This emergency petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order denying summary judgment in a civil rights and tort action.¹ Petitioners have also filed an emergency motion for stay pending our consideration of this matter, pointing out that trial is scheduled to begin next week.²

The motion is granted. SRCR 3(4) & 7. The clerk of this court shall file under seal the exhibits provisionally received in this court on January 18, 2024.

²Petitioners' January 17, 2024, motion for stay exceeds the NRAP 27(d)(2) page limits. As a second, NRAP 27(d)(2)-compliant stay motion was filed on January 18, we deem the January 18 filing the operative motion and direct the clerk of this court to strike the January 17 motion.

Having reviewed the petition and supporting documents, we conclude that an answer may assist this court in resolving the petition. Therefore, real party in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 28 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. NRAP 21(b)(1). Petitioners shall have 14 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.

We temporarily stay the district court proceedings pending our receipt and consideration of any opposition to the stay motion and further order of this court. Any opposition to the stay motion is due by January 25, 2024.
