ORDER DENYING STAY

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order denying a motion for summary judgment and subsequent order imposing sanctions.

Petitioner has filed a motion to stay the district court proceedings pending the resolution of this petition for writ. In determining whether to grant a stay of the district court proceedings pending resolution of a writ petition, this court considers the following factors: (1) whether the object of the petition will be defeated if the stay is denied; (2) whether petitioner will suffer irreparable or serious injury if the stay is denied; (3) whether real parties in interest will suffer irreparable or serious injury if the stay is granted; and (4) whether petitioner is likely to prevail on the merits of the petition. NRAP 8(c); see also Fritz Hansen A/S v. Eighth Jud.

SUPREME COURT OF NEVADA Dist. Ct., 116 Nev. 650, 657, 6 P.3d 982, 986 (2000). Having considered the motion, the opposition thereto, and the reply, we conclude that petitioner has not demonstrated that these factors militate in favor of a stay of the district court proceedings at this time. Accordingly, we deny the motion to stay the district court proceedings.

It is so ORDERED.
