10 remittitur had issued and this Court was again vested with jurisdiction.

11 The Court rejects the Petitioner's argument that he was only ever legally sentenced on
12 an Attempted Robbery conviction. The record has been clear since sentencing – this Court
13 adjudicated him as a habitual criminal and sentenced him to a habitual criminal sentence.
14 Despite the jurisdictional issues, the Court finds that the Defendant has been properly
15 sentenced and did not expire his sentence on the Attempted Robbery conviction. This Court
16 issued its October 13, 2022, Corrected Judgment of Conviction *nunc pro tunc* to accurately
17 reflect the intent and specific sentence this Court imposed at the Petitioner's sentencing
18 hearing in 2015.

19 For those reasons, the Court finds the Petition is without merit, the jurisdictional issues
20 related to the Corrected Judgment of Conviction have been addressed and remedied, and the
21 State's Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED. The Petition is DISMISSED.

This hearing was held remotely based on the Administrative Orders entered in this District. The Court and all the participants appeared via simultaneous audiovisual transmission. The Court was physically located in Reno, Washoe County, Nevada which was the site of the court session. Counsel and the Defendant acknowledged receipt of Notice that the hearing was taking place pursuant to Nevada Supreme Court Rules- Part 9 relating to simultaneous audiovisual transmissions and all stated they had no objection to going forward in this manner.
