On COUNT II the Court ordered the Defendant to the Nevada Department of Corrections to serve a minimum term of twenty-eight (28) months and a maximum term of seventy-two (72) months.

The sentence imposed in COUNT II shall run consecutive to the sentence imposed in COUNT I.
