On April 8, 2021, the Defendant above named, appeared before the Court with his counsel, Daniel Martinez, Esq., and entered a no contest plea to the crime of *Battery with Use of a Deadly Weapon*, a violation of NRS 200.481(2, e, 1) a Category "B" Felony.

On July 28, 2021 the Defendant appeared personally and with his counsel, David Neely, Esq. for entry of Judgment. No sufficient legal cause was shown by the Defendant as to why judgment should not be pronounced against him. The Court adjudged the Defendant guilty of the crime of *Battery with Use of a Deadly Weapon*, a violation of NRS 200.481(2, e, 1) a Category "B" Felony.

The court then sentenced the Defendant to serve a minimum term of twenty-four (24) months and a maximum term of seventy-two (72) months in the Nevada Department of Corrections.

Defendant shall pay to the Clerk of the Court a \$25.00 administrative assessment fee.

i was screaming at Maria Sanchez (Paraphrasing):

1. No NCSO Deputy Present; &

2. A black VW came out of Alvin Thornton's property &
Alvin was pointing at our van as if to tell the VW's
occupants to pursue us.

see P. 6@: Furthermore, Maria Sanchez called Alvin Thornton previously and obtained permission for Mr. Helfrich to visit Ms. Sanchez's rental house to watch a movie; yet Alvin Thornton barged in the house upon our entering it and he was screaming at Maria Sanchez and said that he was kicking her outta my house and into the street as soon as possible. Soon after Ms. Sanchez asked him to leave he attacked her; she banged her knee on a coffee table and fell to the ground. Alvin Thornton then began beating on his chest like a barbarian and dared me to pepper spray him. I believed he was high on drugs and was going to attack me, so I pepper sprayed him as he requested.

See P. 6@: Furthermore, the female driver made two attempts to force me to stop the mini van and Alterio brandished a Pistol at me 3 times and later discharged 3-4 shots from approximately 3/4 of a mile away before pulling over to the right side, near the mini storage building.

See P. 6@: I did not attempt to flee in the mini van; I drove it behind the storage buildings to safety because we had previously been shot at by Alterio Thornton. Alterio yelled "Peter, I'm going to get you Peter!" and he began to run in my direction.

I had a good head start on him; I outran him. Between his verbal threats and previous acts:
1. Brandishing a Pistol; 2. Firing 3 to 4 shots at us; I was in fear of my safety/life. It was too cloudy from the foot dirt & smoke clouds to see if he still had the gun. His verbal threats alone put me in fear of my life.

The wording in the OFFENSE SYNOPSIS is false & misleading.

See P. 7@: Again, Ms. Sanchez called Alvin Thornton previous to our arrival to said home and we had his permission for me to be there. Alvin Thornton attacked Maria Sanchez. Alvin beat on his chest and demanded to be pepper sprayed.

He got what he asked for. Alvin's a maniac.
Google: PV Times Alvin Thornton Domestic Battery with a Deadly Weapon / Strangulation & David Neely needs to ask Alvin Thornton about this at trial.

De-Escalation Tips

1. Be Empathic and Non-judgmental

Respect the feelings of others. Whether or not you think their feelings are valid, they are real to the other person.

2. Respect Personal Space

Be mindful of your position and closeness to the other individual. Respecting their personal space can ease a person's anxiety and protect you, as well.

3. Use Nonthreatening Nonverbals

Remain aware of your facial expressions, body language, and tone in voice. When someone is upset, they are often more sensitive to these factors than the actual words coming out of your mouth.

4. Keep Your Emotional Brain in Check

Stay as calm and rational as possible. Keep your own emotions in check, as you don't want your personal feelings to influence your judgment.

5. Focus on Feelings

People tend to have a hard time expressing how they are feeling. Be as supportive as you can by focusing on their real message. Saying things like "that must be scary" can help the individual feel understood.

6. Ignore Challenging Questions

Instead of challenging how the person feels, focus on what the two of you can do to find a solution.

7. Set Limits

Provide choices for the individual as they process through their emotions. Keep them simple and positive.

8. Choose Wisely What You Insist Upon

Be thoughtful in deciding what negotiations to be rigid in and in which to compromise. Being flexible can help avoid any unnecessary altercations.

9. Allow Silence for Reflection

Even when they may seem awkward, moments of silence allow for people to process through what they are feeling. In these moments, solutions may even be found.

10. Allow Time for Decisions

Remain patient with the individual as they are processing through their emotions. Stress levels can rise if one feels rushed; allowing them this time can help ease the emotions.

Remember, even though we can't control everything that happens to us, we **can** control how we react. We can make the choice to be more mindful and compassionate. It may sound easier said than done, but by choosing this route, we allow ourselves to feel **more peace** and **less anger**. We learn to meet people where they are at, instead of forcing our idea of where they should be.

NARRATIVE:

Narrative Deputy Sehnert//

On 05/27/2020 at approximately 2000 hrs. I was dispatched to HWY 372 and Charleston Park Dr., reference a vehicle accident.

When I arrived at the immediate area the accident location was updated to the north portion of the mini storage located on Charleston Park immediately west of Linda from HWY 372. When I exited the vehicle, I observed a small compact vehicle that crashed into one of the corner portions of the mini storage brick building. I observed the chain link fence on the ground along with debris to include brick structure from the building on the ground to include vehicle parts along with the driver on the ground. Medics were attending the unknown female victim driver and the male victim was standing in the rear of the vehicle. The male was identified as Alterio Thorton with a DOB of [REDACTED] and the female driver was identified as Iseza Del Carmen Nino with a DOB of [REDACTED]. There were no additional occupants at that time.

The female was transported to Desert View for further medical examination due to the fact she is pregnant. The other vehicle involved in the accident was located to the south portion driving path and it was facing towards the west direction. The vehicle had damage to the front portion of the vehicle. There was a female by the vehicle that Deputy Beard was speaking to at the time and there was a male that was also an occupant from the vehicle. The male was identified as Josue Flores through his Nevada Identification card. It should be noted that the driver from the red mini van in the accident fled on foot prior to my arrival.

I began to get verbal statements from multiple witnesses to include the occupants from the 2010 Volkswagen with a Nevada plate of [REDACTED]. I was given information by that vehicle's occupant that they were traveling eastbound on Charleston Park trailing the mini van in order to obtain the vehicle's plate information by taking photos from their cell phone. Alterio stated that the van continuously kept brake checking them so they decided to go around the minivan. He stated that they passed it and were ahead of the vehicle by a bus length and pulled off to the right easement of the road. The male stated that the mini van intentionally drove off the roadway, onto the easement and drove right at them, slamming into them. This forced their vehicle to pass through the chain link fence and continued into the brick structure until they came to a complete stop.

