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4 Q. But you do remember talking to them;
5 is that correct?

6 A. Yeah, I remember talking to them.

7 THE COURT: Are you saying him? was
8 it one detective or two detectives?

9 THE WITNESS: I remember --

10 THE COURT: So we've been going for an
11 hour and a half. I think it's time for a break.
12 I'm going to take a five-minute break. You can get
13 up, walk around, use the rest room. Be back in
14 five minutes. All right. Do you want to go out
15 that way or she can use the rest room over here.

16 (Whereupon a recess was
17 taken at 1:26 p.m. and
18 the proceedings resumed
19 at 1:32 p.m.)

20 THE COURT: Okay. So the record will
21 reflect that we took a few minute break and while
22 we were in the hallway, the witness asked me how
23 much longer she thought she'd be asked questions.

24 MS. ALLEN: For the record I don't
25 think it's very much. I apologize. I lost my

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1 train of thought.

2 THE COURT: You were asking about
3 punishment.

4 MS. ALLEN: That's correct.

5 Q. Remember I'd asked you some questions
6 about talking to the detective.

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. You indicated I just want to make sure
9 you remember they talked to you at the Blankenship
10 house; is that right? Yes? But please speak into
11 the microphone because we need to be able to hear
12 you. I'm almost done. Okay.

13 Do you remember when the police came
14 to the house on Blankenship to talk to you?

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. Okay. Did they talk to all of you?

17 MS. LUZAICH: Well, objection, vague
18 as to all of you.

19 MS. ALLEN:

20 Q. Do you remember who they talked to?

21 A. I know they talked to Taquanda.

22 Q. They talked to Taquanda?

23 A. Uh-huh.

24 Q. Is that a yes?

25 A. Yes.

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HARRIS - VOL. I

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- 1 Q. And they talked to you; is that right?
- 2 A. Yes.
- 3 Q. Do you remember if they talked to Ann?
- 4 A. I don't know. I don't remember if
- 5 they talked to her.
- 6 Q. Okay. Were there any other of your
- 7 sisters that were living in the house at the time?
- 8 A. No.
- 9 Q. At the time that you spoke with that
- 10 detective in 2011, you didn't tell him about
- 11 anything that had happened with Fred; is that
- 12 right?
- 13 A. That's right.
- 14 Q. You didn't say anything about being
- 15 hit with a belt; is that right?
- 16 A. No.
- 17 Q. You didn't say anything about Fred
- 18 touching your vagina; is that right?
- 19 A. No, I didn't say anything.
- 20 Q. And they asked you a lot of questions
- 21 about that, didn't they?
- 22 A. I guess, yes.
- 23 Q. You don't remember.

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24 A. I don't remember.
25 Q. Okay. Do you know Shakira?

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1 A. Uh-huh. I know her.
2 Q. And do you know who she is?
3 A. Yes.
4 Q. Pardon?
5 A. Yes.
6 Q. Okay. Who is she?
7 A. She's Miss Ann's daughter.
8 Q. Ms. Ann's daughter. Did she live at
9 the house?
10 A. Yes.
11 Q. Do you want to eat the candy?
12 A. No, no, I'm cool.
13 THE COURT: Do you need a -- go
14 ahead.
15 MS. ALLEN:
16 Q. Who is Shakira?
17 A. Shakira is Ms. Anne's daughter.
18 Q. Do you know how old she is?

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19 A. Right now she's either 19 or -- right
20 now she would either be 19 or 20 right now.

21 Q. All right. And did she live there
22 when you did?

23 A. Like she -- like she would live there
24 and she would move out then she would come back
25 again.

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1 Q. So she was in and out of the house?

2 A. Not like in and out. She would stay
3 there for a long period of time and then move out
4 then come back.

5 Q. What I mean she didn't live there the
6 whole time you did. You said she'd move in and
7 out. Is that right?

8 A. Yes.

9 Q. Did you ever see Fred beat or hit or
10 whip Shakira?

11 A. No.

12 Q. Okay. Do you know Fred's daughter,

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- 13 Shaday (phonetic)?
- 14 A. I heard of her.
- 15 Q. Did he ever beat Shaday?
- 16 A. No. I don't remember that, no.
- 17 Q. What about a son by the name of
- 18 Moses. You never met Moses.
- 19 A. I met him.
- 20 Q. You did. Yes. And did you ever see
- 21 Fred whip Moses?
- 22 A. No.
- 23 Q. Did you ever have any problems with
- 24 Shakira?
- 25 A. No.

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- 1 Q. Did you ever did take anything from
- 2 her?
- 3 A. No.
- 4 Q. Are you currently on any medication?
- 5 A. No.
- 6 Q. You're not taking any medications at
- 7 all?

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8 A. No.

9 Q. Did you have -- at any point in time
10 from 2007 to when you moved out in 2012, were there
11 any other kids living there besides your family?

12 THE COURT: Other than Shakira?

13 MS. ALLEN: Other than Shakira.

14 Q. Were there any cousins living there or
15 any other children of Miss Ann's, anybody else?

16 A. When we first moved in there was like,
17 it was like some kids staying there.

18 Q. Okay. Do you know what kids they
19 were?

20 A. No.

21 Q. Do you know who they belonged to or
22 how they were related to anybody?

23 A. They was related to Fred.

24 Q. They were related to Fred. Okay. Do
25 you remember their name?

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1 A. No.

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2 Q. Do you remember how old they were?

3 A. They was little.

4 Q. When you say little, do you mean like
5 five, six years old?

6 A. Like somewhere around that age.

7 Q. Little little kids?

8 A. It wasn't little little but like yeah.

9 Q. Okay. And do you remember how many
10 there were?

11 A. No.

12 Q. Okay. And do you remember if they
13 were boys or girls?

14 A. Well, I know there was boys.

15 Q. When you say boys, meaning more than
16 one boy?

17 A. I don't -- I can't remember.

18 Q. You can't remember. Okay.

19 MS. ALLEN: I think I pass the
20 witness.

21 THE COURT: Take a moment.

22 MS. ALLEN: Okay. I think I pass the
23 witness.

24 (whereupon Ms. Allen concluded
25 this portion of her examination

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1 at 1:40 p.m.)

