THE COURT: Show the appearance of Mr. Vitto on behalf of the state. This is the time set for sentencing in this case. There have been a couple of presentence reports made. I take it you both have received both of them.

One was prepared June 8th, 2021, and the second or the amended or supplemental was prepared June 21st, 2021. And the only change I see in that one is that Mr. Neely's name has been placed in the new one, and mine has been placed in the new one.

Was anybody able to discern any other changes between the, with the reports?

MR. NEELY: I have not, Your Honor.

MR. VITTO: I did not.

THE COURT: Okay. Thank you, Mr. Vitto.

Mr. Neely, do you have any corrections you would like to point out? Mr. Helfrich, how are you?

THE DEFENDANT: I'm hanging in there, Your Honor. How are you doing?

MR. NEELY: I don't have any corrections. However there were some things that Mr. Helfrich saw in that that he wanted me to point out to the Court. There were some things he saw there that, as I'm giving my sentencing argument, I agreed to point to and read them into the record that are in the PSI. Other than that, we don't have anything, and of course Mr. Helfrich will probably make a statement to the Court.

THE COURT REPORTER: Mr. Neely, if you wouldn't mind sitting in front of the microphone, it would make my job easier.

MR. NEELY: I'm sorry. I'm so used to standing. Judge Hoyt used to make us stand no matter what.

THE COURT: Judge Hoyt didn't have to work with Zoom.

Mr. Vitto, do you have any corrections you would like to point out in the PSI.

MR. VITTO: I do not, Your Honor.

THE COURT: I note that we don't have a probation and parole person here today. And I know that both you gentlemen are familiar with this, but there's a really complicated credit for time served calculation that needs to be done.

And my first question to P and P was going to be how many days does he have credit for? Do either of you know that?

MR. NEELY: I was going to ask the Court. He had to serve 180 days, he had to serve six months to take care of all the time on his misdemeanor, and then the time that would credit toward this sentence would be after the 180 days were over.

THE COURT: That's basically my understanding of it too, except that the first 180 days, I guess it would have been easier for the person, for you guys to say that when he's finished his Justice Court sentence, good time will begin to apply, or credit for time served will begin to apply to this case.

But, that's not what you did. Mr. Vitto, do you have an opinion about that?

MR. VITTO: Judge, just, you know, trying, it's rather arcane the way it's articulated. The easiest way I think I can distill it is to just say, attribute 180 days time served below, that leaves him 102 days, give him 102 days credit on the case.

THE COURT: Mr. Neely, would you talk to Mr. Helfrich and see what he thinks?

(Discussion between the defendant and his attorney off the record.)

THE COURT: If you can reach a stipulation about it, that would be a huge advantage.

MR. NEELY: He's telling me that's a no.

THE COURT: I came really close to that same number when I calculated it before I came in here, but I was hoping P and P would give us their calculation.

Is everyone satisfied with 102 days?

THE DEFENDANT: I really don't know. I know the longest stint of incarceration here started October 20th, 2020. But, there were a couple prior to that that included I'd say almost a week and maybe a day.

But, off the top of my head, I just don't know enough to make an educated opinion on it.

So, I mean if that's what everybody's going towards,

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great. If it ends up being a discrepancy of a week or two, I just don't have the facts before me. I just don't know.

THE COURT: Okay. Let's do this. Let's presume for purpose of today that's 102 days. And then I will ask counsel to be in contact with P and P to see if they differ from that calculation, and if it's a greater amount of credit for time served, we will amend the JOC to reflect that. If it's a lesser amount it will stay at 102.

MR. NEELY: That sounds good.

MR. VITTO: That works for us, Your Honor. Thank you.

THE COURT: Mr. Vitto, is that satisfactory?

MR. VITTO: Yes.

THE COURT: Mr. Neely, do you have a recommendation for

MR. NEELY: Yes, I do, Your Honor. Mr. Helfrich is 44 years old now. You can say during this childhood he suffered severe physical and emotional abuse from his alcoholic drug addicted parents. He's had a pretty tough childhood.

In fact, when he was younger as a baby, wandering around the house, his parents would allow him to use marijuana and drink alcohol at the parties. So, he's really had a lot of time though, some mental health issues.

THE COURT: I don't want to interrupt you, Mr. Neely.

I did want to make clear before we started argument, I wanted to

make sure that Mr. Helfrich knew that I have read every single word of what you've put in here.

THE DEFENDANT: Thank you, sir. I greatly appreciate that. I thank you for taking that time. Thank you.

THE COURT: I did instruct the clerks on the file, the documents that you presented while you were represented by counsel, because, but I have them marked as exhibits. I have a package of those exhibits, but I don't really see any reason to admit them. They're in the court file already they're just lodged on the left side.

THE DEFENDANT: Thank you, sir. I appreciate it.

THE COURT: I apologize, Mr. Neely.

MR. NEELY: That's okay, Your Honor. Given his mental health history, it's been extensive throughout his whole life. But, it looks to me, after talking to him, he's reached a point in his life where he wants to deal with his issues.

So, he's been to treatment while he's in custody with Serenity Mental Health for PTSD, anxiety, major depression, bipolar disorder and they've got him on some medication for it. So, he wants to seek some treatment for his mental health issues.

During the negotiations, I received, I talked to him in jail and I received some correspondence indicating that he was told he could possibly go to the Clark County Mental Health Court.

