September 18, 2018.¹ Defendants thereafter filed several motions to dismiss.² After the matters were briefed and argued, this Court substantially denied Defendants' motions on February 14, 2020.

1 Defendants filed a writ petition with the Nevada Supreme Court on May 4, 2020.
2 Therein, Defendants argued this Court erred by failing to grant dismissal in total. After
3 extensive briefing, the Nevada Supreme Court issued a writ of mandamus on July 29,
4 2021, directing this Court to reconsider Defendants' *Motion* and more directly apply the
5 definition of a "matter of local concern" as set forth in NRS 268.003 to Plaintiff's claims.
6 Supplemental briefs in this Court followed.

7 **II. LEGAL STANDARD**

8 As dealt with extensively by this Court in its prior Order, Dillon's Rule started
9 as a common-law rule essentially defining and limiting the powers of local
10 governments to act. After a long history of judicial interpretation of Dillon's Rule –
11 occasionally resulting in uncertainty – the Nevada Legislature codified a modified
12 version of the Rule in 2015.³ The codification expanded the narrow approach of Dillon's
13 Rule by allowing local governments to act beyond just the powers expressly granted by
14 the state. Under Nevada's modified Dillon's Rule, it now must be presumed that the
15 governing body has the power to act "if there is any fair or reasonable doubt
16 concerning the existence of a power of the governing body to address a matter of local
17 concern."⁴ Importantly, a matter of local concern is any matter that:
18

- 19 (a) *Primarily affects or impacts areas located in the incorporated city, or*
20 *persons who reside, work, visit or otherwise present in areas located in the city,*
21 *and does not have a significant effect or impact on areas located in other cities*
22 *or counties;*
23 (b) Is not within the exclusive jurisdiction of another governmental entity; and
24 (c) Does not concern:
25 (1) A state interest that *requires statewide uniformity of regulation;*

26 Solutions, Inc., and Endo Pharmaceuticals, Inc.'s Motion to Dismiss First Amended Complaint;
27 (6) Motion to Dismiss of Defendants Watson Laboratories, Inc., Actavis LLC, and Actavis
28 Pharma, Inc.; and (7) Motion to Dismiss of Defendants Cephalon, Inc., and Teva
Pharmaceuticals USA, Inc..

(2) The regulation of business activities that are subject to *substantial regulation by a federal or state agency*; or
(3) Any other federal or state interest that is committed by the Constitution, statutes, or regulations of the United State or this State to federal or state regulation that preempts local regulation.⁵

Emphasis added. To qualify as a matter of local concern, the requirements of subsections (a), (b), and (c) must be satisfied because of the Legislature's use of the conjunction "and" to combine the subsections.⁶ If the matter concerns any of the subparts of subsection (c) then the matter is not one of local concern.⁷ If the lawsuit does not meet the requirements of all three subsections, Plaintiff does not have the authority to maintain the underlying action.

III. ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

Having reviewed the matter anew considering the Nevada Supreme Court's directive, this Court is now convinced the alleged wrongdoing in Plaintiff's Complaint fails to meet the definition of local concern as contemplated by Nevada's modified Dillon's Rule. Plaintiff alleges Defendants were a substantial cause of the opioid epidemic and seek injunctive relief and compensatory damages. Plaintiff alleges the harm caused by Defendants stems, in part, from Defendants' promotion, distribution, and marketing of opioids in the State of Nevada. This conduct is not a matter of local concern because it does not satisfy all three of the subsections in NRS 268.003(1). The alleged wrongdoing fails to satisfy NRS 268.003(1)(a) because it does not primarily impact the City of Reno and it has a significant impact on other areas outside of the City of Reno. Additionally, Defendants' conduct concerns both a state interest that requires statewide uniformity and business activities that are subject to substantial

1 regulation by both federal and state agencies, either of which would make the matter
2 not a local concern pursuant to NRS 268.003(1)(c).

