

# ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S FEBRUARY 20, 2023 MOTION FOR **CLARIFICATION AND FEBRUARY 28, 2023 MOTION FOR A STAY PURSUANT TO** EDCR 5.503(a) and GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S MARCH 11, 2023 COUNTERMOTION AND **VACATING APIRL 24, 2023 HEARING**

This is a post-judgment divorce proceeding reassigned to this judicial department on April 29, 2021 due to the recusal of the judicial officer in Department J. This case has been the subject of thirteen (13) appeals, some deriving from decisions made in Department J and some from this Department. All existing appeals have been resolved and no new appeals are pending at this time.

This Court exercises authority granted it pursuant to NRCP 1 and EDCR 1.10 which provide district court dockets shall be administered to secure speedy, efficient and inexpensive determinations in every action. This Court exercises discretion granted it pursuant to EDCR 2.23(c) to decide this matter without recourse to oral argument. Accordingly, the Court ORDERS the April 24, 2023 hearing VACATED.

Having reviewed the papers and pleadings before it and, good cause appearing, this Court issues its findings and orders.

This matter is scheduled for hearing on April 24, 2023 on Defendant Wilbert (Wilbert) Roy Holmes' February 20, 2023 Motion for Clarification and February 28, 2023 Motion for a Stay. Attached to Wilbert's February 20, 2023 Motion for Clarification was a Certificate of Service by mail to Plaintiff Capucine (Capucine) Yolanda Holmes' court-listed attorney William Heaton. On March 6, 2023, Capucine filed her Opposition and Countermotion to Wilbert's February 20, 2023 motion.

Attached to Wilbert's February 28, 2023 Motion for Stay was a Certificate of Service by mail to an address other than attorney Heaton's court-listed address. Notwithstanding the service defect, on March 11, 2023, Capucine filed her Opposition and Countermotion to Wilbert's February 28, 2023 motion. On March 12, 2023, Wilbert filed his Reply.

This is a post-judgment divorce proceeding wherein Capucine was granted \$100,862.73 as for her interest in the marital residence located at 10550 Patrington Court (Martial Residence), Las Vegas, Nevada following a two-day non-jury bench trial. See Decree of Divorce at p.9, ll.1-14 (filed June 1, 2017). The Decree of Divorce further granted Capucine a lien on the Marital Residence in the awarded sum. Id. at p.9, ll.1-7. On June 8, 2017, Wilbert filed a Notice of Appeal. Following a May 31, 2018 Order of Reversal and Remand, this Court entered an Order upon Remand Clarifying Decree of Divorce (filed June 12, 2018). In the Order, the Court found a math error at page 6 with a correct figure listed a page 7. See Order at p.1, ll.19-22 (filed June 12, 2018). The Court additionally found Capucine's equity in the Marital Residence, as stated in the Decree of Divorce, correct. Id. at p.1, ll.23-24. In the intervening period, Wilbert has filed an additional twelve (12) appeals related to this matter.

In his February 20, 2023 Motion for Clarification, Wilbert requested the Court to rehear the entire divorce matter based on his narrative and attached exhibits wherein he claims

Capucine, who he refers to as "the Devil Woman", was not entitled to the divorce decree award based upon the former judicial officer, Deidre Butler and/or Rena Hughes, being her "personal friend." Wilbert contends, as he has in prior pleadings before this Court, that Capucine has false professional credentials, has been charged with Battery Domestic Violence, has a deviant, magnetic personality, and engaged in multiple infidelities. Wilbert additionally contends he has inoperable brain cancer and has been deemed a vexatious litigant.

On February 20, 2023, attorney Jeffrey A. Cogan filed a Notice of Disassociation of Pleading filed by Wilbert on February 20, 2023. In the pleading, attorney Cogan stated he declined to prepare any argument on Wilbert's behalf that would violate NRCP 11. See Cogan Notice at p.2, 1l.2-17 (filed February 20, 2023). Attorney Cogan stated he agreed to file a pleading before the Court that complied with this Court's January 3, 2023 Minutes taking Wilbert's originally filed but legally defective motion off calendar. Attorney Cogan stated Wilbert nonetheless filed his February 20, 2023 Motion for Clarification in pro se status and against his professional advice. <u>Id.</u> at p.2, ll.6-17.

Also on February 20, 2023, Wilbert filed what appears to be a response to attorney Cogan's Notice wherein he asserts the attorney failed to do his job. <u>See</u> Wilbert's Notice of Disassociation at p.1, ll.26-28 (filed February 20, 2023).

In her March 6, 2023 Opposition to Wilbert's Motion for Clarification, Capucine set forth the history of this case including the various appeals. Capucine requested the Court deny Wilbert's motion where relitigation of the divorce action is not available to Wilbert at this stage of the proceedings. Capucine further alleged Wilbert's motion is not properly supported by the facts presented or law. Specifically, Capucine alleged Wilbert failed to provide reference to statutes, court rules or case authorities in support of his requested relief. Capucine also argued

Wilbert's motion does not meet the requirements of EDCR 5.503. In sum, Capucine alleged Wilbert's motion is untimely and seeks to re-litigate orders long since deemed final.