Well, I have had a lot of experience dealing with them, and if you have any crime of violence, you are not eligible. I told him, I said that Clark Mental Health Court sounds pretty good. But, I know those people. And he has a Manslaughter. So that definitely was not looking possible, Your Honor.

So, what we would like to do is we would like to ask the Court to sentence him to probation, sentence him to minimum of two max of six, suspend it, send him to Serenity Mental Health. We spoke with them and they will allow him to go there and do a one year program.

They have got a bed there at the facility. And after the one year, he would get trained for a job, or actually a job, after he completes it. He's reached a point in his life where he wants to try to change things and I spent some time this morning talking to him about it.

What we all want to see is you get on the right track.

I think his mental health history and everything has got a lot to do with it.

So, that's his plan, to try to change his life going forward, Your Honor, is to try to get some mental health counseling to get himself straightened out. We'd also like to point out, and look at his criminal record, Your Honor. He's got one felony and two misdemeanor convictions.

He had one prison and two jail.

He's never been on probation and he didn't do parole on his felony he did day for day. So, he's never had an opportunity for probation, Your Honor. He's asking the Court to allow him probation to see if he can succeed in getting some mental health and changing his life for the better.

I think he can do it.

THE COURT: Sorry. Hang on. Boy you guys would have been in trouble if your phone went off. Good thing it wasn't mine. Good grief. That's what happens when you have a new phone.

Yes, sir?

MR. NEELY: So, that's our request, Your Honor. If you want to speak with Mr. Helfrich in one second, he's going to probably want to make a statement.

He asked me to read some stuff into the record. I know the Court's already told him that you reviewed everything. Let me see what he's got to say now.

(Discussion between the defendant and his counsel off the record.)

MR. NEELY: He's got some stuff here he wants me to read. He would like me to read this into the record, Your Honor, the offense synopsis:

"Ms. Sanchez stated that they were being shot at, but couldn't provide any further details, other than the vehicle

speaks.

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THE COURT: He will be able to do that after Mr. Vitto

Mr. Vitto, do you have a recommendation for me?

MR. VITTO: Thank you, Your Honor. Thank you very
much. My recommendation is 48 months minimum, 120 months
maximum, and a \$10.000 fine.

At this point in the defendant's criminal career, I think the specific and general deterrence factors are paramount, specifically this Court has the opportunity to stop the defendant for a minimum of four years from involving himself with criminal conduct.

The general deterrence factor, this Court has the opportunity to protect the law abiding citizenry for a minimum of four years.

Looking at the history, listening to everything, taking everything into consideration, it appears that the best shot at any kind of rehabilitation is taking full advantage of any and all programs that are within the controlled environment of the Nevada Department of Corrections.

The defendant positions himself before the Court today for sentencing as a threat and a menace to society. He's menacing. He's violent. He won't stop. After being charged with murder and pleading guilty to manslaughter and going to prison on a 48 to 120, the defendant got out, and didn't let much

immediately involved himself with upon being released for killing a man.

My recommendation to the Court today is that the defendant be sentenced to the maximum term of incarceration, 120 months in the Nevada Department of Corrections, that parole eligibility is after a minimum of 48 months has been served.

I'm also asking that a \$10,000 fine be imposed.

Thank you, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. Vitto.

Mr. Helfrich, is there anything you would like to tell me before I decide what to do?

THE DEFENDANT: I remember previously when we spoke, or when we met the last time, when Mr. Martinez was my attorney, you asked me basically what motivated me to partake in this situation.

And I didn't really have enough time, I don't think we were limited on time, and, and therefore I had a lot of time to think about it. And I want to explain to you what happened, you know, some of the deputy part and whatnot reflects that Maria Sanchez was in a band in our church. We began dating. We had a picnic at the park that day, and she invited me to her rental house.

And she said that she would have to ask permission for me to be there. We were going to watch some Christian-based

movie. I forget the name of it. But, anyways, she then called Alvin Thornton while I was in front of her, and requested permission for me to come over to her rental home and watch a movie.

To the best of my knowledge, that permission was granted. We proceeded to the Wilson Road residence, and parked there. It's a high fence, gated off property.

As we entered, and we were bringing like various things, like leftover food and what have you, from the picnic. And with her autistic son, Josway Flores, who was about 24 at the time. He's special needs. So, as we entered the door of this home that she was renting from Alvin Thornton and came in, Alvin Thornton barged in the house, and this gentleman, Alvin Thornton, he's a black male, larger than this deputy here in stature.

And this Alvin Thornton was yelling and screaming at the top of his lungs, at Maria Sanchez, saying, Maria, I am going to kick you out of my house and into the street as soon as possible.

We were totally flabbergasted. We thought this man gave us permission to be there. I would never have gone over, being an ex-felon, in a situation where I am not welcome somewhere.

Anyways, Maria basically stated, Alvin we asked permission. I'm renting this place for me. You said it was okay

for Peter to be here. I want you to leave. I'm paying rent.

And she and I asked him to leave a couple times. Then he forcibly put his hands on her shoulders, and forcibly shoved her.

She went spluttering around trying to catch her balance, banged her knee on the coffee table, and got scraped up a little bit, then fell on the ground.

Then Alvin began beating on his chest like a barbarian, daring me to pepper spray him.

