ORDER SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING

On March 22, 2023, Lidia S. Stiglich, Chief Justice of the Nevada Supreme Court, and Lynne K. Simons, Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District filed a petition seeking to amend Supreme Court Rule 214 to provide an attorney legislator serving in the Nevada Legislature an exemption from the annual requirement to complete 10 hours of general continuing legal education credit for the compliance period in which the attorney serves in a regular Session of the Legislature.