2 THE COURT: Any further questions?

3 MS. LUZAICH: Yeah, thank you, sorry,
4 Tahara, it doesn't mean you're quite done yet.
5 Okay.

6 REDIRECT EXAMINATION

7 BY MS. LUZAICH:

8 Q. Now, the last bunch of questions that
9 Ms. Allen asked you about was when the Henderson
10 detective came and talked to you in 2011 at the
11 Blankenship house just so that we're talking about
12 the same thing. You remember that, those questions
13 and stuff. Now, when he came and talked to you,
14 was it like 3:30 in the morning?

15 A. I know it was early.

16 Q. Like in the middle of the night?

17 A. Well, yeah.

18 Q. And were Fred and Ann in the next room
19 when they came or at least in the house when they
20 came and talked to you?

21 A. Uh-huh.

22 Q. Is that a yes?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. Why did you not tell the Henderson
25 detective what Fred had been doing?

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1 A. I don't know, I was scared to talk
2 about it.

3 Q. What were you scared of?

4 A. I don't remember if I was just scared.

5 Q. Were you ready to talk about it yet to
6 anybody?

7 Is that a no? You're shaking your
8 head back and forth.

9 A. No.

10 Q. Had you told Taquanda? Yes?

11 A. No.

12 Q. Taquanda hadn't seen what happened in
13 the laundry room yet, had she?

14 A. No.

15 Q. Had you told anybody by then?

16 A. No.

17 Q. As -- Ms. Allen also asked you about,
18 you know, where you got your clothes and stuff for
19 school. She asked you did Fred and Ann buy you
20 your clothes and you kind of hesitated when you
21 answered that. You don't personally know who paid
22 for all that stuff, do you?

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23 A. Fred and Ann I guess.

24 Q. You guess but you don't know. They

25 physically drove you somewhere so that you got

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1 clothes?

2 A. Uh-huh.

3 Q. Is that a yes?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q. She also asked you about whether or
6 not Shabazz had a temper. Did Fred have a temper?

7 A. That's like I don't know like yes and
8 then like I don't know. Like I don't know. Like
9 yes.

10 Q. Why are you kind of wishy-washy about
11 that?

12 A. Because like there would be good days
13 and there would be bad days like.

14 Q. Tell me what a good day would be
15 like.

16 A. Like we would probably go out to eat

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17 or we would go to the movies or we would go to the
18 park.

19 Q. Okay. Would a good day remain a good
20 day?

21 A. Not always. There would always be
22 something that happened to mess it up or something
23 like that.

24 Q. Okay. Were there more good days or
25 more bad days?

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1 A. Even out.

2 Q. When we talk about the things that
3 happened that Fred did, you talked about things
4 that happened in Fred and Ann's room. Did it
5 happen more than one time in Fred and Ann's room?

6 A. Uh-huh.

7 Q. Is that a yes?

8 A. Yes.

9 Q. In Fred and Ann's room is there a
10 bathroom?

11 A. Yes, they had a bathroom.
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12 Q. Okay. Did it happen in there as
13 well?

14 You're nodding your head.

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. Did it happen more than one time in
17 your old room?

18 A. Yes.

19 Q. Did it happen more than one time in
20 the laundry room?

21 A. I can't remember.

22 Q. Okay.

23 THE COURT: What are we talking about
24 happening specifically? I'm not sure what you're
25 asking.

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1 MS. LUZAICH: Well, the sexual
2 touching.

3 THE COURT: Right. But you're --
4 digital, penis, touching the breasts so I mean I
5 don't know --

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6 MS. LUZAICH: Right.

7 THE COURT: -- what you're asking.

8 MS. LUZAICH: Ms. Allen was asking her
9 about a specific incident in Fred and Ann's room.
10 My point is just that it happened more than one
11 time, not just one time.

12 THE COURT: Okay. All right. I just
13 want to know if you're going to be alleging new
14 counts or not.

15 MS. LUZAICH: Your Honor, I expect I
16 will after we see the transcript but I also
17 recognize that there are some counts that I haven't
18 met so

19 THE COURT: So when I was asking for
20 clarification so if you're alleging new counts,
21 you're going to clarify which count we're talking
22 about.

23 MR. LUZAICH: Thank you.

24 Q. Is it difficult for you to talk about
25 the sexual touching?

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1 You're nodding your head again.

2 A. Yes.

3 Q. Why?

4 A. That's an uncomfortable subject for
5 me.

6 Q. Okay. Have you told me in the past
7 that you've done everything you can to forget it?

8 A. Yes.

9 MS. ALLEN: Your Honor, I'd object.

10 THE COURT: Sustained.

11 MS. LUZAICH:

12 Q. Do you want to remember these things?

13 A. No.

14 MS. LUZAICH: I pass the witness.

15 (Whereupon Ms. Luzaich concluded
16 her examination at 1:45 p.m.).

17 MS. ALLEN: Just briefly.

18 RE CROSS-EXAMINATION

19 BY MS. ALLEN:

20 Q. You said that you were -- when you
21 talked to the Henderson police officer, that you
22 were scared; is that right?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. Were you scared because he's a police
25 officer?

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1 A. No.

2 Q. Okay. Do you trust police officers
3 generally?

4 Are police officers there to help you?

5 A. Yes.

6 Q. And you knew he was a police officer;
7 isn't that right?

8 A. Yes.

9 Q. He showed you a badge?

10 A. Yes.

11 Q. Did he explain to you what he was
12 there for?

13 A. I don't know. Yes.

14 Q. That was in 2011; is that right?

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. Were you still talking to your mom
17 back then?

18 A. Yes. What do you mean by that?

19 Q. Well, did you talk to your mom on the
20 phone?

21 A. Sometimes.

22 Q. Did you see her?

23 A. Sometimes.

24 Q. Did you stay with her?

25 A. Sometimes.

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1 Q. Okay. So Miss Ann or Fred would take
2 you and your sister Taquanda over to stay with your
3 mom and Vickie maybe for a weekend?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q. Okay. You were in touch -- what I'm
6 saying is you were in touch with your mom during
7 this time, is that right, in 2011?

8 A. Yes.

9 Q. What about in 2010, did you have
10 contact with your mom in 2010?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. The same thing, would you go there on
13 the weekend?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. And how about in 2012?

16 A. Uh-huh.

17 Q. Yes?

18 A. Yes.

19 Q. Okay. Ms. Luzaich, Lisa asked you
20 about what happened in Fred and Ann's room, the

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21 sexual touching in Fred and Ann's room, and she

22 specifically said something about the bathroom. Do

23 you remember that question a few minutes ago?