Now I, being a small guy, and this individual is larger than this gentleman over here, and I wouldn't stand a chance, you know what I mean, if he attacked me. So, I used nonlethal means, which is pepper spray, to subdue him.

And then we fled and went to the Basin Road, Nye County Sheriff's Office. No one was around. We called 911 and requested medical attention for her banged-up, scraped-up knee, and we requested a deputy help file a report.

I don't know. I mean this is all well acknowledged and accepted by Mr. Martinez told me that he had talked to one of the other prosecutors, Mr. Allmon, that this is all verified.

There's video evidence that we drove there and video evidence that we entered the building, and then eventually 15, 20 minutes later, this deputy came out. I don't remember his name.

We told him what happened. We requested medical

attention for her knee. We requested that Assault and Battery charges be filed.

He refused our request, and he told us to go back to the scene and wait across the street, and a deputy would be there to take our report. And if we needed medical or whatever, it would go from there.

The only reason that -- I would never have gone back to the scene of an incident like this unless an officer had told me to do so.

Being an ex-felon, you always got butterflies in your stomach when you're around police. And when they tell you to do something you want to think that it's in your best interests to do so.

Well, that wasn't the case that day. We went back, and, unfortunately there was no deputy present. And then Alvin came out from the gated area, and motioned this car to come forth, and then he pointed at our SUV. Astrovan; I'm sorry. And then they proceeded to creep forward.

And if all this wasn't enough, you know, having a woman assaulted and all this, and Alvin Thornton has a history with Domestic Battery, With a Deadly Weapon, Strangulation with a former woman. So, this is his serial history repeating itself.

This car came forth, and I said to Maria, pardon my German. "I don't see any F'ing sheriffs. This looks like a

set-up. I'm getting the F out of here."

And I did a U-turn.

And as I proceeded towards where we would go out from Wilson and proceed towards 372. I took a left in hopes of fleeing back to the Sheriff's station. I was hoping to make it there, and then we realized I was doing 55 miles an hour at the time.

And I just want to say Maria and her son both have some mental health issues. So, while we were being tailgated by these two individuals who admitted this, Azilla Demeno, admitted to this at the preliminary hearing. I don't want to bore you with the lies and everything. But, please just take my word for it. She admitted to tailgating.

THE COURT: I read what she did.

THE DEFENDANT: Okay, sir. Thank you.

Maria was screaming and yelling and hollering, as you may well know, and I've got PTSD, and anxiety.

So, I was just trying to tell her, please, why don't you call 911? And they were too terrified. I tapped on the brakes to try and get them off my bumper.

And then they came along the side of us and Maria goes: "Oh, my God. He's got a gun. Jesus help us."

And all this stuff. And she's screaming, and I look, and sure enough, there's Alturio there, pointing a pistol at me,

a black pistol at me. And I almost lost control of the vehicle at the time.

Just out of the sheer terror of having this happen, and then I somehow regained my composure, and I kept telling Maria, "Would you just please shut up and let me drive?"

But, she wouldn't. More and more terrified. They passed us, and about 500 feet away, they got back in our lane and stopped dead in the middle of the road.

It's like a nightmare. This is the kind of stuff you see in Hollywood films, but you never think it is going to happen to you. But, then again, this is Pahrump, Nevada. I mean, anything can happen in the Nyelight Zone.

I proceed to pass them off the double yellow line. I know that's illegal, but I passed them, you know, left to right, and then they performed the same maneuver again, coming alongside, brandishing the pistol and all the while he's grinning at me like it's funny.

Once again stopped about 50 feet away, give or take, and then I once again passed them and I'm doing about 75 or 80, trying to get away from them. And this is a little Volkswagon Beetle GTI, and I've got a four cylinder. If I did a U-turn, like the hills have eyes-ville to California.

There was no place from that stretch of Wilson to where I'm talking about to turn left or turn right to try and evade

them. Sometimes the only way through hell is straight ahead.

My grandfather was a World War II vet. Robert Journegan, Army Air Force, and unfortunately, he's right.

Now, it was about three quarters of a mile, give or take, and that's like third time they passed us, they passed us like they were standing still. They must have been doing 100, 120. Because I was doing about 75, 80.

And somewhere between five hundred and a thousand feet, before they pulled over near that storage building, we distinctly heard, it was like three or four shots, and then Maria just went ballistic, and I kept saying, "Somebody call 911, oh, my God," you know? And I'm going, "What am I gonna do?"

So, the closer we approached, and mind you, even though I only made it through four weeks of military training, and I got sick from the Anthrax vaccine, and I got discharged. There's something that they teach you in the military very early on.

It's think like your opponent, and I'm thinking to myself, if I just fired three to four shots off at somebody from a distance and missed, and then I pull over to the side of the road, to me seemed like a tactic to get a clearer shot.

I mean it doesn't take Rambo or an Army general to figure out that if somebody has fired three to four shots off at you, and pulls over to the right-hand side of the road, instead of continuing driving away like they said they were going to

Walmart.

Well, why weren't they going to the sheriff's department, if they were trying to get a license plate number that they could have gotten when Maria drove back home.

I just, I just panicked and freaked out. I thought to myself, and I saw in my mind, if I drive by them and they get lucky, Maria or her autistic is son, who is like 23 or 24, would likely be the targets. And I made a quick decision, right or wrong. I just said to myself, I think the only way to get the sheriffs involved with this and take thing seriously, and the only way to hope that we're not going to get shot at was to run into the back of the car. And then after I did that, I went around behind the building, the buildings, and parked the vehicle and I said, "Okay. Both of you get out. Both call 911 and hide until the sheriffs show up. Get somewhere to find safety."