3
4 **A. The Alleged Wrongful Conduct Does Not Primarily Impact the City of**
5 **Reno and the Alleged Wrongful Conduct Does Have a Significant Impact on**
6 **Other Cities and Counties Across the Nation.**

7 Plaintiff's complaint does not satisfy NRS 268.003(1)(a) because the alleged
8 wrongful conduct does not primarily impact the City of Reno and has a significant
9 impact on areas outside of the City of Reno. Plaintiff alleges, in addition to within the
10 City of Reno, "[t]he abuse of opioids is a widespread problem in the State of Nevada."⁸
11 As this Court previously recognized, there is no doubt that the opioid crisis extends
12 beyond our state and reaches every corner of the nation.

13 Evidence that Plaintiff's claims are not unique under a modified Dillon's Rule
14 analysis can be easily found by looking at what is occurring nation and state-wide. It
15 was argued that, in Nevada alone, twenty-four (24) of the thirty-five (35) cities and
16 counties in Nevada (and the State of Nevada itself) have brought lawsuits that make
17 similar claims against the manufacturer Defendants named in this lawsuit or their
18 corporate affiliates. Plaintiff recognizes that the opioid epidemic "has had far-reaching
19 financial, social, and deadly consequences ... throughout Nevada" and "across our
20 country."⁹ The far-reaching nature of the opioid epidemic demonstrates how this
21 matter does have a significant impact on other areas in the State of Nevada and
22 throughout our nation.

23 Therefore, the alleged wrongful conduct in Plaintiff's lawsuit fails to satisfy the
24 first aspect of the definition of mater of local concern as defined in NRS 268.003(1)(a).
25 This reason alone would bar Plaintiff from maintaining the underlying action.

1 **B. The Alleged Wrongful Conduct Implicates Statewide Uniformity.**

2 Plaintiff's complaint does not satisfy NRS 268.003(1)(c)(1) because the relief
3 requested requires statewide uniformity in application. Plaintiff alleges that after
4 creating the public health, namely the opioid epidemic, Defendants negatively
5 impacted public health through misleading marketing regarding the appropriate use
6 and risks of opioids.¹⁰ Plaintiff seeks to "stop Defendants' promotion and marketing of
7 opioids for inappropriate uses in Nevada, currently and in the future[.]"¹¹ The practice
8 of Pharmacy, including manufacturing, labeling, and distributing of a drug, is subject
9 to the protection and regulation of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy.¹² The request
10 for statewide relief implicates the need for statewide uniformity in application of the
11 requested relief because, *inter alia*, it falls under the purview of the Nevada State Board
12 of Pharmacy. Additionally, Plaintiff seeks statewide application of their injunctive and
13 the declaratory relief.
14

15 The alleged wrongful conduct in Plaintiff's lawsuit does concern a state interest
16 that implicates statewide uniformity. Therefore, under NRS 268.003(1)(c)(1), Plaintiff's
17 lawsuit does not constitute a "matter of local concern."
18

19 **C. The Alleged Wrongful Conduct is Substantially Regulated by Federal and
20 State Agencies.**

21 Plaintiff's complaint does not satisfy NRS 268.003(1)(c)(2) because the alleged
22 wrongful conduct are business activities subject to substantial regulation by the State of
23 Nevada and the Federal Government. Plaintiff alleges that Defendants' wrongdoing
24 stems from the manufacturing, distribution, and sales in the prescribing and dispensing

1 of opioids. Plaintiff seeks to “stop Defendants’ promotion and marketing of opioids for
2 inappropriate uses in Nevada, currently and in the future[.]”¹³

3 The entire field of opioid manufacturing, distribution and prescription is
4 substantially regulated by the federal government. The Federal Drug Administration
5 (hereinafter “FDA”) and the Drug Enforcement Agency (hereinafter “DEA”) are
6 substantially involved in the regulation of opioid medications. The FDA regulates
7 when and how a prescription opioid medication can be marketed or sold.¹⁴ The
8 manufacturing and prescribing of opioid medications implicates the DEA because
9 many opioid medications are Schedule II controlled substances under the Controlled
10 Substances Act. The Nevada State Board of Pharmacy is also substantially involved in
11 the regulation of opioid medications because the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy
12 regulates pharmacists and pharmacies to promote the protection of the public.¹⁵

13
14 The alleged wrongful conduct does concern business activities substantially
15 regulated by multiple federal agencies and a state agency. Therefore, under NRS
16 268.003(1)(c)(2), Plaintiff’s lawsuit does not constitute a “matter of local concern”
17 because it seeks to regulate the marketing of prescription opioid medications.

