ORDER REINSTATING BRIEFING

Pursuant to NRAP 16, the settlement judge has filed a report with this court indicating that the parties were unable to agree to a settlement. Accordingly, we reinstate the deadlines for requesting transcripts and filing briefs. *See* NRAP 16.

Appellants/cross-respondents (appellants) and respondent/cross-appellant (cross-appellant) shall each have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a transcript request form. If no transcript is to be requested, appellants and cross-appellant shall file and serve a certificate to that effect within the same time period. *See* NRAP 9(a).

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA Appellants shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix on appeal. In preparing and assembling the appendix, counsel shall strictly comply with the provisions of NRAP 30.

Respondents shall have 30 days from service of appellants' opening brief to file and serve an answering brief on appeal. See NRAP 32(a)(1)(B). Cross-appellant shall have 30 days from service of appellants' opening brief on appeal to file and serve a combined answering brief on appeal and opening brief on cross-appeal. See NRAP 28.1(c)(2), (f)(1)(B).

Appellants shall have 30 days from service of the last filed brief to file and serve a combined reply brief on appeal and answering brief on cross-appeal. See NRAP 28.1(c)(3), (f)(1)(C).

Cross-appellant shall have 14 days from service of appellants' combined brief to file and serve a reply brief on cross-appeal, if deemed necessary. See NRAP 28.1(f)(1)(D).