Next, Capucine alleged that, to the extent, Wilbert's motion constitutes a motion for reconsideration, it is clearly untimely under EDCR 5.513 and must be denied. Capucine alleged Wilbert failed to identify any statute or court rule under which this Court would have the power or authority to revisit or modify orders that have been adjudicated and affirmed on appeal or are otherwise now final.

In his February 28, 2023 Motion for Stay, Wilbert requested the Court grant a stay of this Court's orders dated June 1, 2017, December 16, 2019 and February 2, 2020. Wilbert alleged a stay is appropriate because he will present serious legal questions which, absent a stay, will result in irreparable injury to him. Wilbert alleged Capucine's current attorney has been coordinating and invading his property at 10550 Patrington Ct LV, NV 89183causing damages to the structure by changing all door locks and taking items from the property as well as other invasive acts. Wilbert alleged Capucine's previous attorney held back true facts and committed perjury. Wilbert alleged Capucine and her attorney interfered with his legal listing contract and legally signed purchase offers in November 2019 and February 2021. Wilbert alleged Capucine and her attorney lied to the Court by asserted Wilbert's home wasn't listed. Wilbert alleged he has a very strong good buyer in escrow (referencing a November 2019 residential sale contract). Wilbert alleged the buyer has the purchase offer contract rights signed to buy his home with a \$20,000.00 earnest deposit in Chicago Title (alleging a current residential sale contract but for dates of November 2019 to June 2020). Wilbert alleged Capucine are blocking his home sale and trying to get him in contempt of court by telling the Court Wilbert did not try to sell his home (referencing arguments before former Judge Rene Hughes). Wilbert alleged his home

could have been sold early in March 2021. The Court FINDS Wilbert has argued, in previous pleadings, that he has a verified purchaser for the former marital residence. Notwithstanding these previously considered arguments, the Court FINDS Wilbert provided no documentation in support of his representation the Marital Residence is currently under contact.

In her March 11, 2023 Opposition, Capucine alleged the Court's February 4, 2020 Order grants Capucine the sole authority to sell the Patrington Court (Marital Residence) residence as well as "authority to execute any and all documents necessary to cause a sale of the Residence." Capucine alleged that, when Wilbert's tenants moved out of the residence in late January or early February 2023, the realtor was able to procure a key for the residence, but the lock box containing that key was subsequently removed and stolen. Capucine alleged as a result of that theft, it was necessary for Capucine to re-key the Marital Residence locks in order to obtain access and show the residence to prospective purchasers. Capucine alleged a second lock box was removed and stolen.

Capucine alleged on information and belief, Wilbert caused the residence to be re-keyed without notice and without providing the listing realtor a key in what appears to be efforts to thwart the sale of the residence. Capucine alleged the Patrington residence is now under contract for sale for the sum of \$1,150,000. Capucine alleged the residence is "under water" in that the sale price will not satisfy the currently existing encumbrances against the residence, but Capucine has procured agreements from the holder of the first trust deed encumbering the residence to postpone its pending foreclosure sale, and from another lienholder to join with Capucine in waiving a portion of their respective liens, in order to facilitate the closing of the sale of the residence.

Capucine alleged Wilbert has no equity in the Patrington Residence and his motion for

stay is an attempt to preclude Capucine from realizing any recovery on her judgment against Wilbert. Capucine alleged she has procured a preliminary title report for the Patrington Court residence and, after review of that report, Capucine's counsel estimated as of February 10, 2023, a sales price of approximately \$1,275,000 to \$1,300,00 would have been required for the residence to be sold without the necessity of concessions from lienholders. Capucine alleged Wilbert has no equity in the residence, yet Wilbert continues to attempt to interfere with and delay any sale of the residence. Capucine further alleged Wilbert's motion is not properly supported pursuant to EDCR 5.503. Capucine alleged there are no references to statutes, court rules or case authorities which authorize the relief Wilbert seeks. Capucine also argued the motion does not identify any facts which support Wilbert's cause. Capucine alleged Wilbert's motion is untimely and seeks to re-litigate orders and dispositions which are long since final. In her countermotion, Capucine requested Wilbert be designated as a Vexatious Litigant or alternatively an order to show cause should be entered requiring Wilbert to appear and show cause why he should not be designated as a vexatious litigant in this case.

On March 12, 2023, Wilbert filed his Reply to Capucine's Oppositions and Countermotions.

EDCR 5.503(a) states, in pertinent parts, as follows:

(a) Every motion, opposition, countermotion, and reply shall include points and authorities supporting each position asserted and an affidavit supporting all factual averments. Points and authorities lacking citation to relevant authority, or consisting of bare citations to statutes, rules or case authority, do not comply with this rule. The absence or deficiency of points and authorities may be construed as an admission that the filing is not meritorious, or as cause for denial of all positions not supported.

