WHEREAS, JCRLV 6.5 allows the Chief Judge to make "such orders as deemed advisable" relating to local court rules and procedure; and

CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 virus presents concerns regarding public health, and the Court wishes to minimize risks relating to in-person contact; and

WHEREAS, the Court recently issued Administrative Order #20-13 and mandated face coverings for all Court employees; and

WHEREAS, the Court has determined that the scope of that Order needs to be supplemented; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that anyone who enters a public area of the Las Vegas Justice Court must wear a face covering; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order expressly applies to, but is not limited to, private attorneys, contract counsel, employees or attorneys of the Clark County District Attorney' Office, employees or attorneys of the Clark County Public Defender's Office, court reporters, and all members of the public; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that children under the age of two and individuals who are unable to remove the face covering without assistance do not have to comply with the abovereferenced face-covering directive; and