And then as I turned, there's all this poof of dirt and smoke and what have you, and I can only see from this far up, Alturo was out of the car, and he looked in my direction he said, Peter, I'm going to get you, Peter.

And I said, "Oh, brother." I don't know if he still had the gun or not, or what was going on. So I took that as a threat.

And I used to run track when I was a kid, you know, in school so I just ran. And as I ran, people were pouring out of

that thing, Chuck it across the street, whatever. I don't know how they made it disappear, but I know that they did, because there definitely was a gun.

The only last thing I had, pursuant to the NRS 176.1561(b) was in the offensive analysis, I feel that the omission of those facts, blatant omission of those facts that were omitted being after Maria was attacked, we went to the sheriff's department, did our due diligence to try and seek assault charges, and, you know, medical attention for her banged up knee, and then that we were denied the same, and told to go back to the scene.

I think that that being omitted from the offense synopsis to the untrained eye, I know you've read it all and you are aware of it.

But, I object to that being omitted, because the untrained person, or the average person, they would have a hard time thinking, like, well, why did this guy go back? Why in the world did this guy go back? And when I search for answers to myself, like what could I have done differently that day?

So, I enrolled in the Serenity Mental Health, and I have seen four drug and alcohol mental health counselors. And I told them basically the whole start to finish. And I said what could I have done different to avoid this? All these four well educated people that are listening to other inmates and other

people that have crazy traumatic situations.

And they said, you should have never listened to the deputy on Basin Road tell you to go back to the scene and wait for a deputy. That was the catalyst that kind of, it was kinda like to me, napalm on the camp fire that created this situation, that got so out of control, Judge.

I apologize far panicking. I apologize for freaking out. Post-traumatic stress sort of things are very difficult to live with. I didn't realize how bad my PTSD was until I'm in a situation like this, a fight or flight.

I also, one day, on March 2nd, 2020, or 2021. I'm sorry. I was up at Tonopah praying and whatever. It was around 11:45, and I said, "You know, God, I really want to talk to Lieutenant Gray about this."

And as crazy as it sounds, as corny as it sounds, he shows up. How often does Lieutenant Gray show up all the way to Tonopah? He came to my cell. We have a rapport.

I gave him the whole run down, basically, what happened and I said, "Lieutenant, look me in the eye and tell me what I could have done different."

And he paused for a moment. "You know, what, Helfrich?" He goes, "Don't ever listen to one of my deputies or any deputy tell you to go back to the scene after a woman or anybody has been assaulted. Don't ever do that again?

And he kind of apologized that it happened that way.

So, I have had five people, one of them a lieutenant, and a decorated, former officer beat cop that had hit the streets, and he told me the same thing. He said, "You should have never went back to the scene."

And he said, "If something like this ever happens again, just go home. Wait until the next day. Come in and talk to somebody else other than whoever told you to do that until you get the right answer. Or you're going to find somebody, an officer, a deputy, or detective that will file a police report for assault, that will take pictures if there's any bang up or scrape or whatever, and things will go hopefully better, if it ever happens again, next time."

So, I apologize for getting out of control, and I feel stupid for listening to that deputy, but, you know, you're an Honorable Judge. I'm an ex-felon.

I'm just saying, if you went down there under the same circumstances. I doubt that they would have told you to go back to the scene. And you know the law well enough, you probably would have told them I'm not going to. You are going to get your superior over here or something.

I had just got done, it was stressful. The whole situation previous to this was stressful. And I was having an anxiety attack, and I just followed his directions, foolishly,

and look how out of control it got.

You know, it was, in Hollywood, you know, the hero rides away in the sunset, and all this stuff. But it doesn't always happen in real life.

I'm thankful that nobody was really seriously injured. But, what it all boiled down to was those two individuals felt justified, because I pepper sprayed their father to prevent myself from being assaulted after he assaulted Maria Sanchez, that they were justified in playing vigilantes.

And nobody has the right, in my opinion. And you can correct me if I'm wrong, sir, to tailgate us, chase us and do all these crazy antics. Neither one of them, they both admitted they never graduated from the Police Academy, and they had no experience in pursuing suspects. They terrified us that day. Both of them.

And I don't know how anybody, you know, you put a hundred people in a situation, a similar situation, you might get a hundred different responses of how they act.

I felt like because of my prior history in Nye County that the Sheriff's Department was turning a blind eye to helping us. I mean, I could be wrong, but I felt like I was on my own down that lone stretch that day, and nobody was going to come to the rescue or anything. And I was in fear of not only my safety, but my passengers'. And I just made what many may think or

believe to be a rash decision, but I really didn't know what else to do.

But, we don't know what would have happened if I would have drove by, if anything. That might have been the right decision. I just can't say, only God knows that.

But, I want to apologize, in general, also to let you down, because you remember when I lost my parental rights and all that, you wished me well and hoped that things would go good.

Actually, I couldn't find a job when I got out of prison. I was up in Vegas. Nobody would hire me. I'm a National Honor student. I've got an associate's degree. My health issues forced me out of my bachelor's. I ended up out here. I didn't have to worry about toxic mold, just toxic people.