24 A. Huh-uh.

25 Q. No. Okay. Lisa asked a few minutes

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1 ago about sexual touching that had happened in Fred
2 and Ann's room. Do you remember that just a couple
3 minutes ago?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q. And she specifically said it happened
6 in the bathroom.

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. Do you remember me asking you
9 questions about something that happened in the
10 bathroom?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Okay. And do you remember talking to
13 a woman in September of 2012 about the incident
14 that happened in the bathroom?

15 THE COURT: Okay. Hold on a second.
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16 In the shower, is this in the bathroom or not?

17 MS. ALLEN: She had gotten out of the
18 shower.

19 THE COURT: Was the bathroom Fred and
20 Ann's bathroom or was it a different bathroom in
21 the house?

22 THE WITNESS: It was Fred and Ann's
23 bathroom.

24 MS. ALLEN:

25 Q. Do you remember telling the woman in

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1 2012 about an incident that happened after you got
2 out of the shower?

3 A. Yes.

4 Q. And can you describe that incident for
5 me now.

6 You're shaking your head no. Is that
7 a no?

8 A. Yeah, that's a no.

9 Q. Why can't you describe it for me now?

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10 Pardon?

11 A. I don't know. I don't want to.

12 Q. You don't want to.

13 A. No. You all should know what
14 happened. We've been talking about it the whole
15 time.

16 MS. ALLEN: Okay.

17 THE COURT: Let me explain how this
18 process works. All right? So the fact that you've
19 spoken to other people, you haven't told me and I'm
20 the one that needs to hear. Okay?

21 THE WITNESS: Okay.

22 THE COURT: So they're not trying to
23 be mean to you. We're not trying to, you know,
24 annoy you or upset you or make you talk about
25 things you don't want to talk about, but I have to

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1 hear so I've never heard any of this before so when
2 they're asking you all these questions, they're
3 doing it for my benefit so I hear what you've told
4 them and what you told other people. So I

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5 apologize for being mean but you have to tell me.
6 So you said something happened after you got out of
7 the shower when you were in Fred and Ann's
8 bathroom.

9 THE WITNESS: Yes.

10 THE COURT: So tell me what happened.

11 THE WITNESS: Well, I had got out of
12 the bathroom and I guess the light went off and I
13 guess I got raped.

14 MS. ALLEN: Okay. I'm sorry, Your
15 Honor. May I proceed? Okay.

16 Q. So you got out of the shower and you
17 said the light went off?

18 A. Uh-huh.

19 Q. Yes?

20 A. Yes.

21 Q. Did you shut the light off?

22 A. No.

23 Q. Did you see who shut the light off?

24 A. No.

25 Q. All right. They just went off.

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1 A. Yes.

2 Q. Were you still in the shower when the
3 light went off?

4 A. No. I just got out.

5 Q. Is the light switch in the bathroom or
6 is it outside the bathroom?

7 A. Like this went in the bathroom and
8 there's one outside the bathroom.

9 Q. Okay. So you can shut the light off
10 and on both in and out of the bathroom?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Okay. And then you said you got
13 raped; is that right?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Can you describe for me how it
16 happened.

17 THE COURT: Okay. So you got out of
18 the shower. Did you have a towel on you or not?
19 Do you remember?

20 THE WITNESS: I don't remember.

21 THE COURT: You remember you were
22 taking a shower and then you got out of the shower
23 and then the light went off in the bathroom,
24 right?

25 THE WITNESS: Uh-huh.

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1 THE COURT: Okay. And then what
2 happened?

3 THE WITNESS: That's all I remember.

4 THE COURT: Did somebody come into the
5 bathroom?

6 THE WITNESS: Uh-huh.

7 THE COURT: Yes.

8 THE WITNESS: Yes.

9 MS. ALLEN: I'm assuming those were
10 all yeses for the last four or five questions.

11 THE COURT: And you don't know who it
12 was who came in the bathroom.

13 THE WITNESS: I know who it was.

14 THE COURT: So who came into the
15 bathroom when the lights were off?

16 THE WITNESS: Fred.

17 THE COURT: And how do you know it was
18 Fred?

19 THE WITNESS: 'Cause he was the only
20 one into the room when I was taking a shower.

21 THE COURT: Was he in the bathroom
22 when you were taking a shower?

23 THE WITNESS: No.

24 THE COURT: Where was he?

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25 THE WITNESS: He was in the bedroom.

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1 THE COURT: Fred and Ann's bedroom?

2 THE WITNESS: Yes.

3 THE COURT: Not connected to that
4 bathroom.

5 THE WITNESS: Yes.

6 THE COURT: Is the bathroom connected
7 to Fred and Ann's bathroom?

8 THE WITNESS: Yes.

9 THE COURT: was there anybody else
10 home at the time?

11 THE WITNESS: There was only my sister
12 home.

13 THE COURT: Okay. So just you, Fred
14 and Taquanda.

15 THE WITNESS: Yes.

16 THE COURT: Okay. Go ahead.

17 MS. ALLEN: Thank you.

18 Q. Okay. So you said Fred came into the
19 bathroom; is that correct?

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20 A. Uh-huh.
21 Q. Did you see his face?
22 A. No.
23 Q. You didn't see his face. Okay. But
24 you said that -- I know this is difficult, but I
25 need you to describe it to me. You said you were

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1 raped. So what happened?
2 were you on the ground, were you
3 standing up, what happened?
4 A. When I was standing up.
5 Q. Okay. You were standing up and were
6 you facing him?
7 A. No.
8 Q. Okay. What were you facing?
9 A. The wall.
10 Q. Okay. And you said that -- what part
11 of his body touched your body?
12 A. His private part.
13 Q. His penis?

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- 14 A. Uh-huh.
- 15 Q. His penis touch what on you?
- 16 A. My private part.
- 17 Q. Your vagina?
- 18 A. Uh-huh.
- 19 Q. Yes. Okay. Was that the first time
- 20 that ever happened?
- 21 A. No.
- 22 Q. In the bathroom that's not the first
- 23 time that ever happened?
- 24 A. It happened multiple times.
- 25 Q. Okay. So but what I'm asking is when

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- 1 you said today about what happened in the bathroom,
- 2 that was not the first time it happened to you; is
- 3 that right?
- 4 A. Right.
- 5 Q. Okay. It had happened prior to that?
- 6 A. Yes.
- 7 Q. Okay. You said you described good
- 8 days with Fred and Ann and you said that it

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9 involved movies and going out to eat; is that
10 right?

