# State of Nevada Board of Parole Commissioners PAROLE AGREEMENT

<u>DWIGHT SOLANDER</u> was sentenced in the State of Nevada to imprisonment in the Nevada Department of Corrections for the crime of <u>CT. I, II, III-CHILD ABUSE WITH SUBSTANTIAL BODILY HARM</u>. The Board of Parole Commissioners, by virtue of the authority vested in it by the laws of the State of Nevada, hereby authorizes the Director of the Department of Corrections to allow said <u>DWIGHT SOLANDER</u> on the <u>26<sup>TH</sup> day of FEBRUARY</u>, <u>2021</u>, or as soon thereafter as a satisfactory program can be arranged and approved by the Division of Parole and Probation, to go upon parole outside the prison buildings and enclosure, subject to the following conditions:

#### Parole Conditions

- \* You must complete a Mental Health assessment within 30 days of release from NDOC. Participate in treatment as instructed until released by a qualified treatment provider.
- \* Directives: You shall follow the rules of the Division of Parole and Probation to include the following: \*A. You shall not change your place of residence without first obtaining permission from the Division of Parole and Probation.
- \* B. You shall report in person to the Division of Parole and Probation as instructed by the Division or its agent. You shall submit a written report each month on forms supplied by the Division. This report shall be true and correct in all respects.
- \* C. You shall seek and maintain legal employment, or maintain a program approved by the Division of Parole and Probation and not change such employment or program without first obtaining permission. All terminations of employment or program shall be immediately reported to the Division.
- \* D. You shall pay any court ordered restitution by making payments until the balance is paid in full. The minimum monthly payment shall be established by dividing the balance owed at the time of release on parole by the number of projected months to be served on parole. If, after dividing the total restitution owed by the number of projected months to be served on parole the monthly payment is equal to an amount less than \$50, the monthly payment shall be \$50 until the balance is paid in full.
- \* E. Pay all applicable fines and fees on a schedule determined by the Division of Parole and Probation.
- \* F. You shall not leave the state without first obtaining written permission from the Division of Parole and Probation.
- \* G. You shall not associate with convicted felons, persons who are engaged in criminal activity, or other persons with whom your supervising officer instructs you not to associate.
- \* H. You shall follow all the directives of your assigned Parole Officer.
- \* I. You shall satisfy any outstanding warrants within 90 days of your release from custody.
- \* Controlled substances: You shall not use, purchase or possess any illegal drugs, or any prescription drugs, unless first prescribed by a licensed medical professional. You shall immediately notify the Division of Parole and Probation of any prescription received. You shall refrain from the use and possession of any synthetic/designer drug or any mind and/or body altering substance. You shall submit to drug testing as required by the Division or its agent.
- \* Recreational Marijuana: You shall not purchase, consume or have under your control marijuana in any form, except when such use is prescribed for use as a medicine in accordance with the provisions of chapter 453A of NRS.
- \* Intoxicants: You shall not purchase, consume or have under your control any alcohol beverage, unless specifically permitted by special condition of the Board. Upon the direction of the Division of Parole and Probation or other peace officer, you shall submit to a medically recognized test for blood/breath content.
- \* Weapons: You shall not possess, have access to, or have under your control, any type of weapon unless the item is used in conjunction with the duties of legitimate employment and has been approved in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation or its agent.
- \* Laws: You shall comply with all institutional rules, municipal, county, state, and federal laws and ordinances.
- \* Conduct: You shall comply with all the provisions stated on the parole agreement and your conduct shall justify the opportunity granted to you by this community supervision.
- \* No Victim Contact: You may not contact or communicate with the victim or any person directly and proximately harmed by the commission of a criminal offense under any law of this State, or solicit another person to contact or communicate on your behalf with the victim or any person directly and proximately harmed by the commission of a criminal offense under any law of this State unless approved in writing by the Division of Parole and Probation.

