



PETITION

Elissa F. Cadish, Chief Justice, Nevada Supreme Court, petitions the Supreme Court on its administrative docket to create a Commission to Study Judicial Branch Security. The Commission will be charged with studying and making recommendations regarding information gathering and sharing, training security officers and judicial officers, identifying and categorizing threats, responding to threats and violence, courthouse security, and interfacing with other branches of government.

Given the nationwide increase in incidents of courthouse violence, it is imperative that we engage in a thorough assessment of security concerns and procedures to ensure the safety of our Nevada courthouses, justices, judges, and court personnel.

Accordingly, petitioner requests that the Supreme Court place this matter on its administrative docket, hold such hearings as it deems necessary and consider creating a Commission to Study Judicial Branch Security.
