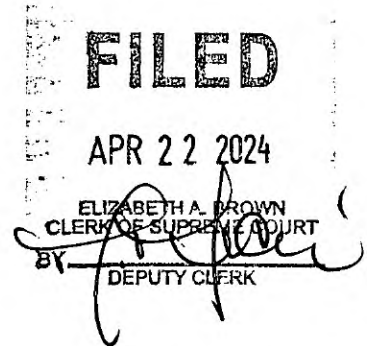

ORDER CONDITIONALLY IMPOSING SANCTIONS

On February 13, 2024, this court issued an order reinstating briefing. That order, among other things, directed appellant, through its counsel Clarence Gamble, to file and serve a transcript request form or certificate that no transcripts will be requested by February 27, 2024. Mr. Gamble failed to comply. On April 5, 2024, this court issued an order again instructing Mr. Gamble to file a transcript request form or certificate that no transcripts are being requested by April 12, 2024, or face sanctions. To date, Mr. Gamble has failed to comply.

Mr. Gamble's failure to file the transcript request form or certificate that no transcripts are requested warrants the conditional imposition of sanctions. Mr. Gamble shall pay the sum of \$250 to the Supreme Court Law Library and provide this court with proof of such payment within 7 days from the date of this order. The conditional sanction will be automatically vacated if Mr. Gamble files and serves the transcript

request form or certificate that no transcripts are being requested within 7 days from the date of this order.

If the required document is not timely filed, the sanctions will no longer be conditional and must be paid. Failure to comply with this order or any other filing deadlines may result in the dismissal of this appeal. See NRAP 9(a)(7). Further, because it appears Mr. Gamble's conduct in this appeal may constitute violations of RPC 1.3 (diligence), 3.2(a) (expediting litigation), and 8.4 (misconduct), failure to comply with this order or any other filing deadlines may also result in Mr. Gamble's referral to the State Bar of Nevada for investigation pursuant to SCR 104-105.

It is so ORDERED.
