MEMORANDUM

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief pursuant to NRAP 31.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due July 31, 2015. This is a direct appeal from the Judgment of Conviction. Pursuant to NRAP 31(b)(3)(B), an initial request for extension of time in a non-capital case will be granted on a clear showing of good cause. Subsequent extensions of time will not be granted except upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B).

The State's has had two 30 day extensions due to the length and complexity of the issues included in the Opening Brief. The State makes its third request for an extension of time, citing the following as extraordinary circumstances and extreme need: While the State has made significant progress on the Answering Brief, due to employee turnover in the Appeals Division the State requests another 30 days in which to complete the Answering Brief. The law clerk assigned to the brief has moved to a new division, and was unable to fully complete the brief due to multiple other assignments which needed completing prior to the division change. However, as the Answering Brief is partially completed, the State is certain that given 30 days, a thorough and complete Answering Brief will be filed.
