Department of Corrections (NDC) and is not present.

This is the time set for hearing on the above-named motions, which the Deft. filed pro se.

Deft.'s Motion for Leave to File Affidavit and Request for Issuance of Writ of Execution: Court noted
that it reviewed the file in this matter. The Deft. was tried before a Jury in January 2002 and convicted
of Count 1 - Attempt Sexual Assault with a Minor Under Fourteen; Count 2 - Sexual Assault with a
Minor Under Fourteen; Count 3, was NOT GUILTY. Deft. appealed the Judgment of Conviction
(JOC) in 2003; the Supreme Court AFFIRMED with LIMITED REMAND. The JOC incorrectly
indicated that Deft. pled guilty when he was actually convicted by a jury so the matter was remanded
for correction of the JOC. An Amended JOC was prepared and filed on February 9, 2005.

The Deft. filed a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus in 2010, it was DENIED; a Supplement to the Writ was filed in 2011, it was DENIED. On December 2, 2013, the Deft. filed another Writ and appealed the denial; it was AFFIRMED by the Supreme Court in September 2014. The Deft. was challenging the conditions of his confinement. The Supreme Court determined that a Writ of Habeas Corpus was not the proper vehicle to raise such a claim. On September 17, 2015, the Deft. filed a Petition for Writ of Mandamus; the matter was reassigned to Department VIII in November 2015. In May 2016, the Supreme Court issued an Order of Affirmance; Deft. failed to demonstrate that he was entitled to relief through mandamus or prohibition. The Deft. then filed a Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, or Correct an Illegal Sentence; it was denied; the Order was filed December 1, 2016. The Deft. is appealing said ruling. COURT ORDERED, the Motion is DENIED.

Motion for Sanctions and Finding of Contempt: Court noted that said motion is uncognizable and the Deft. has failed to state a reason for his position; therefore, COURT ORDERED, the Motion is DENIED.

Deft. has filed a Supplemental Motion for Sanctions and Finding of Contempt, it is set to be heard on August 21, 2017; however, the Court has reviewed this motion as well and since the Deft. has not stated a reason for his position, COURT ORDERED, said Motion is ADVANCED and DENIED.
