

10 hereby files his Renewed Motion for an Order to Show Cause and  
11 Other Relief, on an Order Shortening Time (Prior to Sept 30<sup>th</sup>).

12 This Motion is made and based on all papers and pleadings  
13 on file, and in the regard on Review, the NRAP, the inherent  
14 powers of the Court, and the attached Memorandum of Points  
15 and Authorities.

23 Memorandum of Points and Authorities

24 On September 10, 2020, this Honorable Court (C.J. Pickering)  
25 granted Centofanti's Motion requesting additional time to file  
26 a petition for Review (until September 30, 2020), (20-33344)

27 On September 7, 2020, Centofanti mailed for filing a Petition  
28 for Review and various motions, while awaiting a decision on

1 the motion he mailed Sept 1, 2020 (and subsequently granted, supra.)  
2 In the Petition for Review and motions, Centofanti asked for relief  
3 due to HOSP/INOC denying him access to the law library.  
4 This Court took "no action" on the request for an order to show  
5 Cause, supra, at footnote 1. The Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> order was received  
6 by Centofanti on Sept 15<sup>th</sup>. That same day Centofanti sent a  
7 written Inmate Request Form (DOC 3012) asking for an appointment,  
8 notifying the law library of the Sept 30<sup>th</sup> deadline.

9 On Sept 21, 2020 Centofanti received the following in response:

10 "Still no appointments being scheduled per AW Piccinini  
11 and AD Williams, with no end in sight for it." [no copy available]

12 AW = Associate Warden AD = Associate Director.

13 Centofanti wishes to have his motions, Petition for Review,  
14 and legal arguments contained therein heard on the merits,  
15 and decided on the merits, which will not happen without access  
16 to the resources of the law library.

17 This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> time access is being denied.

18 On June 15, 2020 my request was denied July 1, 2020 (8 days  
19 after the deadline for a Petition for Rehearing) ostensibly for  
20 Covid-19. Ex. A to Sept 9<sup>th</sup> (file date) motion.

21 On August 10, 2020 my request was denied August 13, 2020 telling me  
22 to "find a cure for covid 19".

23 On Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> my request was denied September 21<sup>st</sup>.

24 Each time HOSP/INOC allowed 100<sup>+</sup> inmate workers to go to work  
25 at Prison Industries, 30<sup>+</sup> at the HOSP culinary, and inmate  
26 workers at the HOSP law library and 'others' with a court  
27 order. Fiscal (PI) considerations, institutional needs (culinary,  
28 laundry, etc) are no more important than access to the law library.

1 The prison is not on any Covid-19 lockdown and could easily accommodate  
2 one inmate's request for access, as Centofanti is in a GP level one worker's  
3 unit living with law library workers (same unit and pool).

4 Centofanti is up against the Sept 30th deadline and without an  
5 Order from this Court cannot supplement the Petition for Review with  
6 caselaw and authorities only available at the HOSP law library.

7 Therefore, Centofanti requests the following relief:

8 (1) That the Sept 30th 2020 deadline be extended or stayed  
9 until:

10 a) this Court Orders HOSP/NAC to give Centofanti  
11 access to the HOSP law library;

12 b) Centofanti can supplement his Petition for Review after  
13 being given access to the HOSP law library


14 (2) Order the Nevada Attorney General's office (Counsel for the  
15 State - NAC - HOSP) to appear and respond to this Motion  
16 and issue of denial of access to the law library;

17 and/or

18 (3) Issue an Order to Show Cause on NAC Director Charles Daniels,  
19 HOSP warden Calvin Johnson, and those denying access to the  
20 HOSP law library to Centofanti; and

21 (4) Order the Clerk to provide Centofanti with a file stamped  
22 copy of his Motion and serve it electronically on all counsel  
23 for Respondent.
