On March 18, 2020, in keeping with the public health precautions recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, this court entered AO-0010, postponing the then-scheduled in-person arguments and public hearings. The appellate courts are now preparing to schedule oral arguments in individual cases by videoconferencing or other remote means. The Clerk of the Court will send out scheduling notices in the individual cases. In addition to setting the date and time for argument, the scheduling notice will include information counsel will need to participate in argument remotely. Except as may be ordered in a particular case, no in-person attendance at oral argument by counsel, the parties, or the public will be permitted until further notice. Oral arguments are live-streamed as they occur. The public can access the webcast on the court's website at <http://nvcourts.gov/Supreme/>.
