

ORDER DENYING MOTION TO FURTHER EXPEDITE RESOLUTION

On January 12, 2024, appellant filed a motion to expedite the resolution of this appeal from district court orders refusing to change venue and dismissing the underlying election law complaint for failure to state a claim, pointing out that the primary election is five months away. This court agreed to expedite the matter to the extent that its docket allows.

On March 5, 2024, appellant filed a letter, which this court construes as a motion, *see* NRAP 27(a)(1), again pointing to the upcoming primary election and other related deadlines and seeking a decision "within