11 A. Uh-huh.

12 Q. Yes. Is that a yes?

13 A. Yes.

14 Q. And did you -- would he take all of
15 you? You, your sister Taquanda, Ann, Shakira,
16 would you guys all go out when he did this?

17 A. Yes.

18 Q. Okay. Anybody else go with you guys?

19 A. It was, sometimes we would take
20 Ms. Ann's niece, Nana, we would take her.

21 Q. Nana?

22 A. Uh-huh.

23 Q. Is that her real name or that is her
24 nickname?

25 A. That's her nickname.

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1 Q. Do you know her real name?

2 A. Uh-huh.

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1 THE COURT: You have to leave at 3:00
2 or you have to leave before 3:00?

3 THE MARSHAL: 3:00.

4 THE COURT: 3:00 o'clock you're
5 walking out the door. Do you have someone who can
6 cover for you?

7 THE MARSHAL: Yes, I have someone.

8 THE COURT: The next witness.

9 MS. LUZAICH: Taquanda.

10 THE COURT: Taquanda is how old?

- 5 Q. Okay. when you came down back to Las
- 6 Vegas and moved into the house on Blankenship, who
- 7 moved into the house on Blankenship?
- 8 A. Okay. First it was me, Mahlica and
- 9 Shabazz and Tahara, and my mom and Vickie lived on
- 10 walnut.
- 11 Q. Okay. So when you came back to Utah
- 12 the four of you live in the house on Blankenship,
- 13 mom and Vickie went somewhere else.
- 14 A. Yes.
- 15 Q. When you got to the house on
- 16 Blankenship, did anybody live there with Fred and
- 17 Miss Ann?
- 18 A. Yeah. I guess some other children
- 19 lived there but I don't know who.
- 20 Q. Okay. As time went by and you
- 21 continue to live there, did anybody that was not in

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22 your family also live with you?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. Who was that?

25 A. Shakira lived there, Marcus and

2 Q. Who?

3 A. Lonnie.

4 Q. Who is that?

5 A. I guess Ms. Ann's cousin.

6 Q. Did he live there the whole time?

7 A. Not the whole time.

8 Q. How much of it?

10 Q. Okay. Shakira, who is that?

11 A. Miss Ann's God daughter.

12 Q. Did she always live there?

13 A. No.

14 Q. Did she kind of come and go?

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. And you mentioned Marcus. Was that

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- 17 the first name you said? Who is Marcus?
18 A. Miss Ann's son.
19 Q. Okay. Did he always live there?
20 A. No.
21 Q. How long did he live there?
22 A. Like for a year.
23 Q. Okay. After -- when you started the
24 first grade and it was you and Shabazz, Mahlica and
25 Tahara did there come a time that mom and Victoria,

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- 1 Vickie came?
2 A. Yes.
3 Q. When was that about?
4 A. I really don't remember but I guess it
5 was like a year after we came.
6 Q. Okay. And then did they live there
7 for a while?
8 A. Yes.
9 Q. And when I say a while, how much is a
10 while, weeks, months, years?

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- 11 A. Probably a year.
12 Q. Did there come a time that some people
13 moved out of the house?
14 A. Yes.
15 Q. Of your family I should say.
16 A. Yes.
17 Q. Okay. Who moved out?
18 A. My mom, Vickie, Mahlica, and Shabazz.
19 Q. Do you remember when it was they moved
20 out or what grade you were in when they moved out?
21 A. I was in, it was the summer of fourth
22 grade.
23 Q. The summer you finished fourth grade
24 or the summer you were getting ready to start
25 fourth grade if you remember?

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- 1 A. I don't remember, but I remember in
2 fourth grade I would go to visit them so it was
3 probably like the beginning.
4 Q. Okay. When you would visit them when
5 you were in fourth grade, where would you go to

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6 visit them?

7 A. I would go to the Alexander apartment.

8 Q. Is that also St. Andrews?

9 A. Yeah, yes.

10 Q. Okay. So St. Andrews on Alexander?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Did they then move to another
13 apartment?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Where is that?

16 A. They moved to Lakewood in Henderson.

17 Q. Okay. Now, when you guys moved into
18 the house in 2007, how did -- how did Fred act?

19 A. He was -- when I first moved in, I
20 really wasn't around him 'cause I was little.

21 Q. Did you see things going on around
22 you?

23 A. Yes.

24 Q. What did you see going on around you?

25 A. I saw -- well, this is as I grew older

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1 I saw him being very abusive towards animals and my
2 family, my sisters and brother.

3 Q. Okay. What did you see him do towards
4 your family, your sisters and brother?

5 A. Starting with who?

6 Q. Your choice.

7 A. Well, I'm going to start with me so I
8 guess there's this day I don't know what year it
9 was but everyone was getting in trouble that day
10 and so -- no. I can't start with me.

11 I'm going to start with Shabazz. So
12 we was cleaning and stuff and Shabazz I guess he
13 got in trouble 'cause he got RPC'd or something for
14 something with a girl based on what a girl -- I
15 can't remember what it was, but it was funny
16 though.

17 I can't remember what it was but and
18 so like when you walk in the kitchen there was,
19 when you walk in the kitchen there's a counter,
20 there's the kitchen and then there's a counter and
21 then there's a slide door and Fred and Shabazz was
22 over there talking and I heard them talking, but I
23 didn't go in the kitchen.

24 I went back because when I was going
25 in I was going to get a trash bag but I stood back

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1 and Shabazz and Fred was in that corner where the
2 slide door was and the counter door was and Fred
3 was asking questions and stuff like why and
4 stuff -- I don't remember exactly the type of
5 questions he was asking him but I guess it was
6 taking Shabazz too long to answer and I guess Fred
7 just started punching him and stuff.

8 Q. Did you see that happen?

9 A. Yes.

10 Q. How did Shabazz react?

11 A. He was like blocking.

12 Q. Okay. When you say you saw Fred
13 punching, where was he punching him? Where was
14 Fred punching Shabazz? Sorry.

15 A. In the face and the shoulder and the
16 stomach.

17 Q. Did you see any marks left on Shabazz
18 after that?

19 A. No, I didn't see any marks. I just
20 saw like you know when someone hits you and your
21 skin turns red and stuff, yeah.

