MEMORANDUM

I, JOSPEH Z. GERSTEN, am a duly licensed attorney in the State of Nevada and am employed by The Gersten Law Firm PLLC. Appellant's Counsel is requesting a short thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file his Petition for Rehearing under NRAP 40. Appellant's Petition is currently due January 8, 2024. This is the Appellant's First request for this specific relief.

This is an Appeal from a jury verdict in the Eight Judicial District Court, Department XII, the Honorable Leavitt, J. presiding.

This Court's decision was filed December 20, 2024, starting the eighteen (18) day countdown for filing.
