*ORDER DENYING MOTION  
TO FILE AMICI CURIAE BRIEF*

The National Association of Pretrial Services Agencies, Pretrial Justice Institute, and National Association for Public Defense have filed an untimely motion for leave to file an amici brief. *See* NRAP 29(f) (providing that an amicus party must file its brief no later than seven days after the brief of the party being supported is filed). The State opposes the motion as untimely and because the proposed brief raises new issues ancillary to the subject of the instant proceeding. Having reviewed the motion, the opposition, and the reply, we deny the motion for leave to file an amici brief.
