



*ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO TRANSMIT PRESENTENCE  
INVESTIGATION REPORT*

Cause appearing, the motion to direct the district court clerk to transmit a copy of the presentence investigation report in this matter (district court case number C-10-269095-1) is granted. NRAP 30(b)(6). The district court clerk shall have 15 days from the date of this order to transmit to the clerk of this court copies of the presentence investigation report and psychosexual evaluation filed on August 25, 2017, in a sealed envelope. See *id.*; NRS 176.139(1) (providing that a psychosexual evaluation is part of the presentence investigation report); NRS 176.156(5) (providing that except for specific disclosures authorized by NRS 176.156(1)-(4), a presentence investigation report is “confidential and must not be made a part of any public record”).

It is so ORDERED.
