## **MEMORANDUM**

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief under NRAP 31(b)(3). On August 26, 2011 Appellant requested an extension of time to file his Opening Brief. On December 19, 2011 Appellant requested another extension of time to file his Opening Brief. No previous extensions have been granted to the State. As good cause for the extension, the State cites the size of the record and the issues raised in the Opening Brief.

This is a direct appeal from a denial of a petition for writ of habeas corpus (post-conviction). Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal on June 13, 2011 and filed his Opening Brief on January 24, 2012. Respondent's Answering Brief is due on or before March 23, 2012.

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b), this Court for good cause shown can enlarge the time prescribed by the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure for doing any act, or may permit an act to be done after the expiration of such time. In addition, NRAP 31 allows for an initial extension of time of up to thirty (30) days upon a showing of good cause.

This case involves a record consisting of a sixteen (16) volume appendix consisting of 3024 pages. The seventy-one (71) page Opening Brief raises approximately seven (7) main issues and multiple sub-issues.

The State respectfully moves for an enlargement of time of thirty (30) days, making said brief due on Monday, April 23, 2012. This will give the State sufficient time to thoroughly review and respond fully to the material in Appellant's Opening Brief.