I went to speak with Josue Flores regarding the accident and he stated that Peter was driving the vehicle and that he just rammed into the other vehicle. He additionally stated that the female with him, by the name of Maria Sanchez told him that they were being shot at during the incident, but he wasn't able to articulate anything that would collaborate the shooting allegation at the time. Maria did in fact state that the vehicle was pulled off to the side of the road and that they saw what they believed to be a firearm and that they passed the vehicle, but still stated that Peter rammed into the vehicle.

After reviewing the evidence and speaking to witnesses it was determined that Peter Helfrich intentionally drove the Red Astro minivan bearing Nevada Plate 36A686 into the back of the Volkswagen which caused the vehicle to pass through a chain link fence and cause structural damage to the mini storage facility located at 1280 W. HWY372 to include damage to the front of the 2010 Volkswagen and then he fled the scene. Peter Helfrich was later located by NCSO street

The VW sped past us again (left to right lane) at a high rate of speed (I was at 75 mph) and out about $\frac{1}{4}$ th of a mile drove off the road (to the right) and parked. ^{*}(Somewhere between them passing us and pulling over Maria screamed they are shooting at us; it was on or around the area $\frac{1}{2}$ way to $\frac{3}{4}$ way past our van and before they turned off.) Not knowing if the black male had tossed the gun yet; or if the un-known driver had a gun; taking a risk of passing by said VW and possibly being shot at, my (2005 boot camp) instinct told me it's safer to hit the back of the VW to disable it and hopefully NCSO actually shows up this time (unlike when Maria was attacked) to put a stop to these vigilante's retaliating against me (etc) for pepper spraying Alvin Thornton. After the impact, the astro Van was able to crawl slowly to behind the storage building. I got out and looked towards the dust cloud around the VW to see (Alvin Thornton) the black male's shoulder & head. (60 to 80 feet away) (in the pool of dirt cloud). I heard him say "Peter; I'm going to get you Peter" and he proceeded in my direction; but I outran him. I was in fear of my life.

MITIGATING FACTORS

- Alvin Thornton Attacked Maria Sanchez; ^(1520 E. Basin Road) NCSO Deputy (911) contacted yet refused to intervene, refused to write a report. Instead, he told us to go back to the scene to file a report with a Deputy, thus putting all of us in harms way.

[Take Note that neither alleged victim's stories matched at the Preliminary Hearing; their credibility is lacking.]

NCSO Deputy had a duty to protect us and should have had an ambulance check out Maria's injured knee.

- Alterio Thornton and his fiancée took revenge (for his father's transgressions v.s. Maria and I) against me (Maria, Josue) for pepper spraying his father; taking the law into his own hands, he and his fiancée terrorized myself and my passengers; putting us all in fear of our lives.
- Had the Sheriff's intervened initially, this event would never of happened. The 911 call after the accident (see Discovery) claimed "Shots Fired", proving Alterio had a gun.

He currently receives treatment while in custody through Serenity Mental Health for PTSD, anxiety, major depression, and Bi-Polar Disorder. He takes Rim Ron for anxiety and PTSD. Mr. Helfrich reported two suicide attempts. He was 17 years old when he took 400 sleeping pills and was hospitalized for two weeks and at the age of 44, he took 90 Rim Ron pills and was sick in his cell (he didn't tell anyone). He stated, "Plan on getting it right on #3 if the Judge maxes me out" but could not articulate a plan of action.

Gambling History: None reported

Substance Abuse History: Alcohol consumption was reported to have begun at the age of 1 and is described as problematic with use being daily until October 2020. The defendant reported use of marijuana to have begun at the age of 1 with use described as daily until October 2020. It should be noted that on a previous presentence report he began using alcohol and marijuana at the age of 9 and 13, respectively. He used cocaine for a couple of weeks in the 1990's, used hallucinogens approximately once a week/month beginning in his teens until October 2020, he reported that someone "slipped" heroin in his pot five or six times, and the only time he abused pills was when he attempted suicide. The defendant reported no prior substance abuse treatment until his current incarceration. He receives both mental health and substance abuse treatment through Serenity Mental Health. He plans to participate with inpatient treatment with Serenity in Las Vegas, Nevada upon his release from custody.

V. OFFENSE SYNOPSIS

Records provided by the Nye County Sheriff's Office and the Nye County District Attorney's Office reflect that the instant offense occurred substantially as follows:

On May 27, 2020, Nye County deputies were dispatched to Highway 372 and Charleston Park Drive for an accident where a small compact Volkswagen crashed into the corner of a mini storage brick building. The chain link fence surrounding the perimeter of the storage facility, along with debris from the brick building and vehicle parts, were scattered on the ground. Medics arrived on scene and attended the pregnant female driver (VC2278415) and male passenger (VC2249869) of the Volkswagen. The female victim was transported to Desert View Hospital for further observation.

The other vehicle involved in the accident was a red minivan driven by the defendant Peter Helfrich, who had fled the scene prior to the deputies' arrival, and occupants Maria Sanchez and Josue Flores. Flores stated that Helfrich was driving, and he rammed the other vehicle. Sanchez stated that they were being shot at but couldn't provide any further details other than the vehicle pulled off the road and they saw what they believed to be a firearm, and that Helfrich just rammed the vehicle.

Witnesses stated that the red minivan intentionally drove into the back of the Volkswagen causing it to go through the chain link fence and hit the brick building.

Peter Helfrich was located while on foot walking along Highway 372 with a canister of oleoresin capsicum in his hand. He declined medical attention and was transported to the Nye County Detention Center where he was booked without further incident.

The minivan was impounded, and the Volkswagen was towed at the owner's request and expense.

On October 30, 2020, the adult male victim (VC2249869) provided a recorded interview at the NCSO Pahrump station. He related that his father (VC2249868) called him in distress asking for him to call an ambulance. He responded to his father's residence and found that his father had been pepper sprayed by the defendant Peter Helfrich. He advised that his father owned the property and lived in a travel trailer in the back of the property but allowed people to live in his house as a charitable gesture to help them get back on their feet. At the time of the incident, Maria Sanchez was living in the house and dating Peter Helfrich. His father knew Sanchez but had never met Helfrich. While his father was being attended by medics, Helfrich returned to the property but stayed in the minivan screaming at him and his father. Helfrich then drove away. At that point, he and his girlfriend got in the Volkswagen and tried to get the license plate and call the police. He said the minivan kept brake checking them, so they decided to go around the vehicle. After they had passed the minivan, they decided to pull off to the right side of the road and that is when the minivan slammed into their car causing the car to go through the chain link fence and into the brick building. All the airbags deployed. Helfrich tried to flee in the minivan but there too much damage to the engine, so he fled on foot. He chased Helfrich for a bit but returned to his pregnant girlfriend when she called for help. He reported no serious injuries but was sore and experienced pain several days after the impact.

