ORDER DENYING MOTION

This Matter comes before the Court on JAVIER RAMIREZ RIVAS's ("Defendant") Motion for Orders to Modify Child Custody, Visitation, and/or Child Support filed on May 5, 2023. MAYRA E. ARREGUIN ("Plaintiff") did not file an Opposition to Defendant's Motion. The Court held a hearing on the Motion on June 6, 2023. Both Parties appeared in *pro per*. Evelyn Wakeling translated the proceedings for Plaintiff. Additionally, Melanie McCormick appeared as a Court Appointed Special Advocate ("CASA") on behalf of EDUARDO JAVIER RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 04/13/2006) and CARLOS ADRIAN RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 10/09/2007) (collectively, "Minor Children") and filed a report for the hearing.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

At the hearing, Defendant requested to modify his physical custody of the Minor Children from no physical custody to joint physical custody. Defendant argued he should receive joint physical custody of the Minor Children because Plaintiff slapped them and allowed them to smoke

1 marijuana. Finally, Defendant stated that Plaintiff failed to inform him of the Minor Children's
2 injuries at school.

3
4 Plaintiff admitted the Minor Children tested positive for marijuana after a blood test from
5 a doctor. However, Plaintiff testified she does not allow the Minor Children to smoke marijuana
6 and—contrary to Defendant's position—has talked to them repeatedly about the problems with
7 drugs. Last, Plaintiff argued that when she informs Defendant about the Minor Children, he
8 complains; when she does not inform him about the Minor Children, he also complains. The
9 Court reminded Plaintiff that she and Defendant share joint legal custody of the Minor Children
10 so she must inform Defendant about the Minor Children's injuries.

11
12 The Court thereafter spoke with the Minor Children outside of the presence of the Parties.
13 The Court inquired about the Minor Children's marijuana use. The Minor Children admitted they
14 smoked marijuana. Also, the Minor Children stated they enrolled in boxing for the summer and
15 are excited for it to begin. Further, they expressed their eternal gratitude for their mother, care
16 deeply for her, and are not in any danger while in her care.

17
18 Ms. McCormick's report filed with the Court aligned with the Parties and Minor
19 Children's testimony.

20 21 *DISCUSSION*

22 In evaluating custody and visitation disputes, the court applies the "best interests of the
23 child" standard. *Rico v. Rodriguez*, 121 Nev. 695, 705, 120 P.3d 812, 818 (2005); *see also Vincent*
24 *L.G., v. State Div. of Child & Family Services*, 120 Nev. 422, 434, 92 P.3d 1230, 1238, (2004)
25 (noting that a doctor's testimony that a parent's behavior and detrimental effects on the child
26 should be weighed by the court). Specifically, the Court applies a two-pronged approach to
27 determine whether "(1) there has been a substantial change in circumstances affecting the welfare
28

1 of the child, and (2) the child's best interest is served by the modification." *Romano v. Romano*,
2 401 P.3d 980, 983 (quoting *Ellis v. Carucci*, 123 Nev. 145, 150, 161 P.3d 239, 242 (2007)).
3 "Matters of custody, including visitation, rest in the district court's sound discretion." *Martin v.*
4 *Martin*, 120 Nev. 342, 344-45, 90 P.3d 981, 983 (2004).

6 1. *There are no Substantial Changes in Circumstances Warranting Modifying Physical*
7 *Custody.*

8 Defendant argued Plaintiff slapping the Minor Children and allowing them to smoke
9 marijuana meets the criteria of a substantial change in circumstances and necessitates awarding
10 him joint physical of the Minor Children. The Court disagrees.

11 Here, a substantial change in circumstances does not exist because Plaintiff opposed the
12 Minor Children smoking marijuana. In fact, Plaintiff testified she told the Minor Children how
13 bad marijuana is and to not smoke it. Additionally, the Minor Children clearly communicated to
14 the Court they do not feel in danger while residing with Plaintiff. Ms. McCormick's report further
15 detailed that the Minor Children feel safe in Plaintiff's care. Accordingly, the Court does not find
16 a substantial change in circumstances that negatively affect the Minor Children's welfare exists.
17 Therefore, this prong is not met.
18

19 2. *The Best Interest Factors Favor Modification of the Current Custody Arrangement.*

20 The Legislature enacted twelve factors for Courts to consider when determining a custody
21 arrangement in the best interest of a child. See NRS 125C.0035(4)(a)-(l). The Court evaluates
22 the following factors below and finds it is in the Minor Children's best interest for Plaintiff to
23 continue to have primary physical custody.
24

1 a. *The wishes of the child if the child is of sufficient age and capacity to form an*
2 *intelligent preference as to his or her physical custody.*

3 The Minor Children are 17 and 15 and therefore of sufficient age and capacity to form an
4 intelligent preference as to their custody. They both communicated to the Court their wish is to
5 remain full time with Plaintiff. Therefore, this factor favors Plaintiff heavily.