18 CONCLUSION

19 While the Court is cognizant of Plaintiff’s passionate argument that the financial
20 impact of the opioid epidemic on the City of Reno is unique – a position which
21 resonated with the Court in advance of entry of its initial Order – the higher court
22 decision leaves no doubt that this analysis was flawed.

1 Defendants filed a writ petition with the Nevada Supreme Court on May 4, 2020.
2 Therein, Defendants argued this Court erred by failing to grant dismissal in total. After
3 extensive briefing, the Nevada Supreme Court issued a writ of mandamus on July 29,
4 2021, directing this Court to reconsider Defendants' *Motion* and more directly apply the
5 definition of a "matter of local concern" as set forth in NRS 268.003 to Plaintiff's claims.
6 Supplemental briefs in this Court followed.

7 **II. LEGAL STANDARD**

8 As dealt with extensively by this Court in its prior Order, Dillon's Rule started
9 as a common-law rule essentially defining and limiting the powers of local
10 governments to act. After a long history of judicial interpretation of Dillon's Rule –
11 occasionally resulting in uncertainty – the Nevada Legislature codified a modified
12 version of the Rule in 2015.³ The codification expanded the narrow approach of Dillon's
13 Rule by allowing local governments to act beyond just the powers expressly granted by
14 the state. Under Nevada's modified Dillon's Rule, it now must be presumed that the
15 governing body has the power to act "if there is any fair or reasonable doubt
16 concerning the existence of a power of the governing body to address a matter of local
17 concern."⁴ Importantly, a matter of local concern is any matter that:
18

- 19 (a) *Primarily affects or impacts areas located in the incorporated city, or*
20 *persons who reside, work, visit or otherwise present in areas located in the city,*
21 *and does not have a significant effect or impact on areas located in other cities*
22 *or counties;*
23 (b) Is not within the exclusive jurisdiction of another governmental entity; and
24 (c) Does not concern:
25 (1) A state interest that *requires statewide uniformity of regulation;*

26 Solutions, Inc., and Endo Pharmaceuticals, Inc.'s Motion to Dismiss First Amended Complaint;
27 (6) Motion to Dismiss of Defendants Watson Laboratories, Inc., Actavis LLC, and Actavis
28 Pharma, Inc.; and (7) Motion to Dismiss of Defendants Cephalon, Inc., and Teva
Pharmaceuticals USA, Inc..

(2) The regulation of business activities that are subject to *substantial regulation by a federal or state agency*; or
(3) Any other federal or state interest that is committed by the Constitution, statutes, or regulations of the United State or this State to federal or state regulation that preempts local regulation.⁵

Emphasis added. To qualify as a matter of local concern, the requirements of subsections (a), (b), and (c) must be satisfied because of the Legislature's use of the conjunction "and" to combine the subsections.⁶ If the matter concerns any of the subparts of subsection (c) then the matter is not one of local concern.⁷ If the lawsuit does not meet the requirements of all three subsections, Plaintiff does not have the authority to maintain the underlying action.

