## **MEMORANDUM**

I, JOHN AFSHAR, am a duly licensed attorney in the State of Nevada and am employed by the Clark County District Attorney's Office.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due November 6, 2023. This is a direct appeal from a judgment of conviction following a jury trial. This Court may extend time to file a Respondent's Answering Brief upon a showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3).

The State herein makes its first request for an enlargement of time. Appellant's Opening Brief was filed October 5, 2023, along with an appendix spanning 11 volumes and nearly 3,000 pages.