On October 30, 2020, male victim (VC2249868) was interviewed. He explained that Maria Sanchez was renting the main house while he lived in a travel trailer on the property but a clause in the contract stated he still has use of the kitchen and laundry facilities. It was also agreed that Ms. Sanchez would not have outsiders over to the house without his permission. Ms. Sanchez and Mr. Helfrich were in a dating relationship. Mr. Helfrich was unknown to the victim. While doing laundry, the victim tried speaking to Sanchez about Helfrich being in the home. Helfrich became hostile and sprayed the victim in the face with pepper spray making it difficult to see and breathe. He tried to stop Helfrich but was sprayed again at which time Helfrich left with Sanchez and her son. The victim called his son for help.

On November 9, 2020, the female victim was contacted for a statement. She added that while pulled over on the side of the road police were called and she saw the pending collision in her rearview mirror. She advised that her car was totaled with the damage estimated at \$7,000.00 and she incurred medical bills. Otherwise her statement was the same as reported by the other two male victims.

VI. DEFENDANT'S STATEMENT

Mr. Helfrich is currently in custody at the Nye County Detention Center and was interviewed by Specialist Thelaner on June 7, 2021. Verbally, the defendant admitted to using pepper spray because victim (VC2249868) was being physical with his girlfriend, Maria Sanchez. He further admitted that he rammed into the back of the Volkswagen but said he felt he had no other option because he heard gunshots being fired and felt that his life was in danger.

VII. VICTIM INFORMATION/STATEMENT

Attempts were made to contact the victims (VC2278415, VC2249868, and VC2249869) in order to obtain a Victim Impact Statement and restitution claim; to date no response has been received by the Division. If the requested information is received after this report has been submitted, it will be provided to the Court.

According to the police report, victim (VC2278415) suffered a vehicle loss of \$7,000.00 and an unknown amount of medical bills. If the information is received after this report has been submitted, it will be provided to the Court.

IX. PLEA NEGOTIATIONS

In exchange for the defendant's plea of no contest pursuant to Alford, the State, the defense, and the defendant have agreed to recommend the following: The Defendant will plead no contest to Count I of Pahrump Justice Court case 20TR01961 (Assault, misdemeanor), the prosecution will not pursue any other charges related to this case. The State will dismiss the following charges: 20TR01961 Counts II-IV (Certain Unlawful Acts, Driving Without a License, Security for Payment of Tort Liabilities, Harassment, and Eluding a Peace Officer, all misdemeanors), 20CR01738 (Charged as Simulation of Legal Document, NRS 207.337, D felony and was to be amended to Harassment, a misdemeanor), and 20CR01739 (Harassment, a misdemeanor). The State will deny 20NY-3974 (referred for a charge of Simulation of Legal Document, NRS 207.337, D felony). Both parties agree that in 20TR01961, the Defendant will enter a no contest plea to Count I (Assault) and that the Defendant will be sentenced to a term of confinement in the Nye County Detention Center, that begins with the Defendant being remanded to the custody of the Sheriff, and ends with the Defendant entering his plea of no contest in District Court as part of this guilty plea agreement. The sentence for that offense is dependent on the timing of this case. Meaning that the credit for time served will all be applied to 20TR01961 and the time served in the instant case will not begin until the Defendant enters a plea of no contest in the District Court or when the Defendant has served 180 days, the maximum allowed on 20TR01961. Both parties retain the right to argue at sentencing. The Defendant agrees to forfeit any and all weapons seized or impounded in connection with the instant case or other case negotiated or resolved in this agreement.

The State will regain the right to argue for any lawful sentence and term of confinement if the Defendant: fails to interview with the Department of Parole and Probation; fails to appear at any subsequent hearings in this case; tests positive for a controlled substance at any subsequent hearing in this case without a valid prescription; or an independent magistrate, by declaration review confirms probable cause for new criminal charges at a preliminary hearing; or found guilty at trial for new criminal charges.

3 MR. VITTO: Good morning, Your Honor.

4 MR. NEELY: Good morning, Your Honor. Long time no
5 see.

6 THE COURT: We could barely get here through your flood
7 waters.

8 MR. NEELY: You're lucky you weren't here Monday. You
9 would have had trouble getting out of here.

10 THE COURT: I heard that.

11 This is Case Number --

12 Suzy, are you on there?

13 THE COURT REPORTER: I'm on there. Hi, Judge.

14 THE COURT: Hi, Suzy. This is Case Number, CR-20-145A,
15 the State of Nevada versus Peter Helfrich.

16 Show the appearance of Mr. Neely on behalf of
17 Mr. Helfrich, together with his client, and I'm sorry, sir. Is
18 it Mr. Allmon?

19 MR. VITTO: No. It's Kirk Vitto with the DA's office,
20 Your Honor.

21 THE COURT: Mr. Vitto, I do that to you every single
22 time. It's because you have that mask on. That's my excuse this
23 time.

24 MR. VITTO: No worries.

1 THE COURT: Show the appearance of Mr. Vitto on behalf
2 of the state. This is the time set for sentencing in this case.
3 There have been a couple of presentence reports made. I take it
4 you both have received both of them.

5 One was prepared June 8th, 2021, and the second or the
6 amended or supplemental was prepared June 21st, 2021. And the
7 only change I see in that one is that Mr. Neely's name has been
8 placed in the new one, and mine has been placed in the new one.

9 Was anybody able to discern any other changes between
10 the, with the reports?

11 MR. NEELY: I have not, Your Honor.

12 MR. VITTO: I did not.

13 THE COURT: Okay. Thank you, Mr. Vitto.

14 Mr. Neely, do you have any corrections you would like
15 to point out? Mr. Helfrich, how are you?

16 THE DEFENDANT: I'm hanging in there, Your Honor. How
17 are you doing?

18 MR. NEELY: I don't have any corrections. However
19 there were some things that Mr. Helfrich saw in that that he
20 wanted me to point out to the Court. There were some things he
21 saw there that, as I'm giving my sentencing argument, I agreed to
22 point to and read them into the record that are in the PSI.
23 Other than that, we don't have anything, and of course
24 Mr. Helfrich will probably make a statement to the Court.