My certifications and everything else that I had going for me really didn't seem to mean much when I tried to find employment, and I wasn't aware of Serenity Health or Hope For Prisoners. and some of these other things that I, unfortunately, under these circumstances, became aware existed, to my disposal, so I ended up back in Pahrump, working my way out of a tent, and this is how I ran into Maria Sanchez. We started off friends, and I was volunteering as a cook at the church, and other things.

Lastly, the only other thing that I wanted to point out was there was some discrepancy about this simulation of a legal

document.

THE COURT: I don't care about that.

THE DEFENDANT: It was a formal demand letter, sir.

THE COURT: You are not being sentenced for that.

THE DEFENDANT: I just want to apologize to everybody else. It wasn't my intent to hurt anybody. It was my intent to disable that vehicle, force the sheriffs to take this matter seriously, because it got out of hand, by these three individuals that were, in my opinion, seeking vindication for pepper spraying Alvin Thornton, who has a history of assaulting and strangling and beating women. And why the sheriffs didn't take it seriously, because they already arrested him previously for assaulting women is beyond me.

But, I can't change anything, Judge. And I know you have given me two recommendations from these two gentlemen, both well educated, and experienced on both sides of the fence.

I'm offering a third option and a prayer to the Court that if you would give me a two to five, or a two to six, or however you want to structure it, I promise you right here on the record that when I do believe that two to five or two to six, I will directly go into Serenity's one-year mental health program.

But, not just mental health but the drug and alcohol program. Because part of the thing was, after this event happened, I was so stressed out, even though I got OR'd, I was so

stressed out I started drinking heavily, and getting into drugs again, to try to combat this serious case over my head and looking at going back to prison, it was just overwhelming. I fell off the wagon again.

Since I been incarcerated and been in treatment, I've got a proper diagnosis. They finally gave me a rim rod (sic)it's this medication for PTSD. It helps me sleep.

I was having flashbacks from this event, nightmares and things. One time I was awake for five days straight, so they finally got me on the right medications.

And I just want to say how grateful I am that we have a program in Nye County, finally, called Serenity Mental Health, because I didn't have that during the whole manslaughter thing.

I had gone through a traumatic experience and there was

THE COURT: I need you to wind it up.

THE DEFENDANT: There was no help there. I'm trying to get the help that I can with what I can. And I hope you will give me the chance. And a two to five, or two to six, and then going to counseling after, if these other options that you're weighing, I'm just trying to give you a third option.

Thank you.

THE COURT: Thank you, Mr. Helfrich. Do you have any legal cause to show, Mr. Neely, why this sentence should not be

MR. NEELY: No, Your Honor I do not.

THE COURT: I've got a few things to say before I

impose the sentence.

Mr. Helfrich, a couple things. While you were incarcerated, for you to seek out and participate in this program I think is probably the most important thing that's happened to you since I've known you, which is now quite a while. So, I'm glad for that. That's a good thing.

There were lots of bad choices made that night, and there wasn't just the one, but there were lots of them. And what you are being sentenced for, just so you understand, is not the reaction to what you perceived to be happening at the house where the lady lived, it's what you did with the car, assaulting, battering the other car and the people in it.

I just want to make it clear what the important part of this is to me. The rest of it is important also, but that's the event for which you are being sentenced.

So, enough said. There being no legal cause established, it is the Judgment of the Court that you are, in fact, guilty of the offense of Battery With the Use of a Deadly Weapon, a Category B felony.

It is the Judgment of this Court that you are, in fact, guilty of that charge. In accordance with the laws in the State

of Nevada, I do now sentence you as follows:

In addition to the \$25 administrative assessment fee, and whatever fees are necessary to be imposed, there's a three dollar administrative assessment, DNA administrative assessment. I doubt if there's a \$150 DNA analysis fee, DNA fee. But, since nobody from P and P is here, I can't know that for sure, because his DNA was undoubtedly taken last time.

I know there was a discussion of restitution early on, but all I've got is somebody's estimate of a damage figure, and that's insufficient for me to order restitution.

So, Mr. Helfrich, you're not going to be granted probation.

You will be sentenced to a term of six years in the Nevada State Prison with a minimum parole eligibility of two years, and you will be given credit for 102 days served, unless a higher number is developed by P and P following this Imposition of Sentence.

Important to my decision is the fact that Mr. Helfrich has never been on probation. He has had innumerable opportunities to seek out the kind of counseling that he has finally sought out, and didn't choose to do that while he was not incarcerated.

I understand that the drug and alcohol issues and those need to be addressed as well.

De-Escalation Tips

1. Be Empathic and Non-judgmental

Respect the feelings of others. Whether or not you think their feelings are valid, they are real to the other person.

2. Respect Personal Space

Be mindful of your position and closeness to the other individual. Respecting their personal space can ease a person's anxiety and protect you, as well.

3. Use Nonthreatening Nonverbals

Remain aware of your facial expressions, body language, and tone in voice. When someone is upset, they are often more sensitive to these factors than the actual words coming out of your mouth.

4. Keep Your Emotional Brain in Check

Stay as calm and rational as possible. Keep your own emotions in check, as you don't want your personal feelings to influence your judgment.

5. Focus on Feelings

People tend to have a hard time expressing how they are feeling. Be as supportive as you can by focusing on their real message. Saying things like "that must be scary" can help the individual feel understood.

