## ORDER CONSOLIDATING APPEALS, REMOVING FROM SETTLEMENT PROGRAM AND REINSTATING BRIEFING

Appellant shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve a single opening brief and appendix that addresses all issues raised in these appeals. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance
