## ANAGAN'S MOTION TO VACATE BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Appellant Dale Edward Flanagan respectfully moves this Court for an order vacating the briefing schedule set out in its March 18, 2003 Order.

In accordance with that Order, appellant has once again reviewed the district court record. That record continues to be incomplete in that the district court clerk's office is unable to locate portions of the file. Despite indications that transcripts were filed with the APR 0 2 2003

district court on some of the dates for which appellant filed requests for transcripts, those transcripts are not in the record and appellant does not have copies of them.

Consequently, appellant has filed amended requests for transcripts as directed by the Court's March 18, 2003 Order. Those requests have been on file with the court reporters for nearly 90 days, but appellant has had no response from the court reporters as yet.

Consequently, even if the reporters reply promptly, it will be virtually impossible for appellant to incorporate all of those transcripts and get the entire record numbered and prepared in volumes as required by the rules and filed with the opening brief on the schedule set out in the Court's March 18, 2003 Order.

Furthermore, appellant did not ignore the rules in not filing his opening brief earlier, but rather was in communication with the Supreme Court clerk's office seeking direction because of the incompleteness of the record. Appellant was advised to await completion of the record before establishing a briefing schedule.

Appellant therefore respectfully requests that all dates relating to briefing be vacated and that a briefing schedule be set only after the transcript requests that have been