6. Ignore Challenging Questions

Instead of challenging how the person feels, focus on what the two of you can do to find a solution.

7. Set Limits

Provide choices for the individual as they process through their emotions. Keep them simple and positive.

8. Choose Wisely What You Insist Upon

Be thoughtful in deciding what negotiations to be rigid in and in which to compromise. Being flexible can help avoid any unnecessary altercations.

9. Allow Silence for Reflection

Even when they may seem awkward, moments of silence allow for people to process through what they are feeling. In these moments, solutions may even be found.

10. Allow Time for Decisions

Remain patient with the individual as they are processing through their emotions. Stress levels can rise if one feels rushed; allowing them this time can help ease the emotions.

Remember, even though we can't control everything that happens to us, we can control how we react. We can make the choice to be more mindful and compassionate. It may sound easier said than done, but by choosing this route, we allow ourselves to feel more peace and less anger. We learn to meet people where they are at, instead of forcing our idea of where they should be.

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A. Yes.

Defendant's a very violent man. The Defendant has been convicted of manslaughter charges for which he served time in the Nevada Department of Corrections in which he did kill another person. He did admit to those facts.

I think that he's a violent man and he's out committing more violent offenses. He — so I think that this is evidence of a similar series of acts as — if you let this Defendant out, if you let him roam these streets, I believe that he will commit more violent acts.

I think he's a danger to the community. I think bail is necessary. I think he's a flight risk because he does not submit to the will of the court and so I think that the bail staying at \$20,000 is very reasonable.

THE COURT: Mr. Martinez.

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MR. MARTINEZ: Judge, just a couple points for the record. Mr. Helfrich was convicted of a voluntary manslaughter. That was a case where he was briefly charged with a murder. It was a case where he invoked self-defense.

There was at least -- there was more than a colorable argument that it was self-defense, Judge, which I'm sure led to the plea negotiation that it did, that it would be dropped down to a voluntary manslaughter. But in any case, that's something that happened. That's something that he's pled to, he has served his time on.

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The State talks about him being a violent offender, being a violent person and being out there. I know that Mr. Helfrich has other cases open. None of them are violent, Judge. It has to do with potential harassment for serving documents and things along those lines.

And the State may bring up YouTube videos in the future to say — to present things that Mr. Helfrich has said. Saying things and acting on them are two completely different situations.

As we talk about this case and what we heard today, Judge, what I heard was two people who hopped in a car and decided to be vigilantes, to follow the Defendant even though Maria Sanchez rented the property from Alvin Thornton.

They could have gotten her information, they could have called the police, they could have given a description of the van.

They didn't do that. They acted as vigilantes to

go and try and get Mr. Helfrich themselves. They tailgated him, they had to speed to catch up to him. They tailgated him.

Whether or not he acted reasonably under the circumstances, that's something we're going to decide at trial. But given the totality of everything here today, Judge, I know that he's being held on other cases as well and we can address them when they come up. We can address the

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bail then. I would ask the Judge to reduce - or I would ask Your Honor to reduce bail down to \$10,000 cash or bond. 3 THE COURT: Okay. NARRATIVE:

Narrative Deputy Sehnert//

On 05/27/2020 at approximately 2000 hrs. I was dispatched to HWY 372 and Charleston Park Dr., reference a vehicle accident.

When I arrived at the immediate area the accident location was updated to the north portion of the mini storage located on Charleston Park immediately west of Linda from HWY 372. When I exited the vehicle, I observed a small compact vehicle that crashed into one of the corner portions of the mini storage brick building. I observed the chain link fence on the ground along with debris to include brick structure from the building on the ground to include vehicle parts along with the driver on the ground. Medics were attending the unknown female victim driver and the male victim was standing in the rear of the vehicle. The male was identified as Alterio Thorton with a DOB of and the female driver was identified as Iseza Del Carmen Nino with a DOB of There were no additional occupants at that time.

The female was transported to Desert View for further medical examination due to the fact she is pregnant. The other vehicle involved in the accident was located to the south portion driving path and it was facing towards the west direction. The vehicle had damage to the front portion of the vehicle. There was a female by the vehicle that Deputy Beard was speaking to at the time and there was a male that was also an occupant from the vehicle. The male was identified as Josue Flores through his Nevada Identification card. It should be noted that the driver from the red mini van in the accident fled on foot prior to my arrival.

I went to speak with Josue Flores regarding the accident and he stated that Peter was driving the vehicle and that he just rammed into the other vehicle. He additionally stated that the female with him, by the name of Maria Sanchez told him that they were being shot at during the incident, but he wasn't able to articulate anything that would collaborate the shooting allegation at the time. Maria did in fact state that the vehicle was pulled off to the side of the road and that they saw what they believed to be a firearm and that they passed the vehicle, but still stated that Peter rammed into the vehicle.

Mr. Helfrich reported two suicide attempts. He was 17 years old when he took 400 sleeping pills and was hospitalized for two weeks and at the age of 44, he took 90 Rim Ron pills and was sick in his cell (he didn't tell anyone). He stated, "Plan on getting it right on #3 if the Judge maxes me out" but could not articulate a plan of action.

