POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Rule 28(g) of the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure states in pertinent part as follows:

Rule 28. Briefs.

(g) Length of briefs. Except by permission of the court, briefs shall not exceed 30 pages, exclusive of pages containing the table of contents, tables of citations and any addendum containing statutes, rules, regulations, etc.

In order to fully develop the facts and brief the issues, the Opening Brief is in excess of 30 pages, to-wit 42 pages. There were numerous pretrial and post trial motions which gave rise to important appeal issues. In addition, the jury trial lasted over one month thereby causing the trial transcript to be quite voluminous. In order to properly address the important appeal issues which must be raised in this first degree murder conviction, Appellant needs to file a brief with more than thirty (30) pages.

Therefore, it is respectfully requested that this Court enter an order granting the expansion of the length of the Appellant's Opening Brief to 42 pages.

- 3. That affiant therefore requests that this Court allow the length of the Opening Brief to be 42 pages.


