MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

This Court has never denied a reasonable motion to expedite an appeal of a ballot measure case. The schedule suggested by Respondents is generous, especially compared with Appellants' position that the matter not be expedited at all. It is inarguable that the fundamental rights of Nevadans to employ the initiative process include the right to prompt resolution of legal challenges to filed petitions, and this Court has always performed its work commensurate with the importance of that charge. Respondents request their proposed briefing schedule be adopted in this appeal, and that the matter be placed on the Court's September *en banc* argument calendar.