1 THE COURT REPORTER: Mr. Neely, if you wouldn't mind
2 sitting in front of the microphone, it would make my job easier.

3 MR. NEELY: I'm sorry. I'm so used to standing. Judge
4 Hoyt used to make us stand no matter what.

5 THE COURT: Judge Hoyt didn't have to work with Zoom.

6 Mr. Vitto, do you have any corrections you would like
7 to point out in the PSI.

8 MR. VITTO: I do not, Your Honor.

9 THE COURT: I note that we don't have a probation and
10 parole person here today. And I know that both you gentlemen are
11 familiar with this, but there's a really complicated credit for
12 time served calculation that needs to be done.

13 And my first question to P and P was going to be how
14 many days does he have credit for? Do either of you know that?

15 MR. NEELY: I was going to ask the Court. He had to
16 serve 180 days, he had to serve six months to take care of all
17 the time on his misdemeanor, and then the time that would credit
18 toward this sentence would be after the 180 days were over.

19 THE COURT: That's basically my understanding of it
20 too, except that the first 180 days, I guess it would have been
21 easier for the person, for you guys to say that when he's
22 finished his Justice Court sentence, good time will begin to
23 apply, or credit for time served will begin to apply to this
24 case.

1 But, that's not what you did. Mr. Vitto, do you have
2 an opinion about that?

3 MR. VITTO: Judge, just, you know, trying, it's rather
4 arcane the way it's articulated. The easiest way I think I can
5 distill it is to just say, attribute 180 days time served below,
6 that leaves him 102 days, give him 102 days credit on the case.

7 THE COURT: Mr. Neely, would you talk to Mr. Helfrich
8 and see what he thinks?

9 (Discussion between the defendant and his attorney off
10 the record.)

11 THE COURT: If you can reach a stipulation about it,
12 that would be a huge advantage.

13 MR. NEELY: He's telling me that's a no.

14 THE COURT: I came really close to that same number
15 when I calculated it before I came in here, but I was hoping P
16 and P would give us their calculation.

17 Is everyone satisfied with 102 days?

18 THE DEFENDANT: I really don't know. I know the
19 longest stint of incarceration here started October 20th, 2020.
20 But, there were a couple prior to that that included I'd say
21 almost a week and maybe a day.

22 But, off the top of my head, I just don't know enough
23 to make an educated opinion on it.

24 So, I mean if that's what everybody's going towards,

1 great. If it ends up being a discrepancy of a week or two, I
2 just don't have the facts before me. I just don't know.

3 THE COURT: Okay. Let's do this. Let's presume for
4 purpose of today that's 102 days. And then I will ask counsel to
5 be in contact with P and P to see if they differ from that
6 calculation, and if it's a greater amount of credit for time
7 served, we will amend the JOC to reflect that. If it's a lesser
8 amount it will stay at 102.

9 MR. NEELY: That sounds good.

10 MR. VITTO: That works for us, Your Honor. Thank you.

11 THE COURT: Mr. Vitto, is that satisfactory?

12 MR. VITTO: Yes.

13 THE COURT: Mr. Neely, do you have a recommendation for
14 me?

15 MR. NEELY: Yes, I do, Your Honor. Mr. Helfrich is 44
16 years old now. You can say during this childhood he suffered
17 severe physical and emotional abuse from his alcoholic drug
18 addicted parents. He's had a pretty tough childhood.

19 In fact, when he was younger as a baby, wandering
20 around the house, his parents would allow him to use marijuana
21 and drink alcohol at the parties. So, he's really had a lot of
22 time though, some mental health issues.

23 THE COURT: I don't want to interrupt you, Mr. Neely.
24 I did want to make clear before we started argument, I wanted to

1 make sure that Mr. Helfrich knew that I have read every single
2 word of what you've put in here.

3 THE DEFENDANT: Thank you, sir. I greatly appreciate
4 that. I thank you for taking that time. Thank you.

5 THE COURT: I did instruct the clerks on the file, the
6 documents that you presented while you were represented by
7 counsel, because, but I have them marked as exhibits. I have a
8 package of those exhibits, but I don't really see any reason to
9 admit them. They're in the court file already they're just
10 lodged on the left side.

11 THE DEFENDANT: Thank you, sir. I appreciate it.

12 THE COURT: I apologize, Mr. Neely.

13 MR. NEELY: That's okay, Your Honor. Given his mental
14 health history, it's been extensive throughout his whole life.
15 But, it looks to me, after talking to him, he's reached a point
16 in his life where he wants to deal with his issues.

17 So, he's been to treatment while he's in custody with
18 Serenity Mental Health for PTSD, anxiety, major depression,
19 bipolar disorder and they've got him on some medication for it.
20 So, he wants to seek some treatment for his mental health issues.

21 During the negotiations, I received, I talked to him in
22 jail and I received some correspondence indicating that he was
23 told he could possibly go to the Clark County Mental Health
24 Court.

1 Well, I have had a lot of experience dealing with them,
2 and if you have any crime of violence, you are not eligible. I
3 told him, I said that Clark Mental Health Court sounds pretty
4 good. But, I know those people. And he has a Manslaughter. So
5 that definitely was not looking possible, Your Honor.

6 So, what we would like to do is we would like to ask
7 the Court to sentence him to probation, sentence him to minimum
8 of two max of six, suspend it, send him to Serenity Mental
9 Health. We spoke with them and they will allow him to go there
10 and do a one year program.

11 They have got a bed there at the facility. And after
12 the one year, he would get trained for a job, or actually a job,
13 after he completes it. He's reached a point in his life where he
14 wants to try to change things and I spent some time this morning
15 talking to him about it.

16 What we all want to see is you get on the right track.
17 I think his mental health history and everything has got a lot to
18 do with it.

19 So, that's his plan, to try to change his life going
20 forward, Your Honor, is to try to get some mental health
21 counseling to get himself straightened out. We'd also like to
22 point out, and look at his criminal record, Your Honor. He's got
23 one felony and two misdemeanor convictions.

24 He had one prison and two jail.

1 He's never been on probation and he didn't do parole on
2 his felony he did day for day. So, he's never had an opportunity
3 for probation, Your Honor. He's asking the Court to allow him
4 probation to see if he can succeed in getting some mental health
5 and changing his life for the better.

6 I think he can do it.

7 THE COURT: Sorry. Hang on. Boy you guys would have
8 been in trouble if your phone went off. Good thing it wasn't
9 mine. Good grief. That's what happens when you have a new
10 phone.

