Currently pending before this Court, and before multiple district courts in Nevada, are cases addressing the effect of HOA "super-priority liens" under NRS 116.3116. This issue is of particular interest to the State Bar of Nevada Real Property Section, because this section is comprised of members who frequently encounter this issue in daily practice. The Proposed Amicus wish to file an amicus brief for the limited purpose of directing the Court's attention to the current national discussion regarding both the policy and the interpretation of Section 3-116 of the Uniform Common Interest Ownership Act (UCIOA), the basis of NRS 116.3116.
