

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

This is an appeal identifying an order modifying child custody after a hearing held March 11, 2022. Preliminary review of the docketing statement and the documents submitted to this court pursuant to NRAP 3(g) reveals a potential jurisdictional defect. Specifically, it appears that a subsequent order was filed May 18, 2022, setting forth detailed findings of fact and conclusions of law and an order resolving countermotions to modify custody arising from hearings held March 10, 11, and 21, 2022. Accordingly, it appears that the order appellant challenges is not the district court's final decision, and appellant has not appealed from the final decision on the motion to modify entered May 18, 2022.

Accordingly, appellant shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Failure to demonstrate that this court has jurisdiction may result in this court's dismissal of this appeal. The deadlines for filing documents in this appeal shall be suspended pending further order of this court. Respondent may file any reply within 14 days from the date that appellant's response is served.

It is so ORDERED.