22 Q. Okay. Where did you see red marks?

23 A. On his arms and his like on his cheek.

24 Q. And with your right hand you were
25 rubbing your right cheek; is that correct?

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1 A. Yes.

2 Q. Just now. Okay. So you saw red marks
3 on his arms and on his cheeks.

4 What was Fred's tone while he was
5 talking to Shabazz? Was he talking quietly like
6 you and I are right now or was it different?

7 A. It would be, when I first walked in
8 there, it was like that but then it got louder.

9 Q. Okay. Was that the only thing that
10 you ever saw regarding Shabazz?

11 A. No. And then so when Shabazz, when
12 they got done when Shabazz got back I ran back and
13 then after that I saw Shabazz going his way I went
14 in that hallway again and I went in the kitchen to
15 get a trash bag and Fred turned around and he got
16 like there's a big butcher knife and he, and I was
17 right there 'cause there's another counter with --
18 I guess there's another cabinet where the trash
19 cans was but the trash can but where the trash bags
20 was and he turned.

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21 There's another drawer on the other
22 side of the sink so he turned and he got in that
23 and he held it to me and he was like do you want to
24 die, and then I was like, it was quiet, then I was
25 like no and then he just put the knife back and

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1 then I went back in the room.
2 Q. I'm sorry, honey.
3 A. Can I have water?
4 THE COURT: Sure.
5 MS. LUZAICH:
6 Q. When you say he got the knife from the
7 kitchen, who is he?
8 A. Fred.
9 Q. And when Fred was holding the butcher
10 knife and saying that to you, how did you feel?
11 A. I felt scared.
12 Q. Did you feel like he was still angry
13 regarding Shabazz?
14 A. Yes.

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15 Q. He hadn't calmed down?

16 A. No.

17 Q. He didn't touch you with the knife,

18 though, correct?

19 A. Yeah.

20 Q. Yes, he did?

21 A. Yes.

22 Q. Where did he touch you with the knife?

23 A. He held it right here up like in the

24 movies they hold it to your throat but he didn't

25 hold it like this. He held it like this.

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1 Q. What part of the knife was --

2 A. The point.

3 Q. The point of the knife was touching

4 your neck.

5 A. Yes.

6 Q. Like the center of your neck.

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. Directly between your shoulder. I'm

9 trying to make a record. Is that right?

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10 A. Right here.

11 Q. I guess the better question was he
12 didn't cut you with the knife.

13 A. No.

14 Q. It didn't break the skin, did it?

15 A. No.

16 Q. Is that a no?

17 A. No.

18 Q. Okay. Did he ever say anything to you
19 about that afterward?

20 A. No.

21 Q. Was there another incident that you
22 observed regarding Shabazz?

23 A. Yeah, and then like the day after or,
24 yeah, the day after like they would always go in
25 the garage and stuff and I guess he was beating him

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1 up 'cause that's what I heard like, you know, like
2 when they be making those punching sounds.

3 Q. Okay. I'm going to stop you for a

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4 second. who was in the garage?

5 A. Fred and Shabazz.

6 Q. And when you said you heard, where

7 were you so you could hear?

8 A. I was in the hallway listening.

9 Q. And you said you heard the punching

10 sounds.

11 A. Yeah.

12 Q. Did you hear any words spoken?

13 A. I just heard like quiet conversation

14 but I didn't know what they was saying and then

15 after that you could just hear like the punching in

16 there.

17 Q. Okay. Did you see one or both of them

18 come out of the garage?

19 A. I saw them go and I saw them come out

20 and that day when he came out he had like a red

21 thing in his eye.

22 Q. Who is he?

23 A. Shabazz had like, yeah.

24 Q. Shabazz had a red thing in his eye?

25 A. Yeah, like it was busted.

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1 Q. Did you see anything else around his
2 eye?

3 A. Like on the skin around his eye. It
4 was just like, it was like kind of dark right there
5 and then you could see like a vein busted in his
6 eye and it was red.

7 THE COURT: Was it dark? I'm sorry I
8 couldn't see. So you're pointing.

9 THE WITNESS: It wasn't really dark
10 where you can see but it wasn't really -- it was
11 like dark.

12 THE COURT: So you were pointing to
13 your right eye. Was it Shabazz's right eye or his
14 left eye, do you know?

15 THE WITNESS: I don't know. It was
16 his eye and it was discolored underneath the eye
17 and then it was red inside it, yeah.

18 MS. LUZAICH:

19 Q. And how was Shabazz acting when he
20 came out of the garage?

21 A. He was just acting like nothing
22 happened.

23 Q. Okay. Did he say anything?

24 A. No.

25 Q. Did Fred say anything?

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1 A. No.

2 Q. Were there any other instances that
3 you heard or saw anything regarding Shabazz?

4 A. No, not that I can remember right now.

5 Q. Okay. Were there any other instances
6 regarding you?

7 A. No, that was the only one that I can
8 remember.

9 Q. Did you ever see anything pertaining
10 to Mahlica?

11 A. Yes. Okay. The room was clean and
12 stuff like that. Mahlica, she was reading and I
13 was sitting on the bed and then Fred, he's going to
14 come in there with rage and he's going to be asking
15 questions like why and stuff like that and Mahlica,
16 she didn't answer. You got like five seconds and
17 then after the five seconds was up he started
18 choking her.

19 Q. What room were you in? I'm sorry.

20 A. The room right next to I guess the
21 master bedroom.

22 Q. Was it a bedroom that you guys were
23 in?

24 A. Yes.

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25 Q. Was it a bedroom that you shared, you

2 A. Me and Mahlica and Tahara.

3 Q. Was it just you and Mahlica in the
4 room when Fred came in?

5 A. Yeah, Tahara was there for a little
6 bit but she left.

7 Q. You said he choked her. What part of
8 his body did he use to choke her?

9 A. His hand.

10 Q. Both hands or just one?

11 A. Both.

12 Q. Where was she when he did that?

13 A. She was backed up in the corner right
14 by the mirror and the dresser.

15 Q. Was she standing or sitting or
16 kneeling?

17 A. She was standing and then -- no. She
18 was sitting on the bed and reading a book and then

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19 she stood.

20 Q. How did it come to be that she got
21 out, off of the bed?

22 A. Because I guess when they was talking
23 she had stood up.

24 Q. Okay. What did she do or say when his
25 hands were around her neck?

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1 A. Nothing.

