



ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

James Howard Hayes, Jr., appeals from an order of the district court denying a “motion for credit, presentence confinement served; applied to sentence” filed on August 10, 2022. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Monica Trujillo, Judge.

Because no statute or court rule permits an appeal from an order denying a “motion for credit, presentence confinement served; applied to sentence,” this court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal. See *Castillo v. State*, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990) (“We have consistently held that the right to appeal is statutory; where no statutory authority to appeal is granted, no right to appeal exists.”). Accordingly, we

ORDER this appeal DISMISSED.
