MOTION TO EXCEED TYPE-VOLUME LIMITATION

Pursuant to NRAP 32(a)(7)(D), appellant moves for leave to file an opening exceeding the type-volume limitation set out in NRAP 32(a)(7)(A)(ii) by 6,136 words.

The brief is longer than normal because this case calls for detailed discussion of the record. For the Court's ease of reference, the brief contains a few quite lengthy quotations from the trial transcript. This is an unusual style but an effective one where the actual communications at trial are essential to understanding and resolving the issues. *See, e.g., Jitnan v. Oliver*, 127 Nev. ___, 254 P.3d 623 (2011) (per SAITTA, J.) (opinion uses extensive block quotes from the

trial). In this case, a longer brief actually may take less time to analyze than a shorter one that requires frequent resort to a separate appendix or transcript.