2 Q. I mean was she crying, was she
3 yelling, was she anything?

4 A. She was crying and gasping for air.

5 Q. And what was he saying, if anything?

6 A. Nothing.

7 Q. What ended that?

8 A. I don't know.

9 Q. I mean did he just stop or did
10 somebody call him?

11 A. No, he just stopped.

12 Q. Okay. And then what?

13 A. Then he just left.

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14 THE COURT: Could you speak up a
15 little bit? I'm sorry. If you want, you can move

6 Q. Okay. where were they when you heard
7 it?

8 A. They was in his room, I mean Fred's
9 room.

10 Q. Fred's room. Okay. where were you
11 when you heard it?

12 A. In my room.

13 Q. Was that one time or more than one
14 time?

15 A. More than one time.

16 Q. And did you ever see marks afterwards?

17 A. No.

18 Q. what did you hear?

19 A. Like, you know, whipping of a belt,
20 yeah.

21 Q. Did you hear any words or voices?

22 A. Yeah, screams.

23 Q. who did you hear screaming?

24 A. Shabazz.

25 Q. Did you see him afterwards?

- 2 Q. When he came out of the room?
- 3 A. Yeah.
- 4 Q. And how did he appear when he came out
- 5 of the room?
- 6 A. He appeared angry like, like angry
- 7 with tears.
- 8 Q. Okay. You said you had heard or saw
- 9 him do something to Tahara. Did you hear it or see
- 10 it or both?
- 11 A. Both.
- 12 Q. Where were you and they when you saw
- 13 it?
- 14 A. Okay. So I guess Tahara she got RPC'd
- 15 and he came in there with the belt and stuff. He
- 16 was like -- I don't know exactly what he said, but
- 17 she had answered the question and she had stood up
- 18 and I guess Fred just started whipping her and she

12 room it was at that time.

13 Q. So it was not in Fred and Ann's room?

14 A. No.

15 Q. It was one of the other bedrooms?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. Was that the only time or was there
18 any other times that you saw or hear anything
19 pertaining to Tahara?

20 A. There was more times.

21 Q. In other rooms?

22 A. Yes.

9 question, I don't know what RPC'd means.

10 THE WITNESS: Like when you get
11 suspended from school.

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12 MS. ALLEN: Required parent
13 conference.
14 THE COURT: Okay. Thank you. Go
15 ahead.
16 MS. LUZAICH:
17 Q. You saw them walk into a room?
18 A. Walk in Fred's room.
19 Q. And then what did you hear?
20 A. The belt broke out.
21 Q. And did you see anything or did you
22 hear any words or voices?
23 A. The door was shut.
24 Q. Through the door could you hear any
25 words or voices?

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1 A. I heard voices and stuff. I didn't
2 know what they was talking about and then I just
3 heard the belt come out, yeah.

- 12 A. No.
- 13 Q. Were there ever any occasions that you
- 14 heard anything pertaining to your mom?
- 15 A. Yes.
- 16 Q. What did you hear pertaining to your
- 17 mom?
- 18 A. Okay.
- 19 Q. I'm sorry. What's your mom's name
- 20 just for the record?
- 21 A. Tina.
- 22 Q. What did you hear?
- 23 A. Excuse me. I heard -- okay. So there
- 24 was this night and I got up to use the bathroom and
- 25 I heard Fred. He was talking about she was saying

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1 . open the door and stuff like that and he was
2 cursing and cursing and stuff and so I guess he had
3 busted the door.
4 MS. ALLEN: Judge, objection as to
5 foundation. Did she see it?
6 THE WITNESS: I saw it.
7 THE COURT: Okay. So you saw Fred
8 bust down a door.
9 THE WITNESS: He punched like, he
10 punched a hole in the door.
11 THE COURT: So he didn't bust down the
12 door. He punched a hole in the door. What door
13 was it?
14 THE WITNESS: It was the second room
15 after his room.
16 THE COURT: So one of the bedrooms in
17 the Blankenship house.
18 THE WITNESS: Yes.
19 THE COURT: Go ahead.
20 MS. LUZAICH:
21 Q. And who was in the room when he
22 busted --
23 THE COURT: Punched the door.
24 MS. LUZAICH:
25 Q. Punched the door?

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1 A. My mom.

2 Q. Anybody else?

3 A. That's all.

4 Q. And when you said he was saying open
5 the door, what tone of voice was he using when he
6 is cursing and saying open the door?

7 A. Loud, like mean, rage, forcefulness.

8 Q. Sorry?

9 A. Forcefulness.

10 Q. Did you hear the door being punched?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. And then what did you hear?

13 A. It just went like it broke like the
14 hole in the door like boom like.

15 Q. Did he get inside the room?

16 A. Yeah.

17 Q. And did you hear what happened inside
18 the room?

19 A. I heard what happened but first after
20 I got done from watching I just ran in the bathroom
21 and then I heard him talking. I didn't know what
22 they was talking about but I heard them talking and
23 then after that I just heard my mom scream and then
24 after that they was talking and stuff.

25 It wasn't talking. It was more like

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1 yelling and stuff and so after that I flushed the
2 toilet and then I heard the door like slam again
3 and then I heard someone walk down the hall and I

12 were yelling and screaming. Did you hear the
13 voices? Was it Fred's voice or not?

14 THE WITNESS: Yes.

15 THE COURT: And then did you actually
16 see him punch the door?

17 THE WITNESS: Yes, I saw him.

18 THE COURT: You're objecting to what?

19 MS. ALLEN: She said I'm assuming it
20 was Fred walking down the hallway. Again she
21 either sees him walking down the hallway or she

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22 doesn't.

23 THE COURT: So you're in the bathroom
24 and you flush the toilet and then you heard Fred
25 walking down the hallway.

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1 THE WITNESS: Yes.

2 THE COURT: And you knew it was Fred
3 walking down the hallway because was anyone else in
4 the home besides Fred and your mom?

5 THE WITNESS: Everyone was asleep.

6 THE COURT: Oh, this was night.

7 THE WITNESS: Yes.

8 THE COURT: Go ahead.

9 THE WITNESS: After that I hear him
10 going down the hallway and after I hear him, I open
11 the door and no one was out there. I open the door
12 and I went in my room and I went to sleep.