11 Yes, sir?

12 MR. NEELY: So, that's our request, Your Honor. If you
13 want to speak with Mr. Helfrich in one second, he's going to
14 probably want to make a statement.

15 He asked me to read some stuff into the record. I know
16 the Court's already told him that you reviewed everything. Let
17 me see what he's got to say now.

18 (Discussion between the defendant and his counsel off
19 the record.)

20 MR. NEELY: He's got some stuff here he wants me to
21 read. He would like me to read this into the record, Your Honor,
22 the offense synopsis:

23 "Ms. Sanchez stated that they were being shot at, but
24 couldn't provide any further details, other than the vehicle

1 pulled off the road, and they saw what they believed to be a
2 firearm and that Helfrich just rammed the vehicle.

3 THE COURT: Mr. Neely, would you slow down, and louden
4 up.

5 MR. NEELY: What I'm reading, Your Honor, is on page
6 six, middle of the offense synopsis, Your Honor.

7 THE COURT: Yes, sir.

8 MR. NEELY: And he's asked me to read this statement in
9 the PSI:

10 "Sanchez stated that they were being shot at, but
11 couldn't provide any further details, other than the vehicle
12 pulled off the road and they saw what they believed to be a
13 firearm, and that Helfrich just rammed the vehicle."

14 I also have one more thing he would like me to read,
15 Your Honor. I'm back on page seven, Your Honor, Defendant's
16 Statement.

17 THE COURT: I have it.

18 MR. NEELY: I think I'm on the third sentence:

19 "He further admitted that he rammed into the back of
20 the Volkswagon, but said he felt he had no other option, because
21 he heard gunshots being fired and felt that his life was in
22 danger."

23 And then I think Mr. Helfrich might want to make a
24 statement.

1 THE COURT: He will be able to do that after Mr. Vitto
2 speaks.

3 Mr. Vitto, do you have a recommendation for me?

4 MR. VITTO: Thank you, Your Honor. Thank you very
5 much. My recommendation is 48 months minimum, 120 months
6 maximum, and a \$10,000 fine.

7 At this point in the defendant's criminal career, I
8 think the specific and general deterrence factors are paramount,
9 specifically this Court has the opportunity to stop the defendant
10 for a minimum of four years from involving himself with criminal
11 conduct.

12 The general deterrence factor, this Court has the
13 opportunity to protect the law abiding citizenry for a minimum of
14 four years.

15 Looking at the history, listening to everything, taking
16 everything into consideration, it appears that the best shot at
17 any kind of rehabilitation is taking full advantage of any and
18 all programs that are within the controlled environment of the
19 Nevada Department of Corrections.

20 The defendant positions himself before the Court today
21 for sentencing as a threat and a menace to society. He's
22 menacing. He's violent. He won't stop. After being charged
23 with murder and pleading guilty to manslaughter and going to
24 prison on a 48 to 120, the defendant got out, and didn't let much

1 time go by, before he then began to involve himself with the
2 criminal conduct that you see on page five of the PSI:

3 Harassment, Prepare Or Deliver to a Person Simulated
4 Legal Document.

5 Battery with Use of a Deadly Weapon.

6 Assault With a Deadly Weapon.

7 False Statement to Obstruct Public Office.

8 Assault, Certain Unlawful Acts.

9 Driving Without a Valid License.

10 Unlawful Acts.

11 Proof of Insurance.

12 Harassment.

13 Baiting.

14 Eluding.

15 Failing to Stop on Signal of Police.

16 Intimidating a Public Officer.

17 Et cetera.

18 THE COURT: Those are all charges, is that correct?

19 MR. VITTO: Those are all charges.

20 THE COURT: The convictions are, in fact, one felony
21 and two misdemeanors?

22 MR. VITTO: Correct. And most of those were resolved,
23 no, all of those were resolved as a result of the negotiation
24 before the Court. But, that's the criminal conduct that he

1 immediately involved himself with upon being released for killing
2 a man.

3 My recommendation to the Court today is that the
4 defendant be sentenced to the maximum term of incarceration, 120
5 months in the Nevada Department of Corrections, that parole
6 eligibility is after a minimum of 48 months has been served.

7 I'm also asking that a \$10,000 fine be imposed.

8 Thank you, Your Honor.

9 THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. Vitto.

10 Mr. Helfrich, is there anything you would like to tell
11 me before I decide what to do?

12 THE DEFENDANT: I remember previously when we spoke, or
13 when we met the last time, when Mr. Martinez was my attorney, you
14 asked me basically what motivated me to partake in this
15 situation.

16 And I didn't really have enough time, I don't think we
17 were limited on time, and, and therefore I had a lot of time to
18 think about it. And I want to explain to you what happened, you
19 know, some of the deputy part and whatnot reflects that Maria
20 Sanchez was in a band in our church. We began dating. We had a
21 picnic at the park that day, and she invited me to her rental
22 house.

23 And she said that she would have to ask permission for
24 me to be there. We were going to watch some Christian-based

1 movie. I forget the name of it. But, anyways, she then called
2 Alvin Thornton while I was in front of her, and requested
3 permission for me to come over to her rental home and watch a
4 movie.

5 To the best of my knowledge, that permission was
6 granted. We proceeded to the Wilson Road residence, and parked
7 there. It's a high fence, gated off property.

8 As we entered, and we were bringing like various
9 things, like leftover food and what have you, from the picnic.
10 And with her autistic son, Josway Flores, who was about 24 at the
11 time. He's special needs. So, as we entered the door of this
12 home that she was renting from Alvin Thornton and came in, Alvin
13 Thornton barged in the house, and this gentleman, Alvin Thornton,
14 he's a black male, larger than this deputy here in stature.

15 And this Alvin Thornton was yelling and screaming at
16 the top of his lungs, at Maria Sanchez, saying, Maria, I am going
17 to kick you out of my house and into the street as soon as
18 possible.

19 We were totally flabbergasted. We thought this man
20 gave us permission to be there. I would never have gone over,
21 being an ex-felon, in a situation where I am not welcome
22 somewhere.

23 Anyways, Maria basically stated, Alvin we asked
24 permission. I'm renting this place for me. You said it was okay

1 for Peter to be here. I want you to leave. I'm paying rent.

2 And she and I asked him to leave a couple times. Then
3 he forcibly put his hands on her shoulders, and forcibly shoved
4 her.

5 She went spluttering around trying to catch her
6 balance, banged her knee on the coffee table, and got scraped up
7 a little bit, then fell on the ground.

