





ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Appellant has filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix. Respondents have filed an opposition, and appellant has filed a reply. Cause appearing, appellant's motion is granted. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Appellant shall have until December 27, 2023, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. No further extensions of time shall be permitted absent demonstration of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 376, 528 P.2d 1027, 1028-29 (1974). Failure to timely file the opening brief and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 31(d).