13 MS. LUZAICH:

14 Q. You said you heard your mom scream.
15 Did you hear her scream like words or something

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16 else?

17 A. It was just like a scream. It wasn't
18 no words.

19 Q. Did you hear anything immediately like
20 right before the scream?

21 A. No.

22 Q. Okay. Did you say you didn't hear
23 what they were talking about?

24 A. It was something about some money.

25 Q. About money.

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1 A. Yes.

2 Q. Did you see anything on your mom after
3 that?

4 A. No, I didn't see her. She went to
5 work but there was another time when she had a
6 black eye. I was getting ready for school in the
7 morning and I saw her with a black eye 'cause I was
8 telling her see you, I'm going to school. So I saw
9 her with a black eye. I was like what happened?

10 MS. ALLEN: Objection.
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11 THE COURT: Hold on.
12 MS. ALLEN: Hearsay.
13 THE COURT: Okay. So don't tell me
14 what your mom said but tell me what you saw. So
15 she had a black eye.
16 THE WITNESS: Uh-huh.
17 THE COURT: Yes.
18 THE WITNESS: Yes.
19 THE COURT: Okay. Go ahead and ask a
20 question.
21 MS. LUZAICH:
22 Q. Did you ever see Fred lay a hand on
23 her?
24 A. Yes.
25 Q. Where was it that they were that you

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HARRIS - VOL. I

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1 saw Fred lay a hand on her?
2 A. In the garage.
3 Q. And was he saying anything?
4 A. He was saying something about turn

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5 down the loud music.

6 Q. Anything else?

7 A. About turn down the loud music and he
8 was talking about some money.

9 Q. What about some money?

10 A. He was like for rent and bills money.
11 I didn't know exactly what he said but I heard them
12 words.

13 Q. Do you remember what words you heard?

14 A. I know I heard the words rent, bills
15 and money and turn down the music.

16 Q. And what did you see him do?

17 A. He just started beating on her and
18 hitting her with the belt in the garage.

19 Q. Okay. You said that there also came a
20 time that you saw something to do with Tahara in
21 the laundry room.

22 A. Yes.

23 Q. Tell me about that it.

24 A. Okay. So it was Friday and it was an
25 afternoon and Tahara, she was asleep on the bed

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1 against the wall and I was asleep in front of the
2 bed and there was two mirrors on the other side
3 where the closet was. And he went up in there and
4 Fred went in there and he said to Tahara where's
5 your sister and she pointed to me on the floor and
6 I guess he said, "Come on," and the mirror -- there
7 was a reflection.

25 them go up where the kitchen was and I saw them go

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1 back where the laundry room and back where the
2 garage was.

3 Q. And then what?

4 A. And then after that I had got up
5 'cause I was already up but I wasn't up like
6 standing up so I stood up. I stood in the middle
7 of the where the doorway was and where the doorway
8 was and where the hallway was and so I had went in
9 the kitchen to see what time it was and I don't
10 remember what time it was 'cause it was like a long
11 time ago.

12 It wasn't that long but it was like a
13 year ago and so after that I went back in the other
14 room and then I checked in the bathroom and no one
15 was there and then I saw a hand in the laundry room
16 since the door was cracked and I saw a hand and
17 then I saw another hand over that hand and the
18 door. It was cracked.

19 The door was cracked and after that I
20 didn't say nothing 'cause I got scared so I knew
21 someone was in there so I just went in the garage.
22 No. Before that I heard the belt buckles and stuff
23 and then after I went in the garage and then after

17 hand which was Fred's hand over Tahara's hand.

18 Q. Where were those hands?

19 A. It was at the, it wasn't at the door.

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20 It was like the crease like.
21 Q. The door frame?
22 A. I don't know what that is.
23 THE COURT: So the door wasn't all the
24 way shut.
25 THE WITNESS: No.

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1 THE COURT: Okay. So between the edge
2 of the door and the edge of the wall you could see
3 into the laundry room.
4 THE WITNESS: Yes.
5 THE COURT: And then what did you
6 see?
7 MS. LUZAICH:
8 Q. Was the hand on the wall?
9 A. Yes.
10 Q. Okay. You said that you -- who is in
11 the house at the time, Fred, Tahara, you, anybody
12 else?
13 A. That's all.
14 Q. Nobody else was in the house?

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15 A. No.

16 Q. Okay. You said you heard belt
17 buckles, what do you mean by that?

18 A. Like the belt buckles that the two
19 chains that go through the loops and the square
20 part of it that makes that sound, yeah.

21 Q. So opening or closing?

22 A. I couldn't tell.

23 THE COURT: Going through the belt
24 buckle.

3 of motion like opening or closing a belt buckle as

11 Q. Were you there when that happened?

16 MS. LUZAICH: She didn't say any
17 hearsay.

18 THE COURT: Well, I guess she was
19 starting to.



- 7 A. Uh-huh.
- 8 Q. Yes?
- 9 A. Yes.
- 10 Q. Do you remember Fred being gone from
- 11 the house a lot at work?
- 12 A. Well, he used to work at this at
- 13 Embarq then he got this job it was like at Nellis
- 14 Air Force Base or the air force base. That's all.

3 whipping you about?

10 he whipped you with a belt, can you remember
11 specifically why he did it?

12 A. Oh, it was that time when, oh, yeah
13 when we was, we was walking home from school so I

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14 guess we decided to stop and hang around at a
15 friend's house and then we came home and got in
16 trouble.

17 Q. Okay. So that was one instance when
18 that happened. Can you give me another one?

19 A. And then another one was at the store,

11 A. No. I can't remember.

12 Q. You can't remember. Okay.

14 not doing chores or not?

16 THE COURT: You just don't remember.
17 Okay.

18 MS. ALLEN:

19 Q. At any point in time did you tell
20 anybody at school that you were being whipped by
21 Fred or Ann, either one of them?

22 A. No.

23 Q. Okay. In 2007 after you'd come back
24 to live with Fred and Ann you said that Victoria or
25 Vickie and your mom moved out; is that right?

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HARRIS - VOL. I

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1 A. Yes.

2 Q. And Shabazz and Mahlica stayed behind;

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3 is that correct?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q. And then at some point Shabazz and
6 Mahlica moved out; is that right?

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. Do you remember the reason why they
9 moved out?