The Court FINDS both of Wilbert's motions are legally deficient where the pleadings are wholly devoid of points and authorities supporting each position asserted and neither motion contains the required affidavit supporting all factual averments. The Court further FINDS there

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is no statutory or rule supporting his request for a stay in this matter where no appeal has been filed. See generally NRAP 8(c). The Court FINDS the last appeal, case number 84812-COA. was denied by Order of Affirmance filed on January 13, 2023. Therefore, the Court DENIES Wilbert's request for a stay in this matter.

Accordingly, good cause appearing, the Court DENIES Wilbert's February 20, 2023 and February 28, 2023 motions as legally deficient pursuant to EDCR 5.503(a).

The Court FINDS Wilbert was previously deemed a vexatious litigant on or about May 18, 2020 in A-17-760443-C; A-19-790299-C; A-19-795057-C; A-19-795917-C; A-19-796138-C; A-19-796333-C; A-19-796526-C; A-19-805847-C; and A-20-809415-C. See Decision and Order (filed May 18, 2020)(in listed referenced cases).

The Court FINDS Capucine, in her March 11, 2023 countermotion, requests this Court adopt the May 18, 2020 Decision and Order finding Wilbert to be a vexatious litigant. For the reasons set forth below, the Court GRANTS Capucine's countermotion.

The Court FINDS one of the listed cases, Wilbert Holmes v. Judge Rena Hughes, A-19-796333-C, is related to the captioned divorce proceeding. In the Decision and Order, the Court found as follows:

"Several of Mr. Holmes complaints are also abusive because the complaints are filed with the intent to harass his ex-wife, Capucine Holmes. Three of Mr. Holmes' complaints accuse his ex-wife, or persons associated with his ex-wife, of adultery and attempt to use the alleged adultery as the basis of his [intentional infliction of emotional distress] claim. Mr. Holmes' complaints contain explicit details of the alleged adultery. Again, even if true, adultery is not a basis for a civil action. Mr. Holmes' repeated complaints alleging adultery serve no purpose but to harass Capucine Holmes and her alleged associates."

<u>Id</u>. at p.15, ll.1-7.

Following its findings, the Court set forth restrictions in order for Wilbert to file pro se pleadings before the Eighth Judicial District Court. Id. at p.15, Il.13-28 and p.16, Il.1-6. This

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Court is a specialty division of the Eighth Judicial District Court. The Court FINDS Wilbert is listed as a vexatious litigant on the Nevada Administrative Office of Court's Vexatious Litigant List wherein the Eight Judicial District Court is listed as the determining Court. See https://nvcourts.gov/\_\_data/assets/pdf\_file/0023/13496/Vexatious\_Litigant\_03.09.23.pdf (last accessed March 14, 2023).

Accordingly, because this Court is part of the Eighth Judicial District Court, the Court FINDS good cause to accept the findings made in the May 18, 2020 Decision and Order deeming DEFENDANT WILBERT ROY HOLMES a vexatious litigant. Therefore, Wilbert is required to adhere to the restrictions contained in the May 18, 2020 Decision and Order, if acting in pro se capacity, prior to filing any further motions with this Court. See Decision and Order at p. p.15, ll.13-28 and p.16, ll.1-6. Failure to abide by these restrictions, shall result in any filed matter being taken off calendar.

The Court ORDERS the April 24, 2023 hearing VACATED.

The case SHALL be returned to CLOSED STATUS.

has no undue influence over Judge Rena Hughes, and there is no basis to change venue as Defendant asserts. See, SCR 2.11.

Defendant s Motion for Change of Venue is devoid of legal points and authorities, and does not meet the requirements of EDCR 2.20. Even if Defendant had cited to the appropriate statute or rule, the Court finds no basis for a change in venue. Both parties reside in Clark County, Nevada, the forum is convenient, and there is no obstacle to a fair and impartial trial. See, NRS 13.040 and 13.050.

Defendant s Motion is DENIED, and the hearing of September 21, 2016 is VACATED.

The Court finds that a notice of appeal divests this Court of jurisdiction to act and vests the jurisdiction in the appellate court. Rust v. Clark Cty. School District, 103 Nev. 686, 688, 747 P.2d 1380, 1382 (1987).

As this case was appealed to the Court of Appeals and the District Court no longer has jurisdiction to hear this matter, the Court is hereby vacating the Order to Show Cause hearing and Plaintiff's Motion without prejudice.

Holmes, case number 83229 (Nevada Supreme Court), indicates no matter pending decision and/or due date of January 17 as alleged by Wilbert. The Court FINDS the docket for case number 83229 last lists a January 11, 2022 Case Update Status indicating "Briefing Completed/Submitted for Decision/To Screening". Thus, absent any other information in Wilbert's January 11, 2022 Motion for Stay or his Ex parte Application, the Court FINDS Wilbert's "time sensitive" assertion inaccurate if not outright false.

Accordingly, good cause appearing, the Court ORDERS and denies Wilbert's Ex parte Application for Order Shortening Time. The Court anticipates the Clerk of the Court will issue a Notice of Hearing for Wilbert's January 11, 2022 Motion for Stay Pending Appeal which will schedule the motion for hearing in ordinary course.