Gambling History: None reported

Substance Abuse History: Alcohol consumption was reported to have begun at the age of 1 and is described as problematic with use being daily until October 2020. The defendant reported use of marijuana to have begun at the age of 1 with use described as daily until October 2020. It should be noted that on a previous presentence report he began using alcohol and marijuana at the age of 9 and 13, respectively. He used cocaine for a couple of weeks in the 1990's, used hallucinogens approximately once a week/month beginning in his teens until October 2020, he reported that someone "slipped" heroin in his pot five or six times, and the only time he abused pills was when he attempted suicide. The defendant reported no prior substance abuse treatment until his current incarceration. He receives both mental health and substance abuse treatment through Serenity Mental Health, He plans to participate with inpatient treatment with Serenity in Las Vegas, Nevada upon his release from custody.

V. OFFENSE SYNOPSIS

Records provided by the Nye County Sheriff's Office and the Nye County District Attorney's Office reflect that the instant offense occurred substantially as follows:

On May 27, 2020, Nye County deputies were dispatched to Highway 372 and Charleston Park Drive for an accident where a small compact Volkswagen crashed into the corner of a mini storage brick building. The chain link fence surrounding the perimeter of the storage facility, along with debris from the brick building and vehicle parts, were scattered on the ground. Medics arrived on scene and attended the pregnant female driver (VC2278415) and male passenger (VC2249869) of the Volkswagen. The female victim was transported to Desert View Hospital for further observation.

The other vehicle involved in the accident was a red minivan driven by the defendant Peter Helfrich, who had fled the scene prior to the deputies' arrival, and occupants Maria Sanchez and Josue Flores. Flores stated that Helfrich was driving, and he rammed the other vehicle. Sanchez stated that they were being shot at but couldn't provide any further details other than the vehicle pulled off the road and they saw what they believed to be a firearm, and that Helfrich just rammed the vehicle.

Witnesses stated that the red minivan intentionally drove into the back of the Volkswagen causing it to go through the chain link fence and hit the brick building.

Peter Helfrich was located while on foot walking along Highway 372 with a canister of oleoresin capsicum in his hand. He declined medical attention and was transported to the Nye County Detention Center where he was booked without further incident.

The minivan was impounded, and the Volkswagen was towed at the owner's request and expense.

On October 30, 2020, the adult male victim (VC2249869) provided a recorded interview at the NCSO Pahrump station. He related that his father (VC2249868) called him in distress asking for him to call an ambulance. He responded to his father's residence and found that his father had been pepper sprayed by the defendant Peter Helfrich. He advised that his father owned the property and lived in a travel trailer in the back of the property but allowed people to live in his house as a charitable gesture to help them get back on their feet. At the time of the incident, Maria Sanchez was living in the house and dating Peter Helfrich. His father knew Sanchez but had never met Helfrich. While his father was being attended by medics, Helfrich returned to the property but stayed in the minivan screaming at him and his father. Helfrich then drove away. At that point, he and his girlfriend got in the Volkswagen and tried to get the license plate and call the police. He said the minivan kept brake checking them, so they decided to go around the vehicle. After they had passed the minivan, they decided to pull off to the right side of the road and that is when the minivan slammed into their car causing the car to go through the chain link fence and into the brick building. All the airbags deployed. Helfrich tried to flee in the minivan but there too much damage to the engine, so he fled on foot. He chased Helfrich for a bit but returned to his pregnant girlfriend when she called for help. He reported no serious injuries but was sore and experienced pain several days after the impact.

On October 30, 2020, male victim (VC2249868) was interviewed. He explained that Maria Sanchez was renting the main house while he lived in a travel trailer on the property but a clause in the contract stated he still has use of the kitchen and laundry facilities. It was also agreed that Ms. Sanchez would not have outsiders over to the house without his permission. Ms. Sanchez and Mr. Helfrich were in a dating relationship. Mr. Helfrich was unknown to the victim. While doing laundry, the victim tried speaking to Sanchez about Helfrich being in the home. Helfrich became hostile and sprayed the victim in the face with pepper spray making it difficult to see and breathe. He tried to stop Helfrich but was sprayed again at which time Helfrich left with Sanchez and her son. The victim called his son for help.

On November 9, 2020, the female victim was contacted for a statement. She added that while pulled over on the side of the road police were called and she saw the pending collision in her rearview mirror. She advised that her car was totaled with the damage estimated at \$7,000.00 and she incurred medical bills. Otherwise her statement was the same as reported by the other two male victims.

Mr. Helfrich is currently in custody at the Nye County Detention Center and was interviewed by Specialist Thelaner on June 7, 2021. Verbally, the defendant admitted to using pepper spray because victim (VC2249868) was being physical with his girlfriend, Maria Sanchez. He further admitted that he rammed into the back of the Volkswagen but said he felt he had no other option because he heard gunshots being fired and felt that his life was in danger.

Attempts were made to contact the victims (VC2278415, VC2249868, and VC2249869) in order to obtain a Victim Impact Statement and restitution claim; to date no response has been received by the Division. If the requested information is received after this report has been submitted, it will be provided to the Court.

According to the police report, victim (VC2278415) suffered a vehicle loss of \$7,000.00 and an unknown amount of medical bills. If the information is received after this report has been submitted, it will be provided to the Court.

