*ORDER REGARDING STIPULATION AND MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPENING BRIEF AND APPENDIX*

On August 9, 2023, respondent Get Fresh Sales, Inc., filed a renewed motion to dismiss this appeal for lack of jurisdiction, and on September 15, 2023, appellants filed a response in opposition. Get Fresh Sales has filed its reply. Thereafter, on October 24, 2023, appellants filed a stipulation extending the time to file the opening brief and appendix until November 27, 2023, and on November 27, appellants filed an unopposed motion for an extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix.
