It appears that this Court's consideration of amending the rules relating to attorney misconduct presents an opportunity to discuss whether the proceedings can¹ be subject to electronic coverage. It might be assistive to the State Bar for this Court to, if appropriate, expressly provide language that subjects disciplinary proceedings to the SCR 230(2) electronic coverage presumption.

When the Commission on Judicial Discipline allowed electronic coverage of its proceedings, a remarkable number of judges reached out in appreciation; aside from the public benefit, there is apparently an intense interest by the bench as to how their disciplinary proceedings are conducted, and judges were too busy to make time to sit in and observe disciplinary proceedings. It is likely that many lawyers, too, are interested in how their own disciplinary proceedings function.

I have more detailed feedback and information available, if it is of interest to this Court.