8 Then Alvin began beating on his chest like a barbarian,
9 daring me to pepper spray him.

10 Now I, being a small guy, and this individual is larger
11 than this gentleman over here, and I wouldn't stand a chance, you
12 know what I mean, if he attacked me. So, I used nonlethal means,
13 which is pepper spray, to subdue him.

14 And then we fled and went to the Basin Road, Nye County
15 Sheriff's Office. No one was around. We called 911 and
16 requested medical attention for her banged-up, scraped-up knee,
17 and we requested a deputy help file a report.

18 I don't know. I mean this is all well acknowledged and
19 accepted by Mr. Martinez told me that he had talked to one of the
20 other prosecutors, Mr. Allmon, that this is all verified.

21 There's video evidence that we drove there and video
22 evidence that we entered the building, and then eventually 15, 20
23 minutes later, this deputy came out. I don't remember his name.

24 We told him what happened. We requested medical

1 attention for her knee. We requested that Assault and Battery
2 charges be filed.

3 He refused our request, and he told us to go back to
4 the scene and wait across the street, and a deputy would be there
5 to take our report. And if we needed medical or whatever, it
6 would go from there.

7 The only reason that -- I would never have gone back to
8 the scene of an incident like this unless an officer had told me
9 to do so.

10 Being an ex-felon, you always got butterflies in your
11 stomach when you're around police. And when they tell you to do
12 something you want to think that it's in your best interests to
13 do so.

14 Well, that wasn't the case that day. We went back,
15 and, unfortunately there was no deputy present. And then Alvin
16 came out from the gated area, and motioned this car to come
17 forth, and then he pointed at our SUV. Astrovan; I'm sorry. And
18 then they proceeded to creep forward.

19 And if all this wasn't enough, you know, having a woman
20 assaulted and all this, and Alvin Thornton has a history with
21 Domestic Battery, With a Deadly Weapon, Strangulation with a
22 former woman. So, this is his serial history repeating itself.

23 This car came forth, and I said to Maria, pardon my
24 German. "I don't see any F'ing sheriffs. This looks like a

1 set-up. I'm getting the F out of here."

2 And I did a U-turn.

3 And as I proceeded towards where we would go out from
4 Wilson and proceed towards 372. I took a left in hopes of
5 fleeing back to the Sheriff's station. I was hoping to make it
6 there, and then we realized I was doing 55 miles an hour at the
7 time.

8 And I just want to say Maria and her son both have some
9 mental health issues. So, while we were being tailgated by these
10 two individuals who admitted this, Azilla Demeno, admitted to
11 this at the preliminary hearing. I don't want to bore you with
12 the lies and everything. But, please just take my word for it.
13 She admitted to tailgating.

14 THE COURT: I read what she did.

15 THE DEFENDANT: Okay, sir. Thank you.

16 Maria was screaming and yelling and hollering, as you
17 may well know, and I've got PTSD, and anxiety.

18 So, I was just trying to tell her, please, why don't
19 you call 911? And they were too terrified. I tapped on the
20 brakes to try and get them off my bumper.

21 And then they came along the side of us and Maria goes:
22 "Oh, my God. He's got a gun. Jesus help us."

23 And all this stuff. And she's screaming, and I look,
24 and sure enough, there's Alturio there, pointing a pistol at me,

1 a black pistol at me. And I almost lost control of the vehicle
2 at the time.

3 Just out of the sheer terror of having this happen, and
4 then I somehow regained my composure, and I kept telling Maria,
5 "Would you just please shut up and let me drive?"

6 But, she wouldn't. More and more terrified. They
7 passed us, and about 500 feet away, they got back in our lane and
8 stopped dead in the middle of the road.

9 It's like a nightmare. This is the kind of stuff you
10 see in Hollywood films, but you never think it is going to happen
11 to you. But, then again, this is Pahrump, Nevada. I mean,
12 anything can happen in the Nyelight Zone.

13 I proceed to pass them off the double yellow line. I
14 know that's illegal, but I passed them, you know, left to right,
15 and then they performed the same maneuver again, coming
16 alongside, brandishing the pistol and all the while he's grinning
17 at me like it's funny.

18 Once again stopped about 50 feet away, give or take,
19 and then I once again passed them and I'm doing about 75 or 80,
20 trying to get away from them. And this is a little Volkswagon
21 Beetle GTI, and I've got a four cylinder. If I did a U-turn,
22 like the hills have eyes-ville to California.

23 There was no place from that stretch of Wilson to where
24 I'm talking about to turn left or turn right to try and evade

1 them. Sometimes the only way through hell is straight ahead.

2 My grandfather was a World War II vet. Robert
3 Journegan, Army Air Force, and unfortunately, he's right.

4 Now, it was about three quarters of a mile, give or
5 take, and that's like third time they passed us, they passed us
6 like they were standing still. They must have been doing 100,
7 120. Because I was doing about 75, 80.

8 And somewhere between five hundred and a thousand feet,
9 before they pulled over near that storage building, we distinctly
10 heard, it was like three or four shots, and then Maria just went
11 ballistic, and I kept saying, "Somebody call 911, oh, my God,"
12 you know? And I'm going, "What am I gonna do?"

13 So, the closer we approached, and mind you, even though
14 I only made it through four weeks of military training, and I got
15 sick from the Anthrax vaccine, and I got discharged. There's
16 something that they teach you in the military very early on.

17 It's think like your opponent, and I'm thinking to
18 myself, if I just fired three to four shots off at somebody from
19 a distance and missed, and then I pull over to the side of the
20 road, to me seemed like a tactic to get a clearer shot.

21 I mean it doesn't take Rambo or an Army general to
22 figure out that if somebody has fired three to four shots off at
23 you, and pulls over to the right-hand side of the road, instead
24 of continuing driving away like they said they were going to

1 Walmart.

2 Well, why weren't they going to the sheriff's
3 department, if they were trying to get a license plate number
4 that they could have gotten when Maria drove back home.

5 I just, I just panicked and freaked out. I thought to
6 myself, and I saw in my mind, if I drive by them and they get
7 lucky, Maria or her autistic is son, who is like 23 or 24, would
8 likely be the targets. And I made a quick decision, right or
9 wrong. I just said to myself, I think the only way to get the
10 sheriffs involved with this and take thing seriously, and the
11 only way to hope that we're not going to get shot at was to run
12 into the back of the car. And then after I did that, I went
13 around behind the building, the buildings, and parked the vehicle
14 and I said, "Okay. Both of you get out. Both call 911 and hide
15 until the sheriffs show up. Get somewhere to find safety."