Credits: You shall receive no credit on this sent during any period of time that you are absent from vervision and deemed to be an absconder. The projected parole expiration date assed upon the assumption that you will earn the max. um number of credits available to be earned while on parole. If you fail to work and/or program diligently, fail to keep current with any payments toward restitution and supervision fees or fail to comply with the terms of parole, you may not receive the additional credits off your sentence that have been projected on this document. The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) is responsible for calculating and applying credits to the sentences of inmates and parolees. The projected parole expiration date on this document is subject to change based on credit earnings and/or adjustments as determined by the NDOC. Credits for good time earned on parole may be forfeited if you are found guilty of a violation. Pursuant to NRS 213.15185, all good time credits previously earned to reduce your sentence are forfeited upon revocation of parole.

This parole is granted to and accepted by you, subject to the conditions stated herein, and with the knowledge that the Board of Parole Commissioners has the power, at any time, in case of violation of the conditions of parole to cause your detention and/or return to prison.

DECLARATION OF LIEUTENANT KYLE STEWART

### I, LIEUTENANT KYLE STEWART, state that:

- 1. I am employed by the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Nevada State Police, Division of Parole and Probation. I have held the position of Lieutenant since March 2020. In total I have worked for the Department of Public Safety, Nevada State Police, Division of Parole and Probation since July 2002. In my capacity as a twenty-year employee, I have knowledge of the parole and probation processes.
- 2. I make this Declaration in support of the Department of Public Safety, Division of Parole and Probation's Answer to the Petition for Emergency Writ of Mandamus Under NRAP 27E in the above-captioned matter identified as Case No. 86614. I have read and am familiar with the allegations stated in Mr. Solander's emergency writ. Additionally, I have personal knowledge of the facts in the Declaration, except those matters stated upon information and belief, and as to those matters, I believe them to be true, and if called upon to testify, I could and would do so.

- Mr. Solander was granted parole on November 25, 2020, with an effective date,
   "When Eligible." Ex. A, Ord. Grnt. Parole, attached hereto.
- 4. The Board of Parole Commissioners Conditions of Parole Supervision include,
  "E. Pay all applicable fines and fees on a schedule determined by the Division of Parole and Probation." Id. at p. 2.
- 5. Mr. Solander's parole began on or about February 26, 2021, with an anticipated expiration date of August 24, 2023. Ex. "B", Parole Agreement dated March 4, 2021.
- 6. The Parole Agreement executed by Mr. Solander on March 4, 2021, includes the condition, "E. Pay all applicable fines and fees on a schedule determined by the Division of Parole and Probation. Id.
- 7. On March 4, 2021, Mr. Solander also executed acknowledgment of his outstanding Court Ordered Fees in the amount of \$178.00, which included instructions of where and how to make payment. Ex. "C", Solander, Dwight Court Ordered Fees/Fines.
- 8. On or about May 26, 2023, I personally telephoned the Clerk of the Eighth Judicial District Court and confirmed the \$178.00 in court fees from the time of sentencing were unpaid.
- In my review of Mr. Solander's file, I reviewed Solander's spreadsheet of supervision transaction fees. Ex. "D", Solander, Dwight, OTIS – Supervision Fee Transactions.
- 10.Mr. Solander's Supervision Fee Transactions indicates Solander has been in

violation of condition "E" of his Parole Agreement in 22 of 28 months since March 2021. Id. Between August 2021 and July 2022, Mr. Solander was in violation of condition "E" of his Parole Agreement each month until July 19, 2022, when he made payment to bring his balance to zero. Id. Since August 2022, Mr. Solander has been in violation of condition "E" of his Parole Agreement for at least six (6) months.

- 11. Mr. Solander has never been granted a waiver of his supervision fees as contemplated under NRS 213.1076 (2) or (3) and NAC 213.230.
- 12. On June 7, 2023, I received written communication from the Nevada Department of Corrections indicating Mr. Solander has a projected expiration date of August 18, 2023, for case C-14-299737-1, count 1-3.
- 13. I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of the State of Nevada that the foregoing is true and correct.