10 A. I don't know.

11 Q. Did Fred and Ann ask them to leave
12 because they were causing too many problems in the
13 house?

14 MS. LUZAICH: Objection, foundation,
15 hearsay.

16 MS. ALLEN: If she knows.

17 THE WITNESS: I don't know.

18 THE COURT: Do you know?

19 THE WITNESS: I don't know, no.

20 MS. ALLEN:

21 Q. So you don't know why they were asked
22 to move.

23 MS. LUZAICH: Well, objection,
24 assuming facts not in evidence.

25 THE COURT: Sustained. I don't know

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1 that they were asked to move.

2 MS. ALLEN: Okay.

3 Q. Do you know if they were asked to move
4 out?

5 A. Yeah. I don't --

6 THE COURT: Okay. So at some point
7 your mom and other siblings moved out, right?

8 THE WITNESS: Uh-huh.

9 THE COURT: Do you know why?

10 THE WITNESS: I don't know. I think
11 because they wanted to. I don't know.

12 MS. ALLEN: I'm being specific
13 actually to two of them.

14 Q. Victoria and your mom moved out
15 sometime in 2007.

16 MS. LUZAICH: No. That misstates the
17 testimony.

18 THE COURT: I don't know. At some
19 point your mom moved out of the Blankenship house,
20 right?

21 THE WITNESS: Uh-huh.

22 THE COURT: Yes.

23 THE WITNESS: Yes.

24 THE COURT: When she moved out, did
25 she take one of your sisters with her?

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HARRIS - VOL. I

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1 THE WITNESS: Yeah, Vickie and
2 Mahlica.

3 THE COURT: And do you know when that
4 was? Do you know what grade you were in?

5 THE WITNESS: Starting sixth grade or
6 fifth grade, one of those.

7 THE COURT: And do you know why they
8 moved out?

9 THE WITNESS: I think, I don't really
10 know but I think it's because like --

11 THE COURT: So you don't know, right?

12 THE WITNESS: I don't know.

13 MS. ALLEN: Okay.

14 Q. So then Shabazz stayed behind; is that
15 right?

16 A. Huh-uh. Shabazz moved out with them.

17 Q. So a minute ago when the judge asked
18 you, you said it was mom, Vickie, and Mahlica so
19 now it's mom, Mahlica, and Shabazz?

20 MS. LUZAICH: Well, objection. The
21 question was very specific. Did your sisters go
22 with you?

23 MS. ALLEN: This is
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24 cross-examination. She was doing a lot of leeway
25 examining the witness so I'm trying to clarify that

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1 so if I can --

2 THE COURT: I understand.

3 MS. ALLEN: Thank you.

4 THE COURT: Overruled.

5 MS. ALLEN: All right.

6 Q. So do you remember you said you were
7 in fifth or sixth grade when mom and Vickie, at
8 least mom and Vickie moved out; is that right?

9 A. Uh-huh.

12 Q. Do you remember what school you were
13 in?

14 A. I was going to HP.

15 Q. That would be HP Fitzgerald?

2 those two streets I think it was Commerce and

9 THE COURT: Is St. Andrews an
10 apartment complex or a school?

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13 MS. ALLEN:

14 Q. Are Mahlica and Shabazz then they
15 lived in the apartment on Walnut, they lived there
16 with mom and Vickie.

17 A. It was only mom and Vickie staying
18 there.

19 Q. Okay. Then where were mom and Vickie
20 or where were Mahlica and Shabazz living when mom
21 and Vickie were living on Walnut?

22 A. They was living with us, with me and
23 my sister Taquana.

24 Q. On Blankenship --

25 A. Yes.

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HARRIS - VOL. I

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1 Q. -- with Fred and Ann?

2 A. Yes.

3 Q. How long did they stay with you after
4 mom and Vickie moved to Walnut?

5 A. Say that again.

6 Q. How long did Mahlica and Shabazz stay

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7 at the Blankenship address with you and your sister
8 after mom and Vickie moved to Walnut? How long
9 were they there?

10 A. Until Vickie and mom they moved in
11 with us so they continued to stay there until they
12 moved out and went to the St. Andrews apartment
13 complex.

14 Q. Okay. So just to be clear, mom and
15 Vickie moved back from the Walnut address back to
16 Blankenship; is that right?

17 MS. LUZAICH: Well, objection. The
18 problem is the phrasing of the question.

19 MS. ALLEN: I'm trying to clarify what
20 she's saying.

21 THE COURT: I thought that I said what
22 she said too. Hold on. Let me ask it. So -- are
23 you okay?

24 THE WITNESS: Okay.

25 THE COURT: Okay. So your mom and

12 THE COURT: And then they moved from
13 the Walnut apartment. Did they move into the

15 Walnut apartment?

16 THE WITNESS: Yes.

17 THE COURT: Do you know how old you
18 were when that happened?

19 THE WITNESS: I was either in third
20 grade or second grade.

21 THE COURT: Okay. Go ahead.

22 MS. ALLEN: Thank you.

23 Q. Okay. So going back to the judge just
24 asked you about moving mom and Vickie moved from
25 Walnut back to Blankenship?

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1 THE COURT: No. They moved into
2 Blankenship.

3 MS. ALLEN: Okay.

4 Q. Do you remember a few minutes ago
5 saying when you moved back from Utah everybody
6 lived at Blankenship?

7 MS. LUZAICH: Objection, that
8 misstates the testimony.

9 MS. ALLEN: I'm asking if she
10 remembers. I'm not misstating.

11 THE COURT: Overruled. You can ask
12 her.

13 MS. LUZAICH: My objection is she said
14 do you remember saying before that everybody moved
15 in. That's not what she said.

16 THE COURT: Okay. She's asking if she
17 ever said that and I don't know. Did you ever say
18 that everybody -- when everybody moved from Utah,
19 did everybody move into the Blankenship house
20 initially?

21 THE WITNESS: Huh-uh.

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22 THE COURT: Never. Okay. So she
23 didn't testify to that.
24 MS. ALLEN:
25 Q. So when you moved back from Utah, it

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1 was just the kids that moved, you and Taquanda that
2 moved into Blankenship, right?
3 A. Say that again.
4 Q. When you moved back from Utah, it was

9 Q. You kind of remember what happened.

10 A. Yeah.

11 Q. Okay. You have -- do you remember
12 that there came a time back in 2011 that you spoke
13 with a detective from the Henderson Police
14 Department?

15 A. Yes.

16 Q. Okay. Do you remember his name?