16 And then as I turned, there's all this poof of dirt and
17 smoke and what have you, and I can only see from this far up,
18 Alturo was out of the car, and he looked in my direction he said,
19 Peter, I'm going to get you, Peter.

20 And I said, "Oh, brother." I don't know if he still
21 had the gun or not, or what was going on. So I took that as a
22 threat.

23 And I used to run track when I was a kid, you know, in
24 school so I just ran. And as I ran, people were pouring out of

1 the storage building, and I said, you know, "He's got a gun.
2 Call the sheriffs. He's got a gun," whatever, as I'm running.

3 So, I saw people like they were getting on their
4 cellphones and whatnot, these individuals coming out of the
5 storage unit building, like the office.

6 And then I just, I ran, and there was this house, and I
7 asked the gentlemen in his back yard, I said, "Sir, someone was
8 shooting at us. I feel my life's in danger. I'm trying to get
9 back on 372. If I got to walk to the sheriff's station or flag
10 down a sheriff when they finally arrive."

11 So, he told me how to get back on 372.

12 There was, an undercover shows up, and I waived them
13 down.

14 And I said, "Did you find the gun?"

15 And they both looked at each other.

16 I said, "Well, did you find the gun?" I'm going oh,
17 great. I invoked my right to remain silent. I handed over my
18 pepper spray, and that was it.

19 And the main thing, like I said, you know, I've got the
20 deputy report here and I'm sure you've read it.

21 THE COURT: I have. I read every bit of it.

22 THE DEFENDANT: So, basically, don't even take my word
23 for it. Maria saw the gun, I saw the gun. We all know that, if
24 it took five minutes, if it took ten minutes there's time to bury

1 that thing, Chuck it across the street, whatever. I don't know
2 how they made it disappear, but I know that they did, because
3 there definitely was a gun.

4 The only last thing I had, pursuant to the NRS
5 176.1561(b) was in the offensive analysis, I feel that the
6 omission of those facts, blatant omission of those facts that
7 were omitted being after Maria was attacked, we went to the
8 sheriff's department, did our due diligence to try and seek
9 assault charges, and, you know, medical attention for her banged
10 up knee, and then that we were denied the same, and told to go
11 back to the scene.

12 I think that that being omitted from the offense
13 synopsis to the untrained eye, I know you've read it all and you
14 are aware of it.

15 But, I object to that being omitted, because the
16 untrained person, or the average person, they would have a hard
17 time thinking, like, well, why did this guy go back? Why in the
18 world did this guy go back? And when I search for answers to
19 myself, like what could I have done differently that day?

20 So, I enrolled in the Serenity Mental Health, and I
21 have seen four drug and alcohol mental health counselors. And I
22 told them basically the whole start to finish. And I said what
23 could I have done different to avoid this? All these four well
24 educated people that are listening to other inmates and other

1 people that have crazy traumatic situations.

2 And they said, you should have never listened to the
3 deputy on Basin Road tell you to go back to the scene and wait
4 for a deputy. That was the catalyst that kind of, it was kinda
5 like to me, napalm on the camp fire that created this situation,
6 that got so out of control, Judge.

7 I apologize for panicking. I apologize for freaking
8 out. Post-traumatic stress sort of things are very difficult to
9 live with. I didn't realize how bad my PTSD was until I'm in a
10 situation like this, a fight or flight.

11 I also, one day, on March 2nd, 2020, or 2021. I'm
12 sorry. I was up at Tonopah praying and whatever. It was around
13 11:45, and I said, "You know, God, I really want to talk to
14 Lieutenant Gray about this."

15 And as crazy as it sounds, as corny as it sounds, he
16 shows up. How often does Lieutenant Gray show up all the way to
17 Tonopah? He came to my cell. We have a rapport.

18 I gave him the whole run down, basically, what happened
19 and I said, "Lieutenant, look me in the eye and tell me what I
20 could have done different."

21 And he paused for a moment. "You know, what,
22 Helfrich?" He goes, "Don't ever listen to one of my deputies or
23 any deputy tell you to go back to the scene after a woman or
24 anybody has been assaulted. Don't ever do that again?"

1 And he kind of apologized that it happened that way.

2 So, I have had five people, one of them a lieutenant,
3 and a decorated, former officer beat cop that had hit the
4 streets, and he told me the same thing. He said, "You should
5 have never went back to the scene."

6 And he said, "If something like this ever happens
7 again, just go home. Wait until the next day. Come in and talk
8 to somebody else other than whoever told you to do that until you
9 get the right answer. Or you're going to find somebody, an
10 officer, a deputy, or detective that will file a police report
11 for assault, that will take pictures if there's any bang up or
12 scrape or whatever, and things will go hopefully better, if it
13 ever happens again, next time."

14 So, I apologize for getting out of control, and I feel
15 stupid for listening to that deputy, but, you know, you're an
16 Honorable Judge. I'm an ex-felon.

17 I'm just saying, if you went down there under the same
18 circumstances, I doubt that they would have told you to go back
19 to the scene. And you know the law well enough, you probably
20 would have told them I'm not going to. You are going to get your
21 superior over here or something.

22 I had just got done, it was stressful. The whole
23 situation previous to this was stressful. And I was having an
24 anxiety attack, and I just followed his directions, foolishly,

1 and look how out of control it got.

2 You know, it was, in Hollywood, you know, the hero
3 rides away in the sunset, and all this stuff. But it doesn't
4 always happen in real life.

5 I'm thankful that nobody was really seriously injured.
6 But, what it all boiled down to was those two individuals felt
7 justified, because I pepper sprayed their father to prevent
8 myself from being assaulted after he assaulted Maria Sanchez,
9 that they were justified in playing vigilantes.

10 And nobody has the right, in my opinion. And you can
11 correct me if I'm wrong, sir, to tailgate us, chase us and do all
12 these crazy antics. Neither one of them, they both admitted they
13 never graduated from the Police Academy, and they had no
14 experience in pursuing suspects. They terrified us that day.
15 Both of them.

16 And I don't know how anybody, you know, you put a
17 hundred people in a situation, a similar situation, you might get
18 a hundred different responses of how they act.

19 I felt like because of my prior history in Nye County
20 that the Sheriff's Department was turning a blind eye to helping
21 us. I mean, I could be wrong, but I felt like I was on my own
22 down that lone stretch that day, and nobody was going to come to
23 the rescue or anything. And I was in fear of not only my safety,
24 but my passengers'. And I just made what many may think or

1 believe to be a rash decision, but I really didn't know what else
2 to do.

3 But, we don't know what would have happened if I would
4 have drove by, if anything. That might have been the right
5 decision. I just can't say, only God knows that.