III. ANALYSIS AND DISCUSSION

Having reviewed the matter anew considering the Nevada Supreme Court's directive, this Court is now convinced the alleged wrongdoing in Plaintiff's Complaint fails to meet the definition of local concern as contemplated by Nevada's modified Dillon's Rule. Plaintiff alleges Defendants were a substantial cause of the opioid epidemic and seek injunctive relief and compensatory damages. Plaintiff alleges the harm caused by Defendants stems, in part, from Defendants' promotion, distribution, and marketing of opioids in the State of Nevada. This conduct is not a matter of local concern because it does not satisfy all three of the subsections in NRS 268.003(1). The alleged wrongdoing fails to satisfy NRS 268.003(1)(a) because it does not primarily impact the City of Reno and it has a significant impact on other areas outside of the City of Reno. Additionally, Defendants' conduct concerns both a state interest that requires statewide uniformity and business activities that are subject to substantial

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8 wrongful conduct does not primarily impact the City of Reno and has a significant
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5 impacted public health through misleading marketing regarding the appropriate use
6 and risks of opioids.¹⁰ Plaintiff seeks to "stop Defendants' promotion and marketing of
7 opioids for inappropriate uses in Nevada, currently and in the future[.]"¹¹ The practice
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12 of Pharmacy. Additionally, Plaintiff seeks statewide application of their injunctive and
13 the declaratory relief.
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15 The alleged wrongful conduct in Plaintiff's lawsuit does concern a state interest
16 that implicates statewide uniformity. Therefore, under NRS 268.003(1)(c)(1), Plaintiff's
17 lawsuit does not constitute a "matter of local concern."
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19 **C. The Alleged Wrongful Conduct is Substantially Regulated by Federal and
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21 Plaintiff's complaint does not satisfy NRS 268.003(1)(c)(2) because the alleged
22 wrongful conduct are business activities subject to substantial regulation by the State of
23 Nevada and the Federal Government. Plaintiff alleges that Defendants' wrongdoing
24 stems from the manufacturing, distribution, and sales in the prescribing and dispensing

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18 CONCLUSION

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20 impact of the opioid epidemic on the City of Reno is unique – a position which
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Accordingly¹⁶, *Defendants' Motion to Dismiss* is GRANTED.

8:31 a.m. – Court convened with Court and respective counsel present.

The Court provided counsel with an introduction to the Second Judicial District Court.

The Court provided counsel with the Court's particular background and introduced Department 8 staff, Discovery Commissioner Ayres and Court Information Technology representative Pedro Duenas. Contact information for Court staff was provided to counsel.

COURT ORDERED: The Court executed the Order Granting "Motion to Associate Counsel Joseph S. Bushur" and provided the order to the Court Clerk for filing. Absent further notice, the Court will require the personal appearance of the Nevada licensed attorney who has sponsored pro hac counsel for any hearings whether in-person or conference call. Moving forward, and if depositions occur, it can be discussed whether Nevada counsel need be present to sponsor counsel who will be primarily involved in the discovery process, that decision to be held in abeyance.

The Court wants to ensure that counsel is admitted in this matter if counsel intends on signing any document, addressing the Court or asking questions in discovery.

COURT ORDERED: This matter is exempt from the Nevada Mandatory Arbitration Program. This matter is deemed a complex case and will not be subject to NRCP 16.1.

The Court advised that, at some point, there will be a meeting with Discovery Commissioner Ayres to discuss the parameters of a case management order as to any defendants who remain in the case and to any claims that have survived the motion practice. The Court is aware that Defendant Insys filed bankruptcy in Delaware. The Court will presume that Insys will not participate in this matter pending further order from the Bankruptcy Court in Delaware and/or this Court's order and this matter will move forward as to the remaining defendants.

Counsel Adams confirmed that Defendants Johnson & Johnson, Assertio Therapeutics, Inc. f/k/a Depomed, Inc. and Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc. were dismissed without prejudice.

Counsel Boranian advised the Court that there are just over 2,600 opioid civil actions currently pending in either State or Federal Court with more than 300 of those cases in various state courts around the country with actions pending against some combination of defendants, most of which are also defendants in this case.

Counsel Boranian further advised the Court that the 2,300 cases in federal court are being managed by a single district Judge in Cleveland, Judge Dan Polster. Counsel Boranian advised that there is a jury trial set to commence on October 21st, in Cleveland, set to go for seven (7) weeks involving two (2) plaintiffs with a pending defense motion to lengthen the trial.

