8 WHEREAS, JCRLV 6.5 allows the Chief Judge to make "such orders as deemed  
9 advisable" relating to local court rules and procedure; and

10 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 virus presents concerns regarding public health, and the  
11 Court wishes to minimize risks relating to in-person contact; and

12 WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court recently issued Administrative  
13 Order # 20-16 which mandates face coverings for employees in that court; and


14 WHEREAS, the Las Vegas Justice Court has determined that a similar mandate is  
15 necessary for employees of this court; therefore,

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all employees of the Las Vegas Justice Court must  
17 wear face coverings inside court facilities unless they are alone in unshared work space; and

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that employees of the Las Vegas Justice Court must  
19 continue to ensure proper social distancing while at work and during breaks; and

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be reviewed no later than every 30  
21 days and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.