6 But, I want to apologize, in general, also to let you
7 down, because you remember when I lost my parental rights and all
8 that, you wished me well and hoped that things would go good.

9 Actually, I couldn't find a job when I got out of
10 prison. I was up in Vegas. Nobody would hire me. I'm a
11 National Honor student. I've got an associate's degree. My
12 health issues forced me out of my bachelor's. I ended up out
13 here. I didn't have to worry about toxic mold, just toxic
14 people.

15 My certifications and everything else that I had going
16 for me really didn't seem to mean much when I tried to find
17 employment, and I wasn't aware of Serenity Health or Hope For
18 Prisoners. and some of these other things that I, unfortunately,
19 under these circumstances, became aware existed, to my disposal,
20 so I ended up back in Pahrump, working my way out of a tent, and
21 this is how I ran into Maria Sanchez. We started off friends,
22 and I was volunteering as a cook at the church, and other things.

23 Lastly, the only other thing that I wanted to point out
24 was there was some discrepancy about this simulation of a legal

1 document.

2 THE COURT: I don't care about that.

3 THE DEFENDANT: It was a formal demand letter, sir.

4 THE COURT: You are not being sentenced for that.

5 THE DEFENDANT: I just want to apologize to everybody
6 else. It wasn't my intent to hurt anybody. It was my intent to
7 disable that vehicle, force the sheriffs to take this matter
8 seriously, because it got out of hand, by these three individuals
9 that were, in my opinion, seeking vindication for pepper spraying
10 Alvin Thornton, who has a history of assaulting and strangling
11 and beating women. And why the sheriffs didn't take it
12 seriously, because they already arrested him previously for
13 assaulting women is beyond me.

14 But, I can't change anything, Judge. And I know you
15 have given me two recommendations from these two gentlemen, both
16 well educated, and experienced on both sides of the fence.

17 I'm offering a third option and a prayer to the Court
18 that if you would give me a two to five, or a two to six, or
19 however you want to structure it, I promise you right here on the
20 record that when I do believe that two to five or two to six, I
21 will directly go into Serenity's one-year mental health program.

22 But, not just mental health but the drug and alcohol
23 program. Because part of the thing was, after this event
24 happened, I was so stressed out, even though I got OR'd, I was so

1 stressed out I started drinking heavily, and getting into drugs
2 again, to try to combat this serious case over my head and
3 looking at going back to prison, it was just overwhelming. I
4 fell off the wagon again.

5 Since I been incarcerated and been in treatment, I've
6 got a proper diagnosis. They finally gave me a rim rod (sic) it's
7 this medication for PTSD. It helps me sleep.

8 I was having flashbacks from this event, nightmares and
9 things. One time I was awake for five days straight, so they
10 finally got me on the right medications.

11 And I just want to say how grateful I am that we have a
12 program in Nye County, finally, called Serenity Mental Health,
13 because I didn't have that during the whole manslaughter thing.

14 I had gone through a traumatic experience and there was
15 no --

16 THE COURT: I need you to wind it up.

17 THE DEFENDANT: There was no help there. I'm trying to
18 get the help that I can with what I can. And I hope you will
19 give me the chance. And a two to five, or two to six, and then
20 going to counseling after, if these other options that you're
21 weighing, I'm just trying to give you a third option.

22 Thank you.

23 THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. Helfrich. Do you have any
24 legal cause to show, Mr. Neely, why this sentence should not be

1 imposed?

2 MR. NEELY: No, Your Honor I do not.

3 THE COURT: I've got a few things to say before I
4 impose the sentence.

5 Mr. Helfrich, a couple things. While you were
6 incarcerated, for you to seek out and participate in this program
7 I think is probably the most important thing that's happened to
8 you since I've known you, which is now quite a while. So, I'm
9 glad for that. That's a good thing.

10 There were lots of bad choices made that night, and
11 there wasn't just the one, but there were lots of them. And what
12 you are being sentenced for, just so you understand, is not the
13 reaction to what you perceived to be happening at the house where
14 the lady lived, it's what you did with the car, assaulting,
15 battering the other car and the people in it.

16 I just want to make it clear what the important part of
17 this is to me. The rest of it is important also, but that's the
18 event for which you are being sentenced.

19 So, enough said. There being no legal cause
20 established, it is the Judgment of the Court that you are, in
21 fact, guilty of the offense of Battery With the Use of a Deadly
22 Weapon, a Category B felony.

23 It is the Judgment of this Court that you are, in fact,
24 guilty of that charge. In accordance with the laws in the State

1 of Nevada, I do now sentence you as follows:

2 In addition to the \$25 administrative assessment fee,
3 and whatever fees are necessary to be imposed, there's a three
4 dollar administrative assessment, DNA administrative assessment.
5 I doubt if there's a \$150 DNA analysis fee, DNA fee. But, since
6 nobody from P and P is here, I can't know that for sure, because
7 his DNA was undoubtedly taken last time.

8 I know there was a discussion of restitution early on,
9 but all I've got is somebody's estimate of a damage figure, and
10 that's insufficient for me to order restitution.

11 So, Mr. Helfrich, you're not going to be granted
12 probation.

13 You will be sentenced to a term of six years in the
14 Nevada State Prison with a minimum parole eligibility of two
15 years, and you will be given credit for 102 days served, unless a
16 higher number is developed by P and P following this Imposition
17 of Sentence.

18 Important to my decision is the fact that Mr. Helfrich
19 has never been on probation. He has had innumerable
20 opportunities to seek out the kind of counseling that he has
21 finally sought out, and didn't choose to do that while he was not
22 incarcerated.

23 I understand that the drug and alcohol issues and those
24 need to be addressed as well.

1 The reason I am putting kind of a long tail on it, that
2 is two to six, that is in hopes that when you are paroled, you
3 will have a pretty substantial parole tail, because that will
4 give you access to the Serenity program.

5 And I really hope that you take advantage of that, and
6 that I don't see you here again.

7 Gentlemen, I don't every day do sentencings anymore.
8 Have I covered everything that needs to be covered?

9 MR. VITTO: Yes, Your Honor.

10 MR. NEELY: I agree, Your Honor. You got it all.

11 THE COURT: That will be the Order. And the defendant
12 is remanded to the custody of the Nye County Sheriff.

13 THE DEFENDANT: Thank you, Judge. After I get out, I
14 am going to go right into that program for you. Can I let you
15 know?

16 THE COURT: Show me, don't tell me. Take care, sir.
17 (Whereupon proceedings concluded at 11:00 a.m.)