6 b. *Any nomination of a guardian for the child by a parent.*

7
8 This factor does not favor either Party because neither Party informed the Court that the
9 Minor Child has a guardian.

10 c. *Which parent is more likely to allow the child to have frequent associations*
11 *and a continuing relationship with the noncustodial parent.*

12 This factor does not favor Plaintiff or Defendant because both Parties have demonstrated
13 their willingness to allow visitation with the Minor Child.

14 d. *The level of conflict between the parents.*

15 The level of conflict between the parents is extraordinarily high. Although this factor does
16 not weigh in favor of either Party, it weighs heavily against joint physical custody.

17 e. *The ability of the parents to cooperate to meet the needs of the child.*

18
19 Here, the ability of the parents to cooperate to meet the needs of the Minor Child is
20 unsatisfactory. The parents have continually been at odds about all aspects of the Minor
21 Children's needs. This factor is neutral towards the Parties.

22 f. *The mental and physical health of the parents.*

23
24 This factor does not weigh in favor of either Plaintiff or Defendant. Neither Party
25 presented a mental health concern about the other.

26 ///

1 g. *The physical, developmental, and emotional needs of the child.*

2 This factor weighs in favor of Plaintiff because she has had primary physical custody of
3 the Minor Children for over a decade and better understands the physical, developmental, and
4 emotional needs of the Minor Children. Moreover, Plaintiff recently enrolled the Minor Children
5 in boxing, which will help further their physical development. As such, this factor decidedly
6 favors Plaintiff.
7

8 h. *The nature of the relationship of the child with each parent.*

9 The Minor Children lived primarily with Plaintiff for the past decade of their life because
10 Plaintiff had primary physical custody and Defendant had minimal visitation rights. Therefore,
11 this factor weighs in Plaintiff's favor as she was the primary caregiver for the majority of the
12 Minor Children's life.
13

14 i. *The ability of the child to maintain a relationship with any sibling.*

15 The Minor Children have a strong bond with each other and thus this factor is neutral.
16

17 j. *Any history of parental abuse or neglect of the child or a sibling of the child.*

18 This factor weighs heavily against Defendant because Defendant previously physically
19 abused the Minor Children, which led to the Court awarding Plaintiff primary physical custody
20 of the Minor Children.
21

22 k. *Whether either parent or any other person seeking physical custody has*
23 *engaged in an act of domestic violence against the child, a parent of the child,*
or any other person residing with the child.

24 Again, this factor weighs against Defendant because of his past physical abuse against the
25 Minor Children.

1. *Whether either parent or any other person seeking physical custody has committed any act of abduction against the child or any other child.*

This factor does not apply here because neither Plaintiff nor Defendant have committed any acts of abduction against the Minor Child or any other child.

In sum, factors a, g, h, j, and k, weigh in favor of Plaintiff; no factors weigh in favor of Defendant; and factors b, c, d, e, f, i, and l, are either neutral or do not apply to the analysis. Therefore, it is in the Minor Child's best interest for Plaintiff to have primary physical and custody of the Minor Children.

CONCLUSION

Based on the foregoing and good cause appearing, the Court orders as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Ramirez Motion is **DENIED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that EDUARDO JAVIER RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 04/13/2006) and CARLOS ADRIAN RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 10/09/2007) shall submit to a drug test within thirty (30) days of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Arreguin shall enroll EDUARDO JAVIER RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 04/13/2006) and CARLOS ADRIAN RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 10/09/2007) in drug counseling.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Ramirez and Ms. Arreguin shall enroll in the Juvenile Probation Office's drug and alcohol program. However, they shall participate in the program at different times.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Arreguin shall ensure EDUARDO JAVIER RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 04/13/2006) and CARLOS ADRIAN RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 10/09/2007) remain in their boxing class.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if something happens to EDUARDO JAVIER RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 04/13/2006) and CARLOS ADRIAN RAMIREZ ARREGUIN (DOB: 10/09/2007), Ms. Arreguin must inform Mr. Ramirez of the incident.