Counsel Eglet addressed the Court and provided the Court with the status of the Clark County case to include that it is not currently set for trial, it is further ahead in the litigation process with respect to all

the other cases and retired Nevada Supreme Court Justice Michael Cherry was approved by the Court as the Special Master in that case. Counsel Eglet further advised that, in the Clark County case, the manufacturing defendants filed a writ arguing that the County doesn't have standing, citing Dillon's Rule, a subsequent joinder to the writ was filed by the distributor defendants and the writ has been fully briefed on both sides. Counsel Eglet further advised that a motion for stay of the Clark County case was filed with the Nevada Supreme Court which was denied and the Clark County case continues to move forward while the writ is pending.

Counsel Eglet responded to the Court's inquiry and advised that Justice Cherry was appointed to replace the Discovery Commissioner for all practical purposes to manage the discovery in the case.

Counsel Eglet advised the Court that it is unlikely that the Plaintiff will be opposing any of the pro hacs, there are roughly 15 to 18 cases to be filed in Nevada and he has mentioned to counsel the option of waiving the provision of the limited number of pro hac vices.

COURT ORDERED: It seems to the Court that it would be necessary to bend the rule to allow attorneys who are going to be defending the same defendant or group of defendants to streamline their pro hac vice application so they can represent the client in all cases pending in the State of Nevada.

The Court addressed the pending motions to dismiss.

Counsel Eglet apprised the Court of the process of the motions hearing in the Clark County case to include that the Defendants had one representative argue on behalf of the manufacturers, one representative argue on behalf of the distributors and individual Defendants argue the motions specific to those particular defendants.

Counsel Boranian advised the Court of the order the motions were heard in the Clark County case, manufacturers' joint motion, followed by the distributors' joint motion, followed by the individual manufacturers' motions.

Counsel Guinn recommended that the Court follow the order as stated by Counsel Boranian.

Counsel Eglet and Counsel Adams agreed with the order to hear motions as stated by Counsel Boranian.

Counsel Boranian advised the Court that, for the joint motions, two attorneys argued for each of the manufacturers and distributors.

Counsel Miller concurred with Counsel Boranian and advised that counsel tried to break up the issues in the motions to dismiss by subject matter.

COURT ORDERED: The Court will set two (2) consecutive days for a hearing on pending Motions to Dismiss.

Counsel Guinn advised the Court that the writ embodies an issue that is also an issue in the motion before the Nevada Supreme Court, which is partially briefed.

Counsel Lundvall advised the Court that she brought copies of the writ briefing for the Court, Court staff and Plaintiff's counsel. *Copies of the writ briefing were provided by Counsel Lundvall to the Court Clerk at the break which were subsequently distributed to the Court and the Department 8 Law Clerk.*

Counsel Eglet advised the Court that the writ is fully briefed, it is difficult to know if there will be a hearing for argument on the writ or if it will be decided on the briefs.

Counsel Lundvall advised the Court that there is a reasonable expectation that there would be a request for oral argument on the writ.

Counsel Miller advised the Court of the crux of the writ petition issue and further advised that it is the manufacturers' position that Clark County and the City of Reno are not authorized, under Dillon's Rule, to pursue these lawsuits.

Counsel Eglet advised the Court that today is not the day to argue the writ and further advised that the Plaintiff disagrees with the defendants' analysis, the Plaintiffs do expect to win at the Nevada Supreme Court.

COURT ORDERED: There is not a motion for stay pending before this Court and until/unless the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals directs this Court to do anything different, this Court intends to move forward in this matter.

Counsel Eglet addressed the Court and requested leave to file a supplemental brief based on the rulings in Clark County with respect to the protective order.

Counsel Guinn advised the Court that this is the first hearing of any kind of supplemental briefing.

Counsel Lundvall asked the Court to provide some direction to ensure that the supplemental briefing isn't a reply to the reply briefing that has been submitted to the Court.