IX. PLEA NEGOTIATIONS

In exchange for the defendant's plea of no contest pursuant to Alford, the State, the defense, and the defendant have agreed to recommend the following: The Defendant will plead no contest to Count I of Pahrump Justice Court case 20TR01961 (Assault, misdemeanor), the prosecution will not pursue any other charges related to this case. The State will dismiss the following charges: 20TR01961 Counts II-IV (Certain Unlawful Acts, Driving Without a License, Security for Payment of Tort Liabilities, Harassment, and Eluding a Peace Officer, all misdemeanors), 20CR01738 (Charged as Simulation of Legal Document, NRS 207.337, D felony and was to be amended to Harassment, a misdemeanor), and 20CR01739 (Harassment, a misdemeanor). The State will deny 20NY-3974 (referred for a charge of Simulation of Legal Document, NRS 207.337, D felony). Both parties agree that in 20TR01961, the Defendant will enter a no contest plea to Count I (Assault) and that the Defendant will be sentenced to a term of confinement in the Nye County Detention Center, that begins with the Defendant being remanded to the custody of the Sheriff, and ends with the Defendant entering his plea of no contest in District Court as part of this guilty plea agreement. The sentence for that offense is dependent on the timing of this case. Meaning that the credit for time served will all be applied to 20TR01961 and the time served in the instant case will not begin until the Defendant enters a plea of no contest in the District Court or when the Defendant has served 180 days, the maximum allowed on 20TR01961. Both parties retain the right to argue at sentencing. The Defendant agrees to forfeit any and all weapons seized or impounded in connection with the instant case or other case negotiated or resolved in this agreement.

The State will regain the right to argue for any lawful sentence and term of confinement if the Defendant: fails to interview with the Department of Parole and Probation; fails to appear at any subsequent hearings in this case; tests positive for a controlled substance at any subsequent hearing in this case without a valid prescription; or an independent magistrate, by declaration review confirms probable cause for new criminal charges at a preliminary hearing; or found guilty at trial for new criminal charges.

II. LEGAL ARGUMENT

Petitions for Extraordinary Writs are addressed to the sound discretion of the Supreme Court of Nevada and may issue when there is no plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law. See, State v. Second Judicial District Court ex. rel. County of Washoe, 11 P.3d 1209,

Nev. ___ (2000).

A writ of mandamus is issued to compel performance of an act which the law especially enjoins as a duty resulting from an office, trust or station. See, <u>Lewis v. Stewart</u>, 619 P.2d 1212, 96 Nev. 846 (1980).

A writ of mandamus may issue to control arbitrary or capricious excercise of discretion. See, <u>Barnes v. Eighth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada, in and for Clark County</u>, 748 P.2d 483, 103 Nev. 679 (1987).

This Court has also held that the action being sought to be compelled must be one already required by law. See, Mineral County v. State, Department of conservation and Natural Resources, 20 P.3d 800, Nev. ___ (2001).

Mandamus is the appropriate vehicle for challenging contested orders entered by the District Court. See, <u>Angell v. Eighth Judicial District court in and for the county of Clark</u>, 839 P.2d 1329, 108 Nev. 923 (1992).

It has also been held that a writ of mandamus is proper when the petitioner raises urgent and important issue[s] of law requiring clarification by the Supreme Court. See, <u>Falcke v. Douglas County</u>, 3 P.3d 661, ____ Nev. ___ (2000).



ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS

This is an original pro se petition for a writ of mandamus asking this court to compel the district court to rule on petitioner's pending petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Petitioner also supplemented his mandamus petition with a related request that this court direct the Nye County Clerk's Office to file his "Declaration in Support of Affiant's Emergency Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order & Preliminary Injunction," in which he seeks the return of documents he claims are needed to support his habeas petition.

Because it is alleged that petitioner's habeas petition, filed in the district court on September 10, 2021, is still pending, we determined that an answer would assist the court in resolving the matter and directed respondents to file and serve an answer. The Nye County District Attorney's Office submitted an answer on behalf of the Clerk of the Fifth Judicial District Court. The Attorney General's Office submitted an answer

on behalf of the Fifth Judicial District Court and the Honorable David R. Gamble, Senior Judge.

This court has original jurisdiction to issue writs of mandamus, and the issuance of such extraordinary relief is within this court's sole discretion. See Nev. Const. art. 6, § 4; D.R. Horton, Inc. v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 123 Nev. 468, 474-75, 168 P.3d 731, 736-37 (2007). Petitioner bears the burden to show that extraordinary relief is warranted, and such relief is proper only when there is no plain, speedy, and adequate remedy at law. See Pan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 120 Nev. 222, 224, 228, 88 P.3d 840, 841, 844 (2004).

In their respective answers, respondents failed to identify and/or provide this court with any order of the district court resolving petitioner's habeas petition. Respondents also failed to contest the fact that petitioner's habeas petition is still pending. Additionally, we perceive no obstacle preventing the district court clerk from filing petitioner's "Declaration." Sullivan v. Eighth Judicial Dist. Court, 111 Nev. 1367, 1369-72, 904 P.2d 1039, 1040-42 (1995) (addressing the district court clerk's "absolute obligation" to receive and file documents submitted to them, and collecting cases). Accordingly, we conclude that petitioner has satisfied his burden of showing that our intervention by way of providing extraordinary relief is warranted, and we

ORDER the petition GRANTED AND DIRECT THE CLERK OF THIS COURT TO ISSUE A WRIT OF MANDAMUS instructing the district court to enter an order resolving petitioner's habeas petition and instructing the Nye County Clerk to file petitioner's "Declaration." ¹
