COVID-19

WHEREAS, JCRLV 6.5 allows the Chief Judge to make "such orders as deemed advisable" relating to local court rules and procedure; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 virus presents concerns regarding public health, and the Court wishes to minimize risks relating to in-person contact; and

WHEREAS, the Eighth Judicial District Court recently issued Administrative

Order # 20-16 which mandates face coverings for employees in that court; and

WHEREAS, the Las Vegas Justice Court has determined that a similar mandate is necessary for employees of this court; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all employees of the Las Vegas Justice Court must wear face coverings inside court facilities unless they are alone in unshared work space; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that employees of the Las Vegas Justice Court must continue to ensure proper social distancing while at work and during breaks; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be reviewed no later than every 30 days and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.