COURT ORDERED: The Court expects there to be new material in the supplemental brief that could not have been raised or anticipated during the primary briefing.

Counsel Eglet confirmed that supplemental briefing would be new information and not a reply to the reply.

Counsel Solis-Rainey addressed and advised the Court that a protective order has not been entered in Clark County, a report and recommendation has been made for a protective order, there have been objections and hearings have been set.

Counsel Eglet agreed with Counsel Solis-Rainey, he misspoke regarding the protection order. Counsel Eglet advised that there was a ruling primarily pertaining to the ARCOS data that Plaintiff was not previously able to supply to the Court.

Counsel Solis-Rainey state no objection to the Plaintiff supplementing their briefing and response to the various motions to dismiss with the opportunity for the movants to respond. Counsel Solis-Rainey advised the Court that she only objects to the extent that it was based on a Clark County order that has not been entered. Counsel Boranian requested that, if there is going to be information other than the ARCOS data to which Counsel Eglet referred, that the defense has a chance to meet and confer with Counsel Eglet before the brief is filed to ensure that there is no additional confidential information.

Counsel Eglet advised that the Sixth Circuit's ruling and Judge Polster's follow up ruling is not limited just to the ARCOS data.

Counsel Adams advised the Court that other information has been recently released to the public and it's important for Plaintiff to make the Court aware of what type of information that is.

Counsel Eglet advised the Court that the new information will not violate a protective order.

Counsel Adams advised the Court that collaborating with the Defendants does not work, the Defendants want all documents to be under seal which, he argued, is contrary to Nevada law.

Counsel Boranian argued that the defense is not seeking that everything stay out of the public record, the defense wants a chance to meet and confer with Plaintiff's counsel in advance to discuss what they intend to file.

Counsel Eglet argued against a meet/confer with defense counsel ahead of filing the supplemental brief.

COURT ORDERED: Plaintiff shall file any supplement it believes will be informative to the Court based on new information, new law and/or new rulings on or before September 13, 2019. Defendants shall file a response on or before October 4, 2019 and the Court will then deem the matter re-submitted for adjudication. Matter CONTINUED to January 7, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. (2 days) for Hearing on Motions to Dismiss. The Court will send out a minute order that will generally delineate the order in which the motions will be argued.

Counsel Eglet advised the Court of the discovery timeline in the Clark County case and further advised that Plaintiffs will probably not object to two years of discovery in this case.

COURT ORDERED: The Court anticipates having an order filed no later than two (2) weeks following the hearing on Motions to Dismiss in January, 2020. If the case moves forward in some or all capacities following the January 7, 2020 hearing, it will then be decided what to do with respect to a case management order, including discovery.

Counsel Eglet suggested that the Court set hearings, like status conferences, later in the morning, ie: 10:00 a.m. or in the afternoon to allow for same-day travel. Counsel Eglet further requested that, for counsel that will not substantially involved in the arguments, if they are able to participate by phone.

The Court noted the request of Counsel Eglet regarding same-day travel and request to appear telephonically and the Court will make best efforts to find dates and times that work for everybody.

Counsel Eglet inquired if this Court wishes to be informed about decisions on similar motions in the Clark County litigation.

COURT ORDERED: The Court will review decisions in cases that have some parallel to this case as the Court deems fit, but the Court does not need counsel to file briefs to inform the Court of those decisions. Decisions on similar motions in the Clark County litigation can be mentioned in or attached to the briefs as counsel deems necessary for argument.

PATY Eglet addressed other cases filed in Nevada and other cases that are anticipated to be filed in Nevada pending this Court's ruling/s. Discussion ensued as to the role of Special Master Cherry in the State of Nevada's case and the Clark County case.

PATY Eglet advised the Court that there were hearings in front of Justice Cherry, Justice Cherry made rulings and objections to the rulings were handled by Judge Williams.

DATY Polsenberg moved for the Pro Hac Vice admission of Cassandra Cummings, Esq. to practice before this Court.
