Holmes', Motion to Set Aside Order, Judgment, and/or Default 19("Plaintiff's Motion") having come on for hearing before the Court in the above-captioned matter 20on November 9, 2023 at the hour of 1:30 p.m. Plaintiff having appeared in proper person 21electronically by way of bluejeans, and Defendant, Capucine Y. Holmes ("Defendant"), having 22been represented at the hearing by and through her counsel of record, William H. Heaton of the 23Heaton Fontano, Ltd. law firm. The Court having read and reviewed Plaintiff's Motion, 24Defendant's opposition thereto and the other pleadings and papers on file herein, having heard 25arguments presented by Plaintiff and by Defendant's counsel, being fully informed with respect to 26the issues raised in Plaintiff's Motion and other good cause appearing, makes the following 27findings of fact and conclusions of law:

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A. On May 18, 2020, then Chief Judge, Linda Bell, issued a Decision and Order in this
 matter adjudging and declaring Plaintiff to be a vexatious litigant and imposing restrictions on
 Plaintiff's future in-proper-person filings in the Eighth Judicial District Court.

B. The Court has determined it appropriate to consider Plaintiff's Motion on its merits
without regard to any failure by Plaintiff to comply with requirements imposed by the May 18,
2020, Decision and Order on Plaintiff's in-proper-person filings.

C. Plaintiff's Motion does not clearly articulate and Plaintiffs argument at the time of
hearing did not identify the specific relief Plaintiff seeks, or grounds which would justify a grant
of relief to Plaintiff.

D. The Court assumes Plaintiff's Motion is directed to the Order Granting Summary Judgment which was entered herein on December 9, 2021, and the Order Awarding Attorney's Fees & Costs which was entered herein on January 3, 2022 (collectively the "Subject Orders").

E. To the extent Plaintiff's Motion seeks a rehearing of the motions from which the Subject Orders emanate, Plaintiff's Motion is untimely. EDCR 2.24 expressly requires motions for rehearing to be brought within 14 days after service of written notice of entry of the order or judgment that the subject of the motion for rehearing; however, Plaintiff's Motion was not filed until August, 2023, eighteen or more months after notice of entry of the Subject Orders was served.

18 F. To the extent Plaintiff's Motion asks that the Subject Orders be set aside pursuant 19to NRCP 60(b), it is also untimely. NRCP 60(c) requires that motions for relief under NRCP 60(b) 20be brought within a reasonable time - and, for reasons specified in subsections (1), (2) and (3) of 21Rule 60(b), no more than six months after the date of the proceeding or the date of service of 22written notice of entry of the judgment or order, whichever is later. Plaintiff's Motion does not 23articulate a specific basis for setting aside the Subject Orders pursuant to NRCP 60(b), but because 24Plaintiff's Motion was not filed until more than eighteen months after service of notice of entry of 25the Subject Orders, the Court deems Plaintiff's Motion untimely under the NRCP 60(c).

Based on the foregoing findings and conclusions, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion is denied.

As the failure of service within the statutory period cannot be cured and the plaintiff has not shown good cause as to why service was impossible to be completed within the period, defendant Tommy Cason, Lawrence Lee, Calvin Connor and Detroit Connection Inc. are hereby dismissed

Mr. Holmes's complaints appear to lack sufficient facts necessary to demonstrate the elements of Mr. Holmes's claims. Additionally, within the last three years, Mr. Holmes has filed five other complaints alleging intentional infliction of emotional distress, but each complaint was dismissed for failure to state a claim upon which relief could be granted. Likewise, Mr. Holmes's current complaints appear to lack any arguable factual or legal basis.

Therefore, the Court finds it is necessary that an Order to Show Cause Why Plaintiff Wilbert R. Holmes Should Not Be Deemed a Vexatious Litigant in one or more of the above referenced cases should issue. To accommodate this, Mr. Holmes's cases shall be coordinated through case no. A-17-760443-C and reassigned to Department 7 for the purpose of hearing the Order to Show Cause.
