*ORDER GRANTING MOTION*

Nevada Attorneys for Criminal Justice (NACJ) has filed a motion for leave to file an amicus curiae brief in support of respondent. NRAP 29(c). No opposition has been filed.

NACJ is a Nevada domestic non-profit organization comprised of approximately 250 private and public criminal defense attorneys. It asserts that it therefore has a material interest in the outcome of this litigation, as nearly all of the clients of its members face the prospect of civil forfeiture proceedings. It asserts that it has experience and expertise on these matters and that it can provide a unique and comprehensive perspective on how this court's decision will affect the criminal justice system more broadly.
