



*ORDER TO FILE TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM AND AMENDED
DOCKETING STATEMENT*

On May 31, 2023, this court entered an order directing appellant to file and serve a transcript request form by June 14, 2023. If no transcript is to be requested, appellant was to file and serve a certificate to that effect within the same time period. *See* NRAP 9(a). To date, appellant has failed to comply or otherwise communicate with this court.

Appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to serve and file, in this court, a file-stamped copy of the transcript request form filed in the district court. *See* NRAP 9(a)(3). If no transcript is to be requested, appellant shall file a certificate to that effect in this court within the same time period. *See* NRAP 9(a)(1)(C). Failure to timely comply may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 9(a)(7).

Review of appellant's docketing statement reveals that it is deficient. Appellant did not provide a complete response to Item 23 and did not attach file-stamped copies of all orders resolving claims in the underlying matter.

Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve an amended docketing statement. Failure to timely comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 14(c).

It is so ORDERED.
