(SECOND REQUEST)

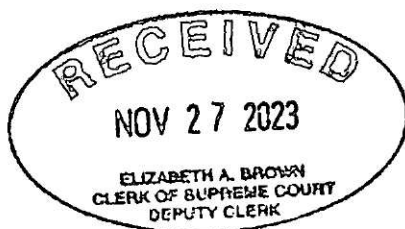
COMES NOW, Appellant, Amy Luciano, appearing in pro se, hereby requests that this court enter an order extending time to submit her Opening Brief (second request).

1 Due to being sick with covid, Appellant hasn't been able to adduce the entire
2 underlying record since is only using a Record on Appeal Index and available
3 Hearing Transcripts, however, Judge Perry has filed additional orders without
4 holding a hearing at district court.
5

6
7 In fact, service hasn't been properly effectuated of recent orders filed on
8 September 19, 2023, September 20, 2023, and November 16, 2023, knowing that
9 Appellant has remained steadfast that a stipulation didn't occur on November 7,
10 2019, September 16, 2020, August 29, 2022, and January 6, 2023, and that a
11 lawyer was supposed to appear on November 7, 2019, and August 29, 2022.

14 Appellant had asked during the hearing held on September 16, 2020, to have
15 a continuance since service hadn't been effectuated of Respondent Frank
16 Luciano's Opposition and Countermotion filed on August 3, 2020.
17

18 Appellant has also filed NRCP 62 Motions at district court on November 12,
19 2023, in which an Order was filed on November 16, 2023, however service wasn't
20 effectuated since only a Notice of Submission was received (See Exhibit 2 attached
21 hereto) and the Notice of Entry didn't have service effectuated on November 16,
22 2023.

1 II. Legal Argument

2 A. This court should grant Appellant's Motion to extend time to file
3 Appellant's Opening Brief for 14-days due no later than December 4, 2023.
4

5 NRAP 31(3) states that a motion for extension of time for filing a brief may
6 be made no later than the due date for the brief and must comply with the
7 provisions of this Rule and Rule 27.
8

9 However, Appellant has been diagnosed with leukemia, osteomyelitis of jaw,
10 has a mass in her left thyroid, and was re-diagnosed with covid on September 25,
11 2023 (See Exhibit 1 attached hereto).
12

13 Further, Respondent Frank Luciano has put Appellant into a dire financial
14 position knowing there is a disparity of income, Appellant wasn't ever afforded
15 equal footing during any hearings held prior to the filing of this appeal, and
16 Respondent Frank Luciano committed perjury in Family Court on May 19, 2020.

19 On November 20, 2023, Respondent Frank Luciano sent email messages
20 alleging this will continue and has attempted to force an unreasonable settlement
21 since he has proceeded with a criminal stance, even though knew I was extremely
22 sick with covid on September 16, 2020.
